



Luxurious Swan Rug Crochet Pattern – Complete Step-by-Step Guide (US Terms)

This Luxurious Swan Rug Crochet Pattern is written using standard US crochet terminology. The rug is constructed in sections: body, neck and head, wings, and tail base. The wings are worked outward in rows with structured increases to create a dramatic, elegant spread. This pattern follows traditional American crochet techniques with proper shaping, stitch balance, and professional finishing methods.

Materials & Tools (US Standard)

- Bulky weight cotton yarn – White (main body), Pink (wing detail), Green (wing detail), Blue (border)
- Small amount of Black and Gold for beak and eye
- Crochet hook 5.5 mm – 7.0 mm (adjust for tension)
- Yarn needle
- Stitch markers
- Scissors
- Non-slip rug backing (recommended)

Abbreviations (US Terms)

- ch – chain
- sl st – slip stitch
- sc – single crochet
- hdc – half double crochet
- dc – double crochet
- tr – treble crochet
- inc – increase (2 stitches in same stitch)

Body Base (Worked in Rows)

- Row 1: Ch 18. Sc in 2nd ch from hook and across. Turn.
- Row 2: Ch 1. Inc in first stitch, sc across to last stitch, inc in last stitch. Turn.
- Row 3: Ch 1. Sc across evenly. Turn.
- Repeat increase rows at both ends every other row to gradually widen the body shape.
- Continue until body reaches desired length according to chart.

Neck & Head Shaping

Attach yarn at top center of body. Ch 2 and work hdc upward in rows, gradually decreasing along inner curve to shape the elegant swan neck. Use strategic decreases (hdc2tog) to form the inward curve.

For the head, work in small oval rounds: 6 sc in magic ring, increase to 12 sc, then 18 sc. Work even for 2 rounds. Stuff lightly if desired for dimension. Attach beak separately using gold yarn.

Wings (Worked Separately in Rows)

Each wing begins at the body side. Attach yarn and ch 3 (counts as dc). Work dc across while increasing evenly along outer edge every row to create fan expansion.

Follow color sections: white base, pink inner arc, green expansion, and blue outer section. Maintain symmetrical increases on both wings for balanced spread.

Decorative Scalloped Border

For the outer blue edge: Skip 1 stitch, 5 dc in next stitch, skip 1 stitch, sl st in next stitch. Repeat across wing edges and tail base for consistent scallop finish.

Tail Base (Worked in Rounds)

Attach yarn at lower body. Work in semi-circular rows increasing evenly to create rounded tail support. Maintain flat shaping by spacing increases evenly across each row.

Finishing, Blocking & Care

Weave in all ends securely following stitch paths for durability. Steam block lightly to shape wings symmetrically. Attach non-slip backing if placing on smooth floors. Hand wash in cold water and lay flat to dry.

Your Luxurious Swan Rug is now complete. You may customize the size by extending wing rows or increasing body length before final edging.
