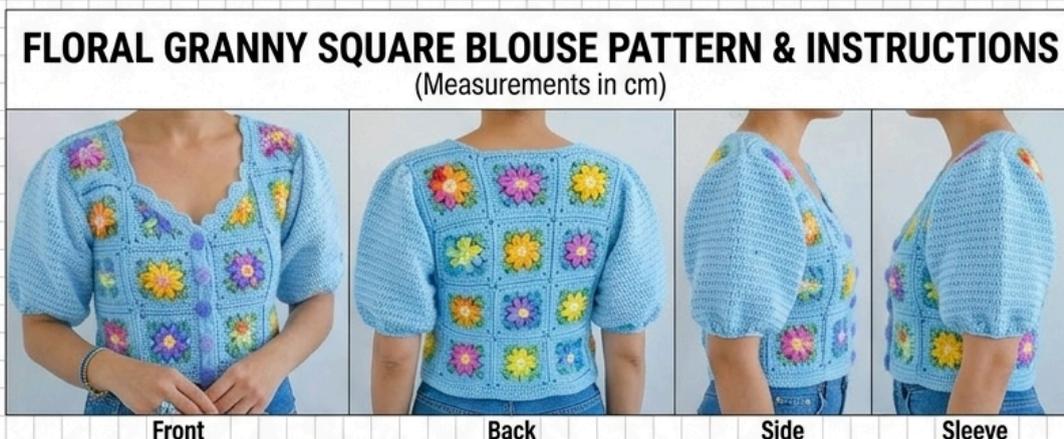


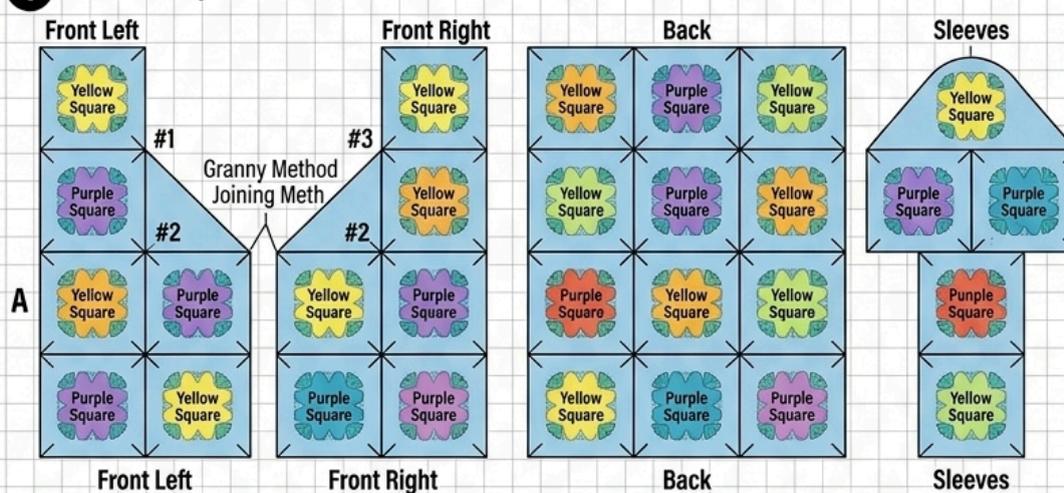
# Crochet Floral Granny Square Blouse Pattern

## Overview

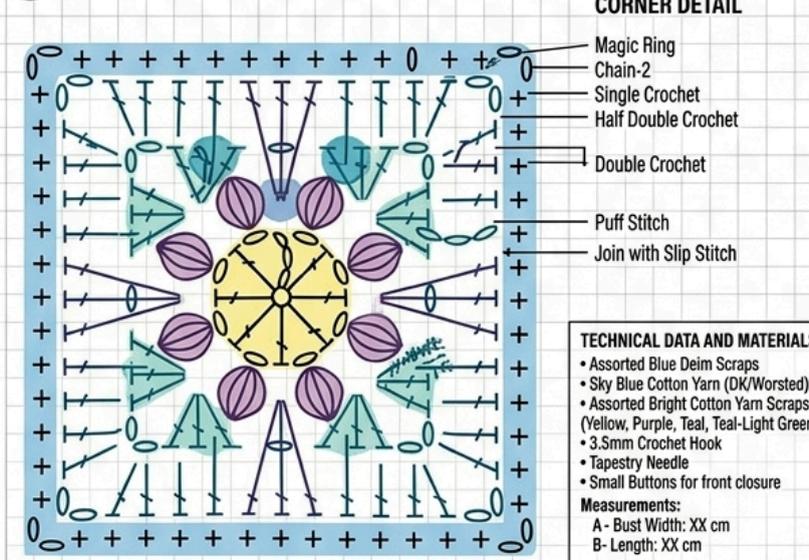
A colorful and feminine blouse made from floral granny squares joined together, featuring a fitted body and soft puff sleeves. This design combines classic crochet motifs with modern shaping.



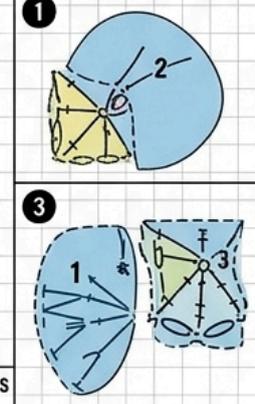

### PUFF SLEEVE ASSEMBLY



- CROCHET TIPS**
- Use correct hook size for your yarn.
  - Blocking all squares before assembly is highly recommended.
  - Maintain consistent puff stitch size.
  - Join squares using the invisible join method for clean seams.
  - Double-check your truncated triangle joins to ensure symmetric shaping.

## Materials

- DK or worsted weight cotton yarn
    - Base color (e.g., sky blue)
    - Flower colors (yellow, purple, pink, green)
  - 3.0–4.0 mm crochet hook
  - Yarn needle
  - Scissors
  - Stitch markers
  - Small buttons (optional, for front closure)
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## Abbreviations (US Terms)

- ch = chain
  - sl st = slip stitch
  - sc = single crochet
  - hdc = half double crochet
  - dc = double crochet
  - puff st = puff stitch
  - sp = space
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## Granny Square Pattern (Floral Motif)

### Round 1 (Center)

- Magic ring

- ch 3 (counts as dc)
- Work 11 dc into ring
- Join with sl st (12 stitches)

### **Round 2 (Petals)**

- ch 1
- (*puff st, ch 1*) in each stitch around
- Join with sl st
- (12 puff stitches)

### **Round 3 (Color Change – Base)**

- Join new color in any ch-1 space
- (*3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc*) in next space (corner)
- (*3 dc in next space*) repeat
- Form square with 4 corners
- Join with sl st

### **Round 4 (Square Expansion)**

- ch 3
- dc in each stitch
- In corners: (*2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc*)
- Join and fasten off

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## **Quantity of Squares**

- Front Left: 6 squares
- Front Right: 6 squares
- Back: 9 squares
- Sleeves: 4 squares each

(Adjust quantity depending on size)

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## Assembly Layout

### Front Panels

- Arrange squares in 2 columns (left and right)
- Leave space at top center for neckline shaping

### Back Panel

- 3 × 3 grid of squares

### Sleeves

- Arrange squares vertically
  - Shape top for puff effect
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## Joining Method

- Use slip stitch or whip stitch
  - Join squares edge-to-edge
  - Work on wrong side for cleaner finish
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## **Puff Sleeve Assembly**

1. Join sleeve squares into a panel
  2. Fold slightly to create rounded cap
  3. Gather top edge lightly
  4. Attach to armhole
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## **Edging**

### **Neckline**

- Join yarn
- Work sc evenly around
- Optional: add picot edging

### **Hem and Sleeves**

- sc or hdc border
  - Optional decorative edge
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## **Closure (Optional)**

- Add button band on front
  - Crochet buttonholes using ch spaces
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## Sizing Notes

- Add/remove squares to adjust width
  - Use larger hook for looser fit
  - Block all squares before assembly
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## Finishing

- Weave in all ends
  - Block blouse to shape
  - Light steam (if yarn allows)
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## Tips

- Keep square size consistent
- Use stitch markers for alignment
- Block squares before joining for best results
- Choose contrasting flower colors for a vibrant look
