

Crochet Bunny Appliqué Pattern

Introduction

This tutorial teaches you how to crochet a cute bunny appliqué. It is perfect for decorating baby blankets, bags, clothing, Easter projects, or children's accessories. The pattern is written in a clear, beginner-friendly way and is based on the crochet diagram provided.

Finished Size

Approximate size: 7–9 cm (2.7–3.5 in) wide and 8–10 cm (3.1–3.9 in) tall, depending on yarn weight and hook size.

Materials

- Light worsted weight yarn in white (main body)
- Light worsted weight yarn in light blue (scarf and tail)
- Crochet hook 2.5–3.5 mm (adjust for your yarn)
- Yarn needle
- Scissors
- Small black safety eye or black embroidery thread

Abbreviations (US Terms)

- ch = chain
- sl st = slip stitch
- sc = single crochet
- hdc = half double crochet
- dc = double crochet
- tr = treble crochet
- inc = increase
- st(s) = stitch(es)

Notes

- This appliqué is worked in continuous rounds and short rows.
- Do not join rounds unless stated.
- Use stitch markers to track the beginning of each round.
- The bunny is worked flat and then details are added.
- All stitches are worked tightly for a neat finish.

Round 1 – Bunny Body Base

Make a magic ring. Work 12 dc into the ring. Join with sl st to the first dc. (12 sts)

Round 2 – Increase Round

Ch 2. 2 dc in each st around. Join with sl st. (24 sts)

Round 3 – Shape the Body

Ch 2. *1 dc in next st, 2 dc in next st* repeat around. Join with sl st. (36 sts)

Round 4 – Lower Body Curve

Ch 2. Dc in each st around. Do not join. Begin shaping the bottom edge with hdc and sc as shown in the diagram to form a sitting bunny shape.

Head Shaping

Attach yarn at the top of the body. Work a short arc of dc and hdc stitches to form the bunny's head. Follow the diagram placement for stitch height and spacing.

Ears (Make 2)

Ch 8. In 2nd ch from hook: sc, hdc, dc, dc, hdc, sc. Sl st into the base of the head. Repeat for the second ear.

Tail

With light blue yarn: Make a magic ring. Work 6 sc into the ring. Join with sl st. Fasten off. Sew onto the lower back of the bunny.

Scarf

With light blue yarn: Ch 22. Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across. Fasten off. Wrap around the bunny's neck and sew in place.

Eye and Face Details

Attach a small black safety eye or embroider a French knot for the eye. Optional: embroider a tiny nose with pink thread.

Finishing

Weave in all loose ends. Block lightly if needed. Your bunny appliqué is now ready to be sewn or glued onto your project.

- Baby blankets • Kitchen towels • Easter decorations • Bags and purses • Children's clothing • Scrapbook or greeting card decor
