

Crochet Cat Earrings - Complete Beginner Tutorial

Introduction

This tutorial will guide you step by step to crochet adorable sleeping cat earrings.

Even if you are a complete beginner, you can follow this pattern with clear explanations, photos, and a crochet diagram.

Materials Needed

- Cotton yarn (yellow or color of your choice)
- Crochet hook (2.5 mm – 3.0 mm)
- Embroidery thread (black)
- Embroidery needle
- Scissors
- Earring hooks and jump rings
- Jewelry pliers

Basic Crochet Stitches

- **Chain (ch):** Yarn over, pull through loop.
- **Slip Stitch (sl st):** Insert hook, yarn over, pull through both loops.
- **Single Crochet (sc):** Insert hook, yarn over, pull through, yarn over, pull through 2 loops.
- **Half Double Crochet (hdc):** Yarn over, insert hook, yarn over, pull through, yarn over, pull through all 3 loops.

- **Magic Ring (MR):** A loop technique to begin working in the round without leaving a hole in the center.

Step-by-Step Instructions

1. Head

- Start with a magic ring (MR).
- Round 1: 6 sc in MR. (6 sts)
- Round 2: 2 sc in each st. (12 sts)
- Round 3: 1 sc, 2 sc *in next st* repeat around. (18 sts)
- Fasten off.

2. Ears (make 2)

- Ch 3.
- Row 1: 1 sc in 2nd ch, 1 hdc in last ch.
- Fasten off, sew to the head.

3. Body

- Start with MR.
- Round 1: 6 sc in MR. (6 sts)
- Round 2: 2 sc in each st. (12 sts)
- Round 3: 1 sc, 2 sc *in next st* repeat around. (18 sts)
- Round 4: 2 sc, 2 sc *in next st* repeat around. (24 sts)
- Round 5: sc around (24 sts).
- Fasten off.

4. Paws

- Ch 6.
- Row 1: sc across (5 sts).
- Sew to the body.

5. Assembly

- Sew head to body slightly tilted to create the sleeping cat shape.
- Attach paws.
- Embroider closed eyes, nose, mouth, and whiskers.
- Add earring hooks with jump rings.

Ears: - Chain 3. - In the second chain from hook: 1 sc, then 1 half double crochet (hdc) in the next chain. - Slip stitch to fasten off, leaving a tail for sewing. - Make 2 ears and sew them to the top of the head. 3. Body (Make 2): - Start with a magic ring. - Round 1: 6 sc in the ring. (6 sts) - Round 2: 2 sc in each stitch. (12 sts) - Round 3: *1 sc, 2 sc in next st* repeat around. (18 sts) - Round 4: *2 sc, 2 sc in next st* repeat around. (24 sts) - Round 5: Crochet around without increases. (24 sts) - Fasten off. 4. Paws: - Chain 6. - Work 1 sc in each chain across (5 sts). - Roll the piece slightly and sew onto the body to form a paw. - Make 2 paws. 5. Assembly: - Sew the head to the body slightly tilted to create the curled sleeping cat shape. - Sew paws on the sides of the body. 6. Face Embroidery: - With black embroidery thread, stitch 2 closed eyes, a small triangle nose, a mouth, and 3 whiskers on each side. 7. Earring Hooks: - Attach a jump ring at the top of each cat and connect it to the earring hook using pliers. Now your cute crochet cat earrings are ready to wear or gift! Tips: - You can experiment with different yarn colors for unique cat styles. - Use metallic or glitter yarn for a special effect. - Adjust hook size to make smaller or larger earrings.
