This step-by-step guide is based on the chart you provided and written so beginners and experienced crocheters alike can follow from start to finish.





### ROUND 1: THE TEAL FLOWER CORE

(3 dc, ch 1) x 5


-  ch: Chain

-  Scallop pattern: (3 dc, ch 1)







### ROUND 2: ADDING THE LAYERED PETALS




#### Petal Stacks key

## Materials You'll Need

- Worsted weight yarn in:
  - Teal (main flower)
  - Yellow (center + star)
  - Optional: White (if attaching pearl)
- Crochet hook (recommended: 4.0–5.0 mm / G–H)
- Yarn needle (for sewing and invisible join)
- Scissors
- Optional: Pearl bead for center embellishment



## Stitch Abbreviations (US Terms)

- ch = chain
- sc = single crochet
- dc = double crochet
- hdc = half double crochet
- tr = treble crochet
- sl st = slip stitch

Special stitch:

- **Scallop (flower petal)** = (3 dc, ch 1) in same space
- **dc cluster** = group of dc stitches worked together in same space



## Round 1: The Teal Flower Core

### ◆ Step 1: Create the Center Ring

1. Start with **yellow yarn**.
2. Make a **magic ring** (or ch 4 and sl st to form a ring).
3. Ch 2 (counts as first dc).

### ◆ Step 2: Form the Base Round

1. Work **dc stitches into the ring** evenly to create a circular base.
2. Join with a **sl st** to the top of the starting ch.

### ◆ Step 3: Create the Scallop Petals

1. Switch to **teal yarn**.
2. (3 dc, ch 1) in the same stitch/space → this forms one scallop.
3. Repeat this **5 times total** to create 5 rounded petals.
4. Join with sl st.



You should now have a small teal flower with 5 petals.

## Round 2: Adding the Layered Petals

This round builds the large mandala structure with layered depth.

### ◆ Step 4: Begin Layering

1. Insert hook into a **ch-1 space from Round 1**.
2. Work:
  - ch 2
  - dc
  - dc
  - ch 2

(This creates a petal base cluster.)

### ◆ Step 5: Continue Around

1. Repeat the cluster (*ch 2, dc, dc, ch 2*) in each **ch-1 space**.
2. This builds the **first layer of outer petals**.

### ◆ Step 6: Add Additional Petal Layers

1. Work **dc clusters into ch-1 spaces** from:
  - Round 1
  - Then Round 2 (as indicated in chart layering)
2. Alternate colors if desired (teal + yellow for depth).

👉 Important:

- Always place clusters into **chain spaces**, not stitches.
- This creates the stacked petal effect.

## Creating the Pointed Petal Edges

### ◆ Step 7: Shape the Points

To form the sharp petal tips:

1. Work sequences like:
  - ch 2
  - ch 1
  - sc
  - ch 2
  - dc
2. Repeat around each petal.

👉 This gives the mandala its signature pointed floral shape.

## ★ Optional Component: Yellow Star Base

### ◆ Step 8: Crochet the Star

1. Using **yellow yarn**, create a small star:
  - Work in a round
  - Build 5 pointed arms using chains and dc/tr stitches
2. Fasten off and weave in ends.

## Assembly Instructions

### ◆ Step 9: Attach Star to Mandala

1. Place the **yellow star behind or under the mandala center**.
2. Sew using yarn needle through the middle stitches.

### ◆ Step 10: Add Pearl (Optional)

1. Thread yarn through the center.
2. Attach the **pearl bead** securely.
3. Knot and hide yarn ends.

## Invisible Join Technique

### ◆ Step 11: Clean Finishing

1. Cut yarn, leaving a tail.
2. Thread needle.
3. Insert under the top loops of the first stitch.
4. Pull through gently to mimic a stitch.
5. Weave in ends.

👉 This creates a seamless finish instead of a visible slip stitch join.

## ✨ Final Tips for Success

- Always crochet **loosely enough** to keep petals flexible.
- Blocking your finished mandala helps define the shape.
- Use stitch markers if you lose track of chain spaces.
- Keep consistent tension for even layering.
