

Stylish Skirt and Bustier Set Pattern (Denim, Lace, Floral & Tulle)

This detailed sewing pattern guides you through creating a layered, romantic skirt and structured bustier using recycled denim, lace, floral fabrics, and tulle. The design features cascading ruffles, mixed textures, and decorative embroidery.

**MODELING GUIDE AND INSTRUCTIONS:
EMBROIDERED FLORAL DENIM SKIRTS AND CORSET SET**

SAIA

#1: Waist Panel
(Medium Wash Denim) - x 1

#2: Riveted Waistband - x 1

#3: Upper Tier 1
(Denim + Wide Lace) - x 1

#4: Upper Tier 2
(Denim + Thin Lace) - x 1

#5: Mid Tier 1
(Denim with Rose Print + Wide Lace) - x 2
(specify print orientation)

#6: Mid Tier 2
(French Tulle + Thin Lace) - x 2

#7: Lower Rear Tier
(Medium Wash Denim with Rose Embroidery + Wide Lace + Tulle) - x 1
(note elongated shape)

CORPETE

#8: Denim Corset
(Medium Wash Denim) - x 1

#9: Chest Flounce
(Denim + Pleated Tulle + Lace) - x 1

DETAIL OF EMBROIDERY AND BUTTONS

EMBROIDERY AND BUTTON DETAIL

Decorative Metal Buttons

3D EMBROIDERY APPLIQUE
(Roses)
Apply by hand in specified positions

TECHNICAL DATA AND MATERIALS

- Assorted Blue Denim Scraps (Light, Medium Wash)
- Pleated Tulle (Cream Color)
- Wide and Narrow Lace (Cream/Ivory)
- Denim Fabric Printed with Roses
- 3D Rose Embroidery Applique
- Decorative Metal Buttons
- Metal Rivets (Waist)
- Backing Fabric (51cm x 46cm) (keep original reference)

SEWING TIPS

- Use a denim needle and strong sewing thread.
- Stitch close to patch edges to secure firmly. (keep reference)
- Reinforce pocket attachments with backstitching. (keep reference)
- Flounce layers: Pre-assemble and sew one by one.

MEASUREMENT SCALE (cm)

- Estimated standard dimensions for reference. Size M:
- Skirt Hem Width: 180cm
- High Hem Height: 45cm
- Low Hem Height: 110cm
- (Add precise callouts on main pieces as detailed above)

#3: 35 cm top, 45 cm bottom, 18 cm height

#2: 12 cm top, 18 cm height

#5: 155 cm top, 118 cm height

#6: 10 cm top, 118 cm height

#7: 180 cm width

Finished Size (Reference – Size M)

Skirt waist: adjustable (approx. 70–75 cm)
Skirt length: 45 cm (front) to 110 cm (back)
Hem width: approx. 180 cm

Bustier height: approx. 32–33 cm
Bust panels: segmented (approx. 10–12 cm each section)

Skill Level

Intermediate to Advanced (due to layering, shaping, and mixed fabrics)

Materials Needed

Denim (light and medium wash – recycled jeans recommended)
Floral printed fabric (rose patterns preferred)
Tulle (cream or soft tone)
Lace (wide and narrow types)
Lining fabric (cotton recommended)
Decorative buttons (metal or vintage style)
Metal rivets (optional for waistband)
3D floral appliqués (optional)
Boning (for bustier structure)
Zipper or lacing (closure option)
Thread (matching and strong for denim)

Pattern Pieces

Skirt

#1 Waist Panel – cut 1
#2 Waistband – cut 1
#3 Upper Tier 1 (denim + wide lace) – cut 1
#4 Upper Tier 2 (denim + thin lace) – cut 1
#5 Mid Tier 1 (floral denim + lace) – cut 2
#6 Mid Tier 2 (tulle + lace) – cut 2
#7 Lower Rear Tier (elongated back panel) – cut 1

Bustier

#8 Corset Base Panels – cut multiple (depending on size)

#9 Chest Flounce (lace + tulle layers) – cut 1

Add 1 cm seam allowance to all pieces

Cutting Instructions

Cut denim pieces from recycled jeans for varied tones

Ensure floral fabric orientation is consistent

Cut tulle slightly wider for gathering effect

Prepare lace trims according to tier widths

Sewing Instructions

Skirt Construction

Waist Section

Attach waistband (#2) to waist panel (#1)

Add interfacing for structure

Optional: install rivets for decorative effect

Upper Tiers

Sew #3 and #4 panels separately

Attach lace trim along bottom edges

Gather slightly to create soft ruffle effect

Attach tiers to waist panel, layering from top to bottom

Mid Tiers

Sew #5 (floral panels)

Add lace overlay

Repeat with #6 (tulle layers)

Gather each tier and attach below upper tiers

Tip: sew each layer individually before stacking

Lower Rear Tier

Attach #7 at back only

Ensure longer length for high-low effect

Add multiple ruffle layers for volume

Hem Finishing

Finish edges with lace or rolled hem
Ensure smooth transition between front and back

Bustier Construction

Panel Assembly

Sew corset panels (#8) together vertically
Press seams open
Insert boning channels along seams

Shaping

Curve seams slightly inward at waist
Ensure snug fit

Top Edge

Attach flounce (#9) using lace + tulle layers
Gather lightly for soft volume

Closure

Option 1: back zipper
Option 2: lace-up back with eyelets

Finishing

Line inside with cotton fabric
Topstitch edges for durability

Embellishment

Attach floral appliqués to skirt and bustier
Focus on asymmetrical placement for modern look
Sew decorative buttons on bustier front

Assembly Tips

Work in layers: complete each tier before attaching
Use strong needle for denim fabrics
Press seams frequently for clean finish
Reinforce stress points (waistband, bust seams)

Ruffle Guidelines

Light gather: 1.3x fabric width

Medium gather: 1.5x

Full ruffle: 2x width

Use longer stitches for gathering ease

Customization Ideas

Use colored denim for bold designs

Add more tiers for dramatic volume

Replace lace with mesh for modern style

Incorporate patchwork denim pieces

Final Finishing

Trim all threads

Press entire garment carefully

Check fit and adjust waist or bust if needed

Add final decorative elements (buttons, embroidery, appliqués)

This set combines structure and softness, making it ideal for statement outfits or upcycled fashion projects.
