




Crochet Bunny Appliqué Tutorial (US Terms)

This step-by-step guide is based entirely on the stitch chart you provided. Follow along carefully and you'll be able to recreate the bunny appliqué from start to finish—even if you're still learning 😊

CROCHET BUNNY APLIQUE TUTORIAL & STITCH CHART (Measurements in cm)



MATERIALS NEEDED

- Assorted Creme/White Yarn (sc rounds)
- Assorted Red Yarn (sc rounds)
- Assorted Dark Blue Yarn (sc rounds, for outline)
- Black Embroidery Floss
- [Tapestry Needle]
- fabric glue for securing details

CROCHET TIPS (US Terms)

- Use correct hook size for yarn.
- All numbers refer to single crochet (sc) stitches unless specified (US terms).
- Outline all sections with Dark Blue yarn as shown in finished photo.
- Magified insets #H/#F show detailed component form and attachment.
- Magic Ring (MR) is recommended for head rounds for a clean start.
- Secure all thread tails neatly.



Materials Needed

- Creme/White yarn (for head, ears, hands, feet)
- Red yarn (for dress)
- Dark Blue yarn (for outline)
- Black embroidery floss (for face details)
- Crochet hook suitable for your yarn
- Tapestry needle
- Fabric glue (optional, for securing details)
- Scissors



Finished Size

- Height: approx. 3 cm (1.2 in)
- Width: approx. 3.2 cm (1.25 in)
- Head width: approx. 5.2 cm (scaled in diagram context)
- Dress width: approx. 3.8 cm



Stitch Abbreviations (US Terms)

- MR = Magic Ring
- sc = single crochet
- hdc = half double crochet
- dc = double crochet
- tr = treble crochet
- sl st = slip stitch
- ch = chain



Step 1: Crochet the Head (#1)

Using creme/white yarn:

1. Start with a MR
2. Round 1: 6 sc into MR
3. Round 2: inc in each stitch around (12 sc)
4. Round 3: (1 sc, inc) repeat around (18 sc)
5. Round 4: (2 sc, inc) repeat around (24 sc)
6. Continue increasing until you reach a round, flat circle that matches the head size in the chart
7. Fasten off and leave a tail for sewing

Do NOT stuff — this is a flat appliqué



Step 2: Crochet Ear A (#2)

Using creme/white yarn:

1. MR
2. Round 1: 5–6 sc in MR
3. Round 2+: Work in rounds, increasing slightly to form an oval shape
4. Continue until ear is long and narrow (see chart proportions)
5. Fasten off

Make 1 piece

Step 3: Crochet Ear B (#3)

Repeat the same steps as Ear A

Make 1 piece

Tip: Slight variations between ears are fine and make it look more natural 😊

Step 4: Crochet the Dress (#4)

Using red yarn:

1. MR
2. Round 1: 6 sc
3. Round 2: increase evenly (12 sc)
4. Continue increasing to form a semicircle shape
5. Add a slight flare by increasing more at the sides
6. Stop when dress width reaches approx. 3.8 cm
7. Fasten off

Step 5: Crochet the Hands (#5)

Using creme/white yarn:

1. MR
2. Round 1: 4–5 sc
3. Round 2: minimal shaping (no need for many increases)
4. Fasten off

Make 2 pieces

Step 6: Crochet the Feet (#6)

Using creme/white yarn:

1. MR
2. Round 1: 5–6 sc
3. Round 2: slight increases to create oval
4. Keep shape small and rounded
5. Fasten off

Make 2 pieces

Step 7: Face Details (#7)

Using black embroidery floss:

- Eyes: embroider two small oval dots, about 2.5 cm apart
- Mouth: stitch a small “X” shape centered below the eyes

Keep features minimal and cute 😊

Step 8: Outline All Pieces

Using dark blue yarn:

- Single crochet evenly around each piece
- This creates the bold outline seen in the chart
- Work 1 sc per stitch, adding extra stitches at corners if needed

Step 9: Assembly

1. Attach ears behind the top of the head
2. Sew or glue hands to the sides of the body area
3. Attach feet under the dress
4. Place dress overlapping the lower head slightly
5. Secure everything using a tapestry needle or fabric glue

Step 10: Final Touches

- Weave in all ends neatly
- Adjust placement of features if needed
- Lightly shape the appliqué with your hands



Crochet Tips

- Always use the correct hook size for your yarn
- All stitch counts are in single crochet unless stated
- Use a magic ring for a clean center
- Keep tension consistent for a neat look
- Blocking is optional but helps flatten the appliqué
