



# Complete Tutorial: Flower pincushion - Pattern

This is a complete pattern and tutorial for making a cheerful flower pincushion 🌸. Here's a clear, simplified breakdown so you can follow it easily:

## TUTORIAL: MAKING THE HAPPY FLOWER PINCUSHION

- Fabric Scraps (see patterns below)
- Stuffing (Fiberfill or Wool)
- Embroidery Floss (Black, Pink)
- Pins (Colored Head Pins)
- Sewing Needle & Thread
- Tracing Paper & Pencils

**Finished Pincushion:**  
Approx. 20 cm Diameter  
x 10 cm Height (excluding pins)





### 1. Pattern Pieces & Layout



**CUT 2**  
(Yellow Fabric, Face)  
Diameter: 12 cm  
Seam Allowance (SA): 1 cm

### 2. Petal Pattern



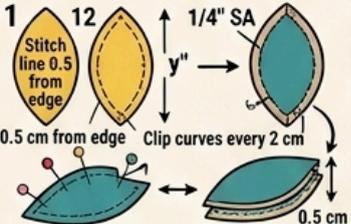
**CUT 12**  
(Assorted Fabrics, see color code)  
10 cm SA: 0.5 cm

### 3. Base Segment Pattern



**CUT 8**  
(Assorted Fabrics, see code below)  
Height: 8 cm  
12 cm

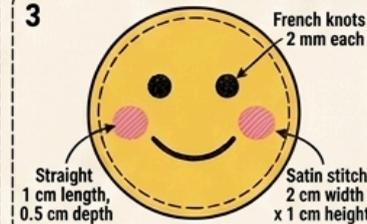
**STEP 1:** Cut & stitch Petal pairs. Trim, turn right-side out, and press. Create 12 finished petals.

#### 2



**STEP 2:** Hand-stitch the base of all 12 petals into a ring.

#### 3



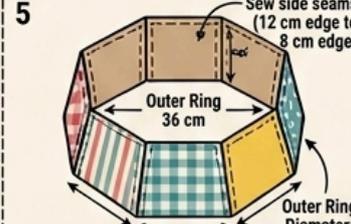
**STEP 3:** Embroider face onto one center circle (French knots for eyes, straight stitches for mouth, satin stitch for cheeks).

#### 4



**STEP 4:** Sew center circles together with SA, turn, stuff. Hand-stitch finished face to center of petal ring.

#### 5



**STEP 5:** Cut and sew base: Sew side seams (12 cm edge to 8 cm edge), using 0.5 cm SA.

#### 6



**STEP 6:** Secure petal unit to base unit. Gather base bottom and sew almost shut. Final stuff and close with a ladder stitch.

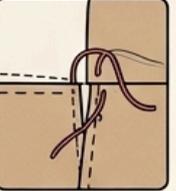
STITCH LEGEND		
	<b>Running Stitch</b>	Even, forward-moving stitches (machine or hand) for seaming.
	<b>Backstitch</b>	Stitches that back up and overlap for a stronger, secure seam.
	<b>Gathering</b>	Running stitches pulled tight to bunch fabric for a ruff or curved shape.
	<b>Ladder Stitch</b>	Invisibly joins two folded edges. Used for final opening closure.
	<b>Embroidery Stitches</b>	French Knots (eyes), Straight Stitches (smile), Satin Stitch (cheeks).
	<b>Quilting Stitch (optional)</b>	Small hand or machine stitches through all layers to bind them. (Not strictly needed here, but included as a legend entry).



**A. TRIM & CLIP:** Crucial for sharp points and smooth curves.



**B. PRESSING:** A vital step for flat, bulk-free seams.



**C. LADDER STITCH:** For seamless hand closure of stuffed items.

**Finished Pincushion:** approx. 20 cm diameter x 10 cm height





## Materials

- Fabric scraps (various colors/patterns)
- Stuffing (fiberfill or wool)
- Embroidery floss (black + pink)
- Pins (optional, decorative)
- Needle & thread
- Tracing paper & pencil



## Pattern Pieces

### 1. Center Circles (Face)

- Cut **2 circles**
- Diameter: **12 cm**
- Seam allowance: **1 cm**

### 2. Petals

- Cut **12 petals**
- Length: **10 cm**
- Seam allowance: **0.5 cm**

### 3. Base Segments

- Cut **8 pieces**
- Height: **8 cm**
- Width: **12 cm (top & bottom)**



## Step-by-Step Instructions

### STEP 1: Make Petals

- Sew petals in pairs (right sides together)
- Turn right-side out and press
- Clip curves for smooth edges
- You should have **12 finished petals**

### STEP 2: Form the Flower

- Hand-stitch all petals together at the base
- Arrange into a ring
- Keep spacing even (~1.5 cm between stitches)

### STEP 3: Embroider the Face 😊

- Use:
  - French knots → eyes
  - Straight stitch → smile
  - Satin stitch → cheeks

### STEP 4: Assemble Center

- Sew the two circle pieces together (leave gap)
- Turn, stuff, and close gap
- Attach center to petal ring

### STEP 5: Make the Base

- Sew the 8 base panels together into a ring
- Join top and bottom edges
- This creates a rounded cushion base

### STEP 6: Final Assembly

- Attach flower top to base
- Gather bottom with thread
- Stuff firmly
- Close with ladder stitch

## Helpful Stitch Guide

- **Running stitch** → basic seams
- **Backstitch** → stronger seams
- **Gathering stitch** → shaping base
- **Ladder stitch** → invisible closing
- **Embroidery stitches** → face details

## Finished Size

- Approx. **20 cm diameter**
- Approx. **10 cm height**
