

Crochet Heart Rooster Rug – Full Step-by-Step Pattern (U.S. Terms)

This detailed tutorial will guide you through making a **heart-shaped crochet rug with rooster appliques**, based closely on the template. It's designed to be clear enough for beginners while still producing a polished, sturdy result ❤️🐔

HEART ROOSTER CROCHET RUG TEMPLATE & INSTRUCTIONS

(Measurements in cm)

#1 HEART BASE (Tan Wash-adapt to yarn colors) - qty 1

#6 Heart Border Trim (Dark / Medium Tan - adapt to yarn colors)

Pattern Pieces #2 (Body, sc)

Pattern Piece #4 (Feathers)

#4 Attach feathers #D to appliques #2/#3

#5 1 cm
nose : 3 cm

BORDER TRIM STITCH PATTERN

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ROOSTER APPLIQUE ASSEMBLY

Yarn change #A)
Beaks #B)
Feet #f (#C)
Tail feathers #D)

GRASS APPLIQUE PATTERN

#2 ROOSTER A (Tan Wash-adapt to yarn colors, Creme body) - qty 1

8cm

#3 ROOSTER B (Dark Wash-adapt to yarn colors, Brown body) - qty 1

#4 Tail Feathers Green Grass Detail (Green Yarn)- qty 1

#6 Heart Border Trim (Dark/Medium Tan - adapt to yarn colors) - qty 1

MATERIALS NEEDED

- Assorted Colored Crochet Yarn (Tan, Creme, Brown, Red, Green, etc. - specify colors seen in <IMAGE 0>)
- [Tapestry Needle]
- Stuffing material - *This is a rug, but I'll add a 'form stability' tip instead*
- fabric glue for securing details

MATERIALS NEEDED

- Assorted Colored Crochet Yarn (Tant tan, Brown, Red, Green, etc. - qty.)
- Cottors cct specifys seen in col/colors1)
- [moss neet #D]

CROCHET TIPS

- Use correct hook size for your yarn.
- Attach appliques securely.
- Form stability: Consider a light stiffening agent for better rug form.
- Embroidery details for combs and beaks.
- Reinforce all appliques with secure stitching.
- Stitch pattern notes: Main heart base is sc rounds; border is lacy trim; roosters are sc/hdc with surface stitch details (like feathers #D).

FINISHED HEART ROOSTER RUG REFERENCE



Materials Needed

- Medium to bulky weight yarn:
 - Tan / beige (main heart base)
 - Creme (Rooster A body)
 - Brown (Rooster B body)
 - Red (combs & wattles)
 - Yellow/orange (beaks & feet)
 - Green (grass + tail feathers)
- Crochet hook (size appropriate for your yarn, usually 4.5–6 mm)
- Tapestry needle
- Stitch marker
- Fabric glue (optional)
- Non-slip rug backing (optional but recommended)



Crochet Notes (U.S. Terms)

- MR = Magic Ring
- sc = single crochet
- hdc = half double crochet
- dc = double crochet
- inc = increase
- dec = decrease
- sl st = slip stitch

👉 Work in continuous rounds unless noted

👉 Keep stitches tight for rug durability



Step 1: Heart Base (Piece #1)

Using tan yarn:

Start as a **large oval base**, then shape into a heart.

1. MR, 6 sc
2. Round 2: inc around (12)
3. Round 3: (1 sc, inc) ×6 (18)
4. Continue increasing evenly to form a flat circle

Make **two circles** of equal size (these form the two lobes of the heart).

Join to form heart:

5. Place circles side-by-side
6. Join with sc across both pieces
7. Continue crocheting around entire shape

Shape the point:

8. On lower section:
 - Use decreases to form a point
9. Continue rounds until size is approx:
 - Width: ~21.5 cm
 - Height: ~38 cm

Fasten off and weave in ends.



Step 2: Heart Border Trim (Piece #6)

Using darker tan yarn:

Attach yarn to edge of heart.

Pattern idea (lacy border from diagram):

1. *(sc, skip 1 stitch, 5 dc in next stitch, skip 1 stitch)*
2. Repeat around entire edge

👉 This creates a scalloped decorative border

👉 Keep spacing even for symmetry

Fasten off neatly.



Step 3: Rooster Appliqué A (Piece #2 – Light Rooster)

Using creme yarn:

1. Chain a base that matches ~12.5 cm width
2. Work in rows using sc and hdc to shape body
3. Increase at chest, decrease toward tail

Add details:

- Comb & wattle → red yarn
- Beak → yellow/orange
- Eye → small black stitch

Fasten off, leave tail for sewing.

Step 4: Rooster Appliqué B (Piece #3 – Dark Rooster)

Using brown yarn:

Repeat same shaping as Rooster A.

Adjust:

- Body color: brown
- Tail: green tones
- Comb/beak same as above

👉 Make sure both roosters face each other symmetrically

Step 5: Tail Feathers (Piece #4)

Using green yarn:

1. Chain a base (~6–7 cm)
2. Work elongated shapes using:
 - dc, hdc, sc combinations
3. Create **curved feather strands**

Make multiple strands and attach together at base.

Sew onto rooster bodies.

Step 6: Grass Appliqué (Piece #5)

Using green yarn:

1. Chain ~5 stitches
2. In each stitch:
 - Work (*sc, hdc, dc*) to create spikes
3. Repeat for layered grass look

Attach at bottom of heart.

Step 7: Assemble Appliqués

1. Position roosters in center of heart
2. Place them facing each other
3. Add grass underneath

Secure everything:

- Sew with tapestry needle
- Or use fabric glue (optional)

 Reinforce stitching for durability

Step 8: Embroidery Details

Using embroidery thread or yarn:

- Outline feathers
- Add wing texture lines
- Define comb and beak edges

This step brings the design to life 🎨

Step 9: Final Reinforcement

- Check all seams
- Reinforce appliqué edges
- Weave in all loose ends

Optional:

- Add non-slip backing
- Lightly block the rug to shape
