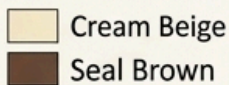


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Lying Siamese Cat Crochet Rug — Complete Step-by-Step Tutorial (US Terms)

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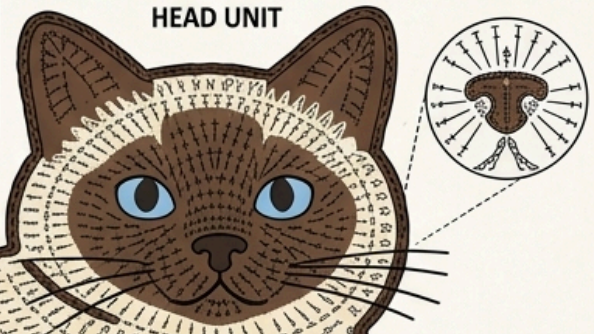

ASSEMBLY ORDER



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Materials & Tools

- Worsted weight yarn:
 - Cream Beige (main body)
 - Seal Brown (face, ears, paws, tail, trim)
- Crochet hook: Size H/8 (5.0 mm) or size needed to match tension
- Tapestry needle
- Stitch markers
- Scissors
- Optional: safety eyes or yarn for embroidered eyes



Stitch Abbreviations (US Terms)

- CH = Chain
- SC = Single Crochet
- DC = Double Crochet
- SL ST = Slip Stitch
- INC = Increase (2 stitches in same stitch)
- DEC = Decrease (combine stitches)



Body Section (Main Oval Rug)

This is worked in **continuous rounds**, starting from the center and expanding outward.

Round 1

- With Cream Beige: CH 4, SL ST to form a ring
- Work 8 SC into ring
- Join with SL ST

Round 2

- CH 1, INC in each stitch around (16 SC total)

Round 3

- CH 1, (SC, INC) repeat around (24 stitches)

Rounds 4–12

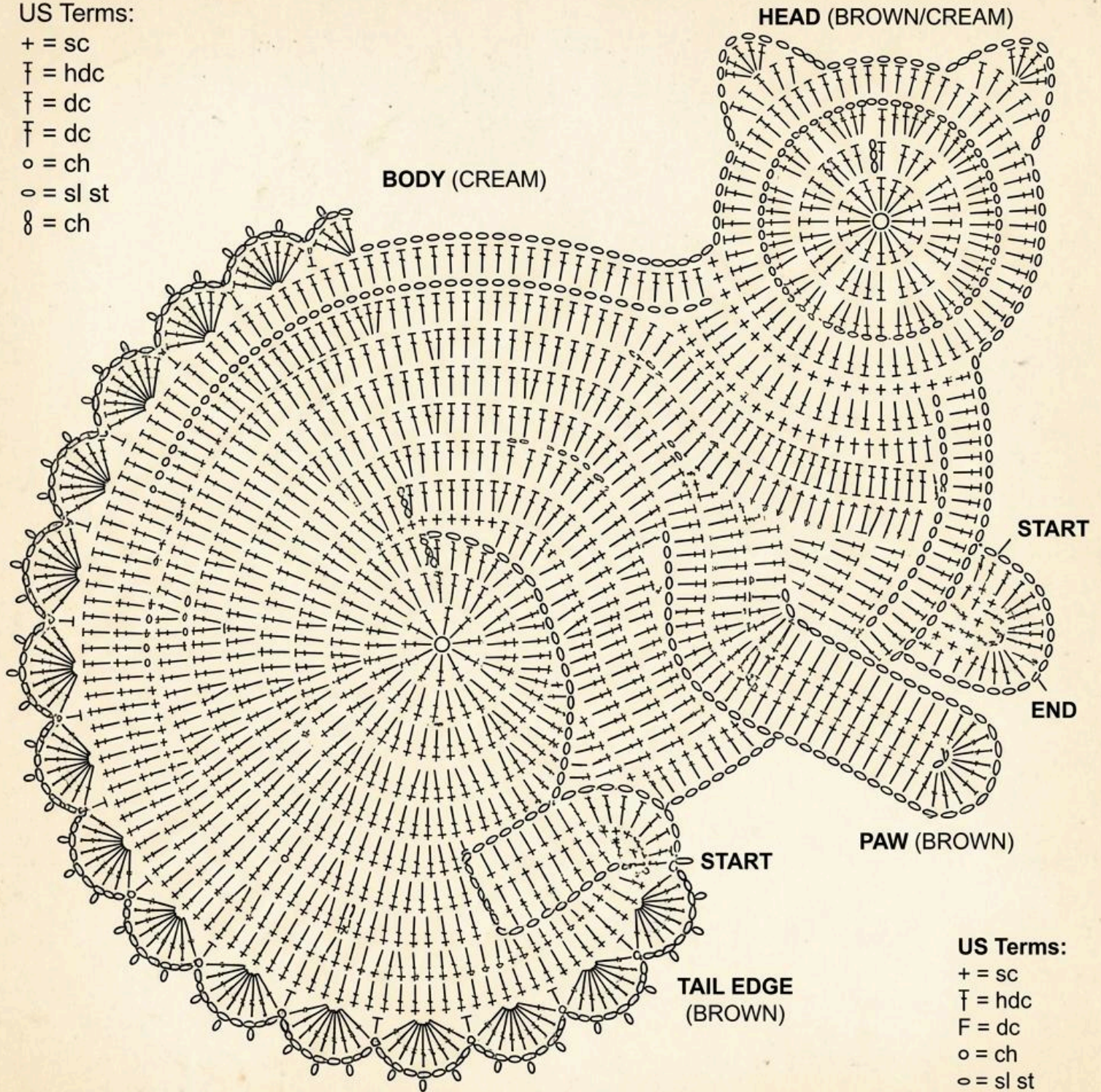
- Continue increasing evenly:
 - Add 1 SC between increases each round
 - Keep the shape slightly oval (not perfectly circular)

👉 Tip: Place increases more toward the sides to elongate the rug.

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Body Color Transition

Round 13–28

- Switch to Seal Brown for edge shaping accents (as shown in diagram sections)
- Continue DC rounds to expand rug:
 - Maintain oval shape
 - Work evenly without puckering

Scalloped Trim Section

This creates the decorative edge around the rug.

Round 1 (Trim Base)

- Join Seal Brown yarn
- *Skip 1 stitch, 5 DC in next stitch, skip 1 stitch, SL ST in next*
- Repeat around entire edge

Round 2

- Continue shell pattern:
 - Work shells into center DC of previous shells

Round 3 (Optional Decorative Edge)

- Add tighter shells or SC edging if desired for stability

Head Unit

The head is worked separately, then attached.

Face Base (Cream Beige)

Round 1

- Magic ring, 8 SC

Round 2

- INC around (16 SC)

Round 3

- (SC, INC) repeat (24 SC)

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Rounds 4–8

- SC evenly to build face

Face Mask (Siamese Marking)

- Attach Seal Brown yarn
- Work DC stitches across the front half of the face
- Shape slightly downward to mimic mask pattern

Ears (Make 2)

Round 1

- Magic ring, 4 SC

Round 2

- INC in each stitch (8 SC)

Round 3

- (SC, INC) (12 SC)

Shape

- Fold slightly and flatten base
- Attach to top of head symmetrically

Eyes & Facial Details

Eyes

- Use blue yarn or safety eyes
- Position evenly above center of mask

Nose

- Small triangle using Seal Brown
- Embroider or crochet separately

Whiskers

- Use white yarn
- Stitch outward from muzzle

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Legs & Paws (Make 4)

Each piece is worked separately.

Round 1

- Magic ring, 6 SC

Round 2

- INC around (12 SC)

Rounds 3–6

- SC evenly

Shape

- Flatten slightly for paw look
- Front legs slightly longer than back

Tail

Round 1

- CH 10

Row 2

- SC in each chain

Rows 3–6

- Continue SC rows
- Slightly curve by decreasing one side occasionally

Assembly Order

Follow this exact order for best alignment:

1. Attach head to body (top right area)
2. Sew ears onto head
3. Add facial features
4. Attach legs and paws:
 - Front legs extend forward
 - Back legs tuck under body

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5. Attach tail along curve of body
 6. Secure all loose ends

Final Shaping & Finishing

- Block the rug lightly to smooth shape
- Adjust scallops evenly
- Reinforce stitches where pieces join

Helpful Tips

- Keep tension consistent throughout
- Use stitch markers to track rounds
- Check symmetry frequently during assembly
- Don't overstuff — this is a flat rug, not plush
