
## COMPLETE FABRIC PLUSH BUNNY TUTORIAL

### SECTION 1: MATERIALS & PREPARATION




### SECTION 2: PATTERN PIECE & CUTTING LAYOUT

(All Measurements Adjusted to logical cm)




### SECTION 3: STEP-BY-STEP ASSEMBLY GUIDE

#### STEP 1: PREPARE EARS.




Sew inner and outer ear pairs, clip SA, and turn right-side-out.

#### STEP 2: PREPARE TAIL.



Sew two tail circles, stuff firmly.

#### STEP 3: ASSEMBLE BODY & EARS.



Fold ears in half at the base and sandwich them between body fabric layers at the head. Place the tail.

Pin all body pieces together, leaving a 5 cm gap on the back seam for turning. Sew all around, avoiding the gap.

#### STEP 4: FINISHING.



Turn right-side out, stuff firmly, and slip-stitch the opening closed.

## Section 1: Materials & Preparation

Before you begin, gather all your materials:

- **Fabric (0.5 meter / ~0.55 yards)** – main fabric for the bunny
- **Contrasting fabric (small amount)** – for inner ears
- **Pom-pom (x1)** or fabric scraps for tail
- **Stuffing (polyfill)**
- **Thread** (matching your fabric)
- **Sewing machine** (or hand sewing needle)

Optional but helpful:

- Fabric scissors
- Pins or clips
- Fabric marker or chalk
- Ruler or measuring tape



## Section 2: Pattern Pieces & Cutting Layout

All measurements are in centimeters (cm). Seam allowance (SA) is **0.5 cm (~1/4 inch)** unless stated.

### Ears

- Height: **20 cm**
- Width: **9 cm**
- Cut:
  - **4 pieces** in main fabric
  - **2 pieces** in contrasting fabric (inner ears)

### Tail

- Circle: **6 cm diameter**
- Cut:
  - **2 fabric circles**

### Body Piece

- Length: **42 cm**
- Height: **42 cm (overall silhouette)**
- Lower section height: **12 cm**
- Mid body width: **12 cm**

Cut:

- **4 body pieces** (2 mirrored pairs)

Tip: Fold fabric before cutting to ensure symmetry.



## Section 3: Step-by-Step Assembly Guide



### Step 1: Prepare the Ears

1. Pair each **main ear piece** with a **contrasting inner ear piece** (right sides together).
2. Sew around the edges, leaving the bottom open.
3. Clip the seam allowance slightly around curves to reduce bulk.
4. Turn each ear right-side-out.
5. Gently press flat.

You should now have **2 finished ears**.



### Step 2: Prepare the Tail

1. Place the two **6 cm circles** right sides together.
2. Sew around the edge, leaving a small opening.
3. Turn right-side-out.
4. Stuff firmly with filling.
5. Hand-stitch the opening closed.

Alternative: Use a ready-made pom-pom instead.



### Step 3: Assemble Body & Attach Ears

1. Take your **body pieces** and arrange them in pairs (right sides together).
2. Fold each ear slightly at the base.
3. Position the ears between the body layers at the head area.
4. Place the tail at the back, also sandwiched between layers.
5. Pin all layers securely.

Important:

- Leave a **5 cm opening** along the back seam for turning later.
- 6. Sew around the entire bunny shape, following the seam allowance, **but do not sew the gap**.

## Step 4: Finishing

1. Turn the bunny right-side-out through the 5 cm gap.
2. Push out curves and corners gently using a blunt tool.
3. Stuff the bunny firmly with filling until evenly shaped.
4. Close the opening using a **slip stitch (ladder stitch)** for an invisible finish.

## Final Result

You now have a soft, handmade plush bunny! Adjust stuffing firmness to your preference and enjoy your finished piece 

## Tips for Success

- Take your time when sewing curves for a smoother shape
- Use pins generously to keep layers aligned
- Iron pieces lightly before assembly for cleaner results
- If hand sewing, use small, tight stitches for durability
