



Crochet Bunny Hat for Cats – Full Step-by-Step Tutorial (U.S. Terms)

This complete guide will walk you through making an adorable bunny hat for cats 🐱🐰 using the exact structure from the template. Follow carefully and you'll be able to create a snug, comfortable, and cute accessory from start to finish.

CROCHET BUNNY HAT FOR CATS TEMPLATE & INSTRUCTIONS

(Measurements in cm)

EAR CONSTRUCTION
Outer Ear #2 Inner Ear #3
Secure Stitching
Assemble and Attach at specified spots

Ears: 2 qty, each piece 2 & 3

Chinstrap - Loop (White Yarn) #5
8.8cm
2.5cm
3.5cm

Bottom Trim (Pink Yarn) #4
11.5cm

Chinstrap - Tie (Pink Yarn) #6
11.4cm
1cm
Attach tie #6 to loop #5 (Adjustable Loop & Tie System)

FINISHED HAT ON CAT REFERENCE

MATERIALS NEEDED

- Assorted Creme/White Yarn (sc rounds, 11.4cm x 8.9cm - adapt size values for a cat hat)
- Assorted Pink Yarn
- [Sewing Needle, standard items]
- Fabric Glue (Optional for assembling felt details)

CROCHET TIPS

- Use correct hook size for your yarn.
- Raw Edge/Frayed Applique Style - edges are joined neatly (not frayed)
- Join ear pieces (#2 & #3) with neat sc around.
- Secure ear attachments to dome (#1) firmly.
- Adjustable loop & tie system for piece #5 & #6 - attach tie to loop as shown.
- Reinforce tie attachments with strong thread or backstitching.



Materials Needed

Prepare everything before you begin:

- Medium/light weight yarn
 - Creme or white (main hat + outer ears)
 - Pink (inner ears, trim, chin strap)
- Crochet hook (size appropriate for your yarn, typically 3.5 mm / E-4)
- Tapestry needle
- Stitch marker
- Scissors
- Fabric glue (optional, for small details)



Crochet Notes (U.S. Terms)

- MR = Magic Ring
- sc = single crochet
- inc = increase (2 sc in same stitch)
- dec = invisible decrease
- sl st = slip stitch



Work in continuous rounds unless stated



Keep stitches tight so the hat holds its shape



Step 1: Hat Dome (Piece #1)

Using creme/white yarn:

1. Start with MR
2. Round 1: 6 sc (6)
3. Round 2: inc in each stitch (12)
4. Round 3: (1 sc, inc) ×6 (18)
5. Round 4: (2 sc, inc) ×6 (24)
6. Continue increasing evenly until the circle reaches about **11.4 cm diameter**
7. Once size is reached:
 - Work even rounds (no increases) to form the dome height
 - Total height should be about **8.5 cm**
8. Fasten off



This forms the main hat base.

Step 2: Outer Ears (Piece #2)

Make 2 using white yarn:

1. MR, 6 sc
2. Round 2: (1 sc, inc) ×3 (9)
3. Round 3: (2 sc, inc) ×3 (12)
4. Continue increasing slightly to create an oval shape
5. Crochet several rows without increasing to build height
6. Shape into a pointed oval (approx. **8.5 cm tall**)
7. Fasten off

Step 3: Inner Ears (Piece #3)

Make 2 using pink yarn:

1. Same method as outer ears, but slightly smaller
2. Keep shape narrower so it fits inside outer ear
3. Fasten off

Step 4: Assemble the Ears

1. Place inner ear (#3) onto outer ear (#2)
2. Sew around edges using neat stitches
3. Slightly pinch the base of each ear to give a natural curve
4. Secure tightly

Step 5: Attach Ears to Hat

1. Identify placement spots on the top of the dome (slightly forward)
2. Position ears symmetrically
3. Sew securely to the hat

 Reinforce stitches so they stand upright.

Step 6: Bottom Trim (Piece #4)

Using pink yarn:

1. Attach yarn to bottom edge of hat
2. Work 1 round of sc evenly around
3. Optional: add another round for thickness

 This creates a clean, decorative edge.

Step 7: Chinstrap Loop (Piece #5)

Using white yarn:

1. Chain enough stitches to form a small loop (~2.5 cm wide)
2. Join with sl st
3. Reinforce with another round of sc

Attach this loop to one side of the hat.

Step 8: Chinstrap Tie (Piece #6)

Using pink yarn:

1. Chain a long cord (~20–25 cm or desired length)
2. Slip stitch back along the chain for strength
3. Fasten off

Attach the tie to the opposite side of the hat.

👉 The tie will pass through the loop to secure under the cat's chin.

Step 9: Final Assembly & Adjustments

- Check all attachments (ears, straps, trim)
- Weave in all loose ends
- Adjust ear positioning if needed
- Ensure hat fits comfortably (not too tight)

Step 10: Fitting & Safety Tips

- Gently place on your cat's head
- Secure using the loop and tie system
- Make sure:
 - It's not blocking vision
 - It's not too tight around the neck

👉 Always supervise your pet while wearing the hat.
