

Crochet Coffee Cup Coaster Pattern

US Crochet Terms – Based on the Diagram

Skill Level: Beginner – Intermediate

Finished Size: about **12–15 cm (5–6 in)** wide depending on yarn and hook.


This adorable **coffee cup coaster** is made in **four simple parts**: the saucer, the cup body, the coffee surface, and the handle. After crocheting each piece, they are assembled to create a charming **mini coffee cup coaster** perfect for kitchen decor or coffee lovers.



① Diagram of the Saucer




Rd 1: 8 hdc (Beige)

③ Cup Content (Coffee)




Brown/Coffee

Attach the coffee content with sc

← Row etc

- Color A (Beige/Cream)
- Color B (Brown/Coffee)
- Color C (Blue)

④ Diagram of the Handle



Sew the handle



Materials

Yarn colors:

- Cream / Beige – cup and saucer
- Brown – coffee
- Optional accent color – handle outline

Tools:

- Crochet hook **3 mm – 4 mm**
- Yarn needle
- Scissors
- Stitch marker (optional)

Recommended yarn:

- Cotton yarn (best for coasters because it absorbs moisture).
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Abbreviations (US Terms)

MR – magic ring

ch – chain

sl st – slip stitch

sc – single crochet

hdc – half double crochet

dc – double crochet

inc – increase (2 stitches in same stitch)

st – stitch

Part 1 – Saucer

Using **cream yarn**

Round 1
MR, **8 hdc** into ring.
Join with sl st. (8)

Round 2
Ch 2, **inc in each stitch** around.
(16)

Round 3
Ch 2, *1 hdc, inc* repeat around.
(24)

Round 4
Ch 2, *2 hdc, inc* repeat around.
(32)

Round 5
Work **hdc around evenly**.

Fasten off and weave ends.

This forms the **round saucer base**.

Part 2 – Coffee Surface

Using **brown yarn**

Round 1
MR, **8 hdc** into ring.

Round 2
1 hdc, inc repeat around.

Round 3
Hdc around evenly.

Fasten off leaving a long tail.

Place the coffee circle **in the center of the saucer** and attach with **sc or sewing stitches**.

Part 3 – Cup Body

Using **cream yarn**

Row 1
Ch **20**.

Starting in the **3rd chain from hook**, work **hdc across**.

Row 2
Turn, ch 2.
Hdc across.

Row 3
Turn, ch 2.
Hdc across again.

Fasten off.

This rectangular piece forms the **side wall of the coffee cup**.

Wrap it slightly into a **cup shape** and sew onto the saucer above the coffee circle.

Part 4 – Cup Handle

Using cream yarn

Row 1
Ch **10**.

Row 2
Sc across chain.

Row 3
Ch 1, turn.
Sc across again.

Fasten off.

Curve the strip into a **handle shape** and sew it onto the side of the cup.

Optional Border

Attach accent yarn around the entire coaster.

Round
Work **sl st** or **sc** around the saucer edge.

This gives the coaster a **clean decorative finish**.

Finishing

- Weave in all ends
- Block lightly if needed
- Press with steam for a flat finish

Your coffee cup coaster is now ready to use.

Tips

- Use **cotton yarn** to protect surfaces from hot cups.
- Tight stitches help the coaster hold its shape.
- You can add **embroidered steam lines** above the cup for decoration.
