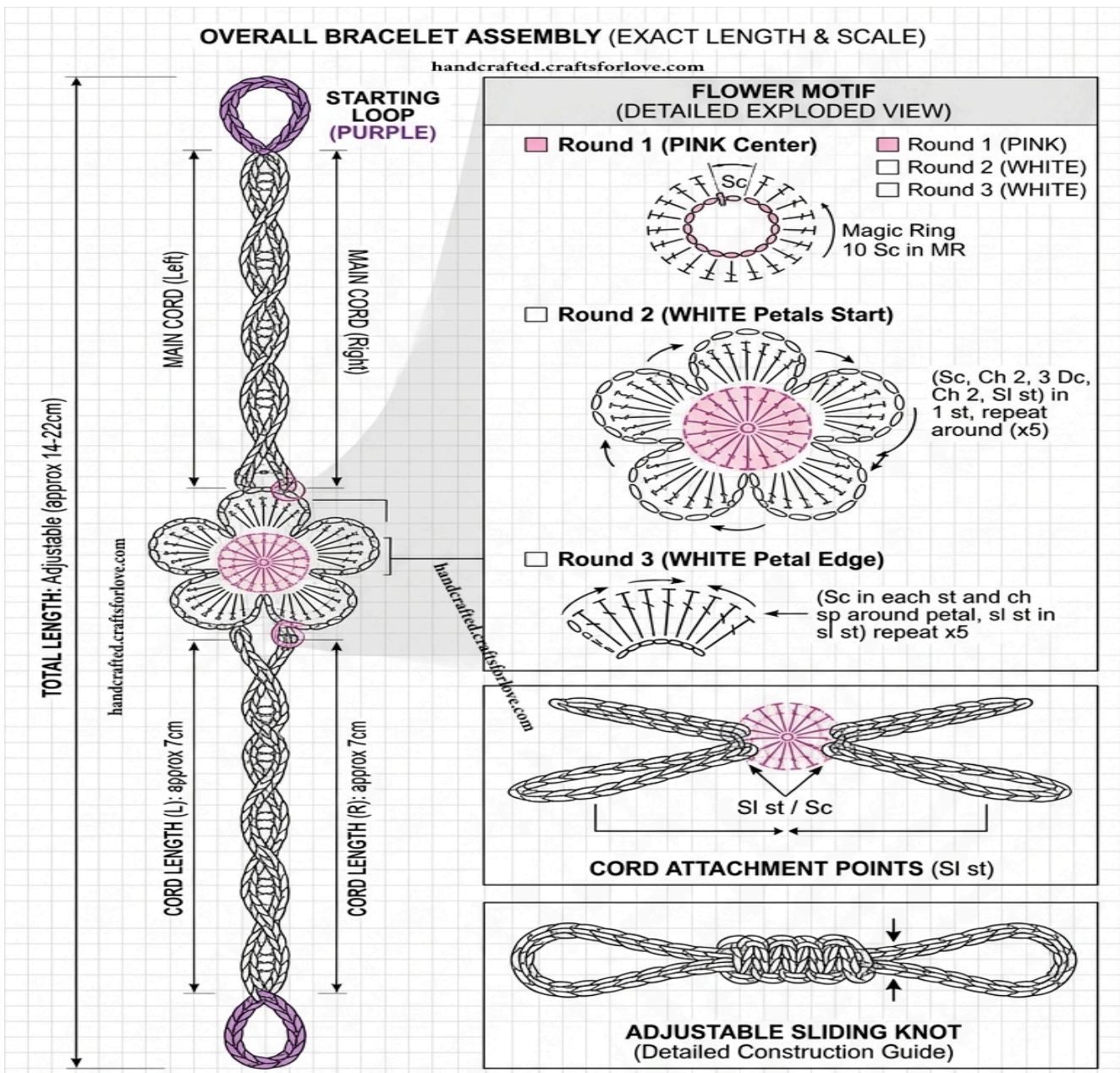


# Crochet Bracelet Flower Pattern

## Materials & Tools

- Cotton yarn in:
  - Pink (flower center)
  - White (petals)
  - Purple (loops)
- Crochet hook (size appropriate for your yarn, typically 2.5–3.5 mm)
- Scissors

STITCH SYMBOL KEY (US Crochet)					
	<b>CHAIN (CH)</b> Foundation stitch and loop formation.		<b>DOUBLE CROCHET (DC)</b> Tall, loose stitch for petal height.		<b>SLIP STITCH (SL ST)</b> Connecting rounds or pieces, moving position.
	<b>SINGLE CROCHET (SC)</b> Base and tight texture stitch.		<b>MAGIC RING (MR)</b> (2 Sc in 1 St, 2 Dc in 1 St) Adjustable starting technique.		<b>REVERSE SINGLE CROCHET (Crab Stitch)</b> Optional textured edge detail.
	<b>DOUBLE CROCHET (DC)</b> Tall, loose stitch for petal height.		<b>DECREASE (DEC)</b> (Sc2tog) Joining stitches to taper shape.		<b>ATTACHMENT POINTS (JOIN)</b>

## Finished Size

- Total length: approx. 14–22 cm (adjustable)
- Each cord length: approx. 7 cm (left and right)



## Stitch Abbreviations (US Terms)

- CH = Chain <https://handcrafted.craftsforlove.com/> **SEE THE BEST PATTERNS**
- SC = Single Crochet
- DC = Double Crochet
- SL ST = Slip Stitch
- MR = Magic Ring
- DEC = Decrease (sc2tog)



## Step 1: Flower Motif – Round 1 (Pink Center)

1. Start with **pink yarn**.
2. Create a **Magic Ring (MR)**.
3. Work **10 SC** into the **MR**.
4. Join with a **SL ST** into the first SC.

✓ You now have a small circular center.



## Step 2: Flower Motif – Round 2 (White Petals Start)

1. Switch to **white yarn**.
2. In the same stitch:
  - SC, CH 2, 3 DC, CH 2, SL ST (all in same stitch → forms one petal)
3. Skip to the next stitch and repeat:
  - (SC, CH 2, 3 DC, CH 2, SL ST)
4. Repeat this sequence **5 times total** around the circle.

✓ You should now have **5 petals forming**.



## Step 3: Flower Motif – Round 3 (White Petal Edge)

1. Continue with **white yarn**.
2. For each petal:
  - SC in each stitch and each chain space around the petal
  - SL ST at the base of the petal
3. Repeat for all **5 petals**.

✓ This step smooths and defines the petal edges.

## Step 4: Cord Attachment Points

1. Identify two opposite spaces between petals.
2. Attach yarn at one side using:
  - SL ST or SC to secure
3. Repeat on the opposite side.

✓ These points will connect the cords to the flower.

## Step 5: Create the Left and Right Cords

You will make two cords (one on each side).

1. Attach yarn at one attachment point.
2. Chain to desired length:
  - Approx. **7 cm**
3. Work back along the chain:
  - SL ST or SC in each chain stitch (for a sturdy cord)
4. Fasten off.
5. Repeat on the opposite side for the second cord.

✓ You now have two symmetrical cords.

## Step 6: Create the Starting Loop (Purple)

1. Attach **purple yarn** at the end of one cord.
2. Chain enough stitches to form a small loop.
3. Join with SL ST to create a closed loop.
4. Reinforce by working SC around the loop if desired.

✓ This loop will be used to fasten the bracelet.

## Step 7: Adjustable Sliding Knot

1. Take both cord ends on the opposite side.
2. Overlap them slightly.
3. Using a separate piece of yarn:
  - Wrap around both cords 5–7 times
  - Pull ends through the wrap to secure (sliding knot technique)
4. Tighten gently.

✓ This allows the bracelet to adjust in size.

## **Step 8: Final Assembly & Adjustments**

- Check symmetry of cords
- Trim excess yarn
- Weave in all loose ends with a yarn needle
- Test sliding knot for smooth adjustment

## **Tips for Best Results**

- Keep tension even, especially in petals
- Use stitch markers if needed for petal placement
- If petals curl, lightly block the flower
- Adjust cord length for wrist size
