

Crochet Cat Tutorial – Step by Step for Beginners



This crochet cat pattern is an adorable and easy project for beginners. With its cute details like the ears, tail, and playful tongue, this pattern makes a perfect decoration, gift, or accessory. Follow the simple steps below to crochet your own cat from scratch.

Materials Needed:

- 3mm crochet hook
- Cotton yarn in white, grey, pink, and black
- Tapestry needle
- Scissors
- Black beads or safety eyes
- Hot glue (optional)

Step-by-Step Instructions:

Step 1: Make the Base Body

Start with white yarn. Make a magic ring and crochet 6 single crochets (sc). Tighten the ring. In the next rounds, increase evenly until you reach the size of the cat's body (about 6 cm in diameter).

Step 2: Add the Gray Stripes

Switch to gray yarn. Crochet short rows or surface slip stitches to create the stripes on the back and head of the cat.

Step 3: Create the Ears

With gray yarn, make two small triangles: ch 3, sc in 2nd chain, hdc in next. Fasten off. Sew or crochet them onto the head.

Step 4: Make the Legs and Tail

For each leg, chain 4 and sc back across. For the tail, chain 7 and sc back across with gray yarn. Attach all to the body.

Step 5: Crochet the Tongue and Cheeks

With pink yarn, chain 3 and sc back for the tongue. Make two small circles with pink yarn for cheeks. Sew or glue in place.

Step 6: Add the Face Details

Attach black beads or safety eyes. Use black yarn to embroider the nose, mouth, and whiskers.

Step 7: Final Assembly

Sew or glue all parts together neatly. Weave in any loose ends. Your cute crochet cat is ready!
