

# Crochet Teddy Bear Applique Pattern

US Crochet Terms – Based on the Chart

Skill Level: Beginner – Intermediate

Finished Size: about **10–14 cm (4–5.5 inches)** depending on yarn and hook.

This teddy bear is a **flat crochet applique**, perfect for blankets, baby clothes, pillows, bags, or rugs. The entire bear is crocheted starting from the **head center and expanding outward**, then the **ears, arms, and legs are formed using chains and round stitches**.

## Part 1 – Head

Using **light brown yarn**

Round 1

MR, 12 dc into the ring.

Join with sl st. (12)

Round 2

Ch 2, *dc, inc* repeat around.

Join. (18)

Round 3

Ch 2, 2 *dc, inc* repeat around.

Join. (24)

Round 4

Ch 1, sc around evenly.

Join.

This forms the round head shape seen in the chart.

## Part 2 – Ears (Make directly on head)

Attach yarn to upper side of head.

Ear Round

Ch 2

5 dc in same stitch

Ch 2, sl st same stitch

Skip 3 stitches and repeat for second ear.

## Part 3 – Body

Attach yarn at bottom of head.

Row 1

Ch 2, work 8 dc across bottom half of head.

Row 2

Turn, ch 2.

Work **dc across**, adding **2 increases at each side** to widen the body.

Row 3

Ch 2, turn.

Work dc evenly across.

Row 4

Decrease slightly at sides to shape lower torso.

Fasten off.

## Part 4 – Arms

Attach yarn to side of body.

Round

Ch 4

Work 5 dc into first chain to create a small oval arm.

Sl st back to body.

Repeat on opposite side.

---

## Part 5 – Legs

Attach yarn to bottom of body.

Round 1

Ch 3

Work **8 dc in circle**.

Round 2

Sc around.

Join to body.

Repeat for second leg.

---

## Part 6 – Paw Pads

Using **cream yarn**

Round 1  
MR, 6 sc.

Round 2  
Inc around (12 sc).

Sew onto the legs.

---

## Part 7 – Muzzle

Using **cream yarn**

Round 1  
MR, 8 sc.

Round 2  
Inc every second stitch (12).

Fasten off and sew to center of face.

---

## Part 8 – Face Details

Embroider with brown yarn:

- Small oval nose
- Curved smiling mouth

Attach safety eyes or embroider black eyes above the muzzle.

---

## Optional Border

You can crochet a finishing round around the entire bear:

Round

Attach yarn anywhere and work **sc evenly around the entire shape**.

This gives a cleaner outline.

---

## Tips

- Use cotton yarn for crisp stitch definition.
- Tight stitches help the applique keep its shape.
- You can enlarge it for rugs or blankets using thicker yarn.
