

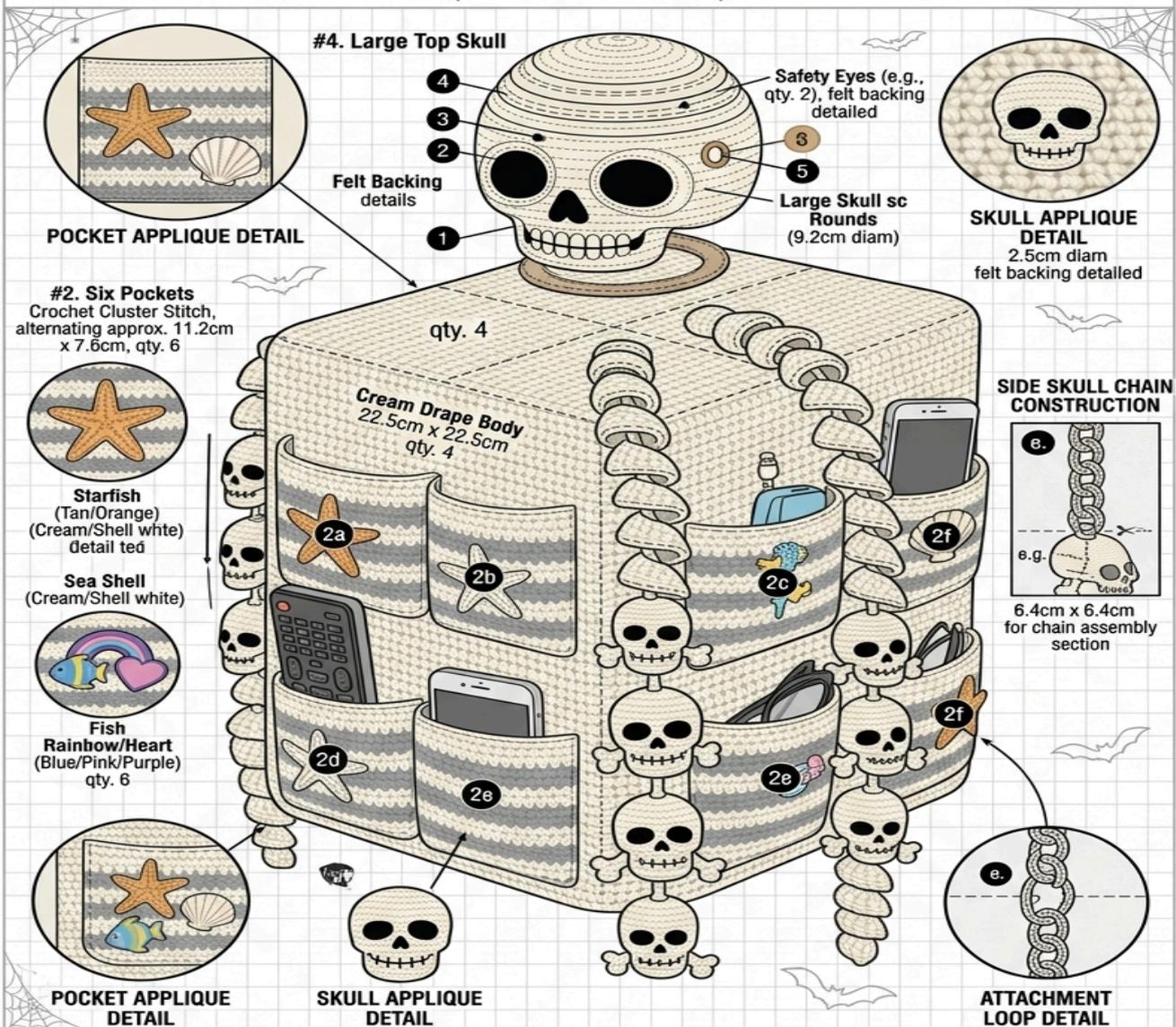


# Crochet Skull Armrest Organizer (U.S. Terms)

## Finished Size (approx.)

- Main cube: 22.5 cm x 22.5 cm (8.8" x 8.8")
- Pockets: 11.2 cm x 7.6 cm (4.4" x 3")
- Large skull: ~9.2 cm (3.6") diameter

## CROCHET SKULL ARMREST ORGANIZER PATTERN & INSTRUCTIONS (Measurements in cm)



### MATERIALS NEEDED

- Cream (e.g., Aran weight) and Grey (e.g., Aran weight) Cotton Yarn
- Black Cotton Yarn (for eye detail) or Safety Eyes
- Small amount of Polyester Fiberfill (for Large Top Skull) (Option: felt for eyes) - Black felt for large skull eyes (Option: felt for backing) - Tan felt backing for eyes and eyelets
- Tan metal eyelets
- 4.0mm and 3.25mm Crochet Hooks
- Tapestry Needle
- Beach-themed appliques (Starfish, Shell, Fish, Rainbow - can be embroidered or pre-made)
- Measuring Tape, Scissors

### CROCHET TIPS (U.S. Terms)

- Use correct hook size for your yarn to achieve correct gauge.
- Invisible Decrease is recommended for head form.
- Reinforce pocket attachments with strong thread or backstitching.
- Large Skull: Start with a Magic Ring (MR) and use tight tension.
- Side Skulls: Ensure neat, consistent rounds.
- Stuff large skull firmly.
- Secure all felt and eyelets neatly.



## Materials

- Worsted weight cotton yarn (Cream + Accent colors)
- Black yarn (eyes/details)
- 4.0 mm (G) crochet hook
- 3.25 mm (D) hook (optional for tighter skulls)
- Fiberfill stuffing
- Tapestry needle
- Scissors
- Stitch markers
- Felt (optional backing for skulls/eyes)
- Safety eyes (optional)



## Abbreviations (U.S.)

- ch = chain
- sc = single crochet
- hdc = half double crochet
- dc = double crochet
- sl st = slip stitch
- inc = increase (2 sc in same stitch)
- dec = decrease (sc2tog)
- st(s) = stitch(es)
- MR = magic ring
- BLO = back loop only



## PART 1: Main Cube Panels (Make 4)

### Base Panel (Textured Fabric)

#### Row 1:

Ch 26, sc in 2nd ch from hook and across (25 sts)

#### Row 2+:

Ch 1, turn, *sc in BLO across*

Repeat until square measures **22.5 cm (~30–32 rows)**

👉 **Make 4 identical panels**



## PART 2: Assembly of Cube

1. Place panels together (right sides facing out)
2. Join using **sl st** or **sc seam** along edges
3. Form a hollow cube
4. Leave bottom slightly open if you want to slide onto armrest



## PART 3: Pockets (Make 6)

### Pocket Base

#### Row 1:

Ch 18, sc across (17 sts)

#### Row 2–10:

Ch 1, turn, hdc across

Fasten off.

### Optional Texture (Striped Look)

Alternate rows:

- Row A: sc
- Row B: hdc

### Attach Pockets

- Position evenly around cube
- Sew sides + bottom only (leave top open)



## PART 4: Appliqués (Optional Decorative)

### ★ Starfish

#### MR:

Ch 1, (*sc, hdc, dc, hdc, sc*) in same stitch → repeat 5 times  
Sl st to close

## **Shell**

Ch 6

Work 5 dc in 2nd ch from hook (fan shape)

## **Fish**

Small oval:

- MR: 6 sc
- Round 2: inc around (12)  
Add tail with ch + sl st

Attach appliqués to pockets.

# **PART 5: Large Skull (Top Piece)**

## **Skull Base**

**Round 1:** MR, 6 sc

**Round 2:** inc around (12)

**Round 3:** (sc, inc) ×6 (18)

**Round 4:** (2 sc, inc) ×6 (24)

**Round 5:** (3 sc, inc) ×6 (30)

**Round 6:** (4 sc, inc) ×6 (36)

**Round 7–10:** sc around

## **Shape Lower Skull (Jaw)**

**Round 11:** (4 sc, dec) ×6 (30)

**Round 12:** (3 sc, dec) ×6 (24)

Stuff firmly.

## **Eye Holes**

Option 1: Safety eyes

Option 2: Crochet circles:

- MR, 6 sc in black yarn, sl st

Sew onto skull.

## Nose

- MR, ch 1, 3 sc  
Shape into triangle

## Teeth

Embroider vertical lines with white or black yarn

# **PART 6: Small Skull Appliqués (Make Many)**

**Round 1:** MR, 6 sc

**Round 2:** inc around (12)

**Round 3:** sc around

Add:

- Eyes: French knots or small circles
- Jaw: embroider line

# **PART 7: Skull Chains (Sides)**

## Chain Base

Ch length  $\approx$  6.4 cm (~10–12 chains)

**Row 1:** sc across

## Attach Skulls

- Sew small skulls spaced evenly along chain
- Make 2–3 chains per side

Attach vertically to cube edges.

## PART 8: Attachment Loops

Make loops to secure organizer to armrest:

Ch 12–15

Sl st to first ch to form loop

Attach to inside edges of cube

## PART 9: Final Assembly

1. Attach large skull to top center
2. Sew chains along vertical edges
3. Attach all appliqués
4. Reinforce pocket seams
5. Weave in all ends



### Tips

- Use **tight tension** for structure
- Cotton yarn works best (less stretch)
- Add cardboard/plastic canvas inside for stiffness
- Customize pocket sizes for phone/remotes

## Optional Upgrades

- Add lining fabric inside pockets
- Use glow-in-the-dark yarn for skulls
- Add elastic band underneath for grip
