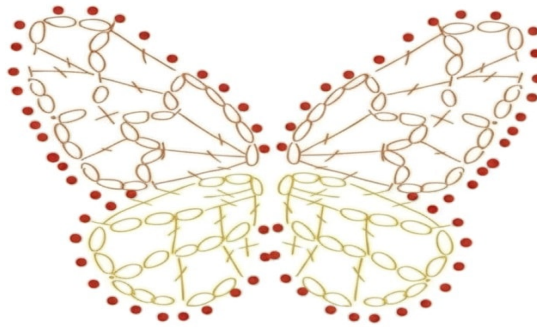


Crochet Butterfly Tutorial – Step by Step for Beginners



This delicate crochet butterfly is simple, elegant, and perfect for beginners. It can be used as an applique, brooch, hair accessory, or even as part of your home decor. Follow this easy, step-by-step guide to create your own crochet butterfly from scratch.

Materials Needed:

- 2.5mm crochet hook
- Cotton yarn in your chosen color (blue used in photo)
- Tapestry needle
- Scissors
- Fabric stiffener or glue (optional for firmness)

Step-by-Step Instructions:

Step 1: Create the Center Ring

Make a magic ring and crochet 6 single crochets (sc) inside. Pull tight and join with a slip stitch (sl st). This will be the center of the butterfly.

Step 2: Form the Upper Wings

Chain 6, then work 1 double crochet (dc) into the ring. *Chain 2, dc into the ring* four more times.

This forms the loops for the upper wings.

Step 3: Make the Lower Wings

Chain 4, then work 1 half double crochet (hdc) and 1 dc into the next loop. Repeat for the second loop to shape the lower wings.

Step 4: Outline the Wings

Work single crochets (sc) evenly around each wing to give them structure. When you reach a corner or curve, work 2 sc in the same stitch to keep it flat.

Step 5: Shape the Butterfly Body

Wrap yarn tightly several times around the center of the wings to form the butterfly's body. Tie and secure it at the back.

Step 6: Form the Antennae

Chain 8 from the top center, slip stitch back to the body, and repeat for the second antenna. Fasten off.

Step 7: Finishing Touches

Cut and weave in all loose ends. If you want a stiffer butterfly, apply fabric stiffener and let it dry flat.
