

Amigurumi House with Sunflower Pattern

Materials & Tools

- Worsted weight yarn:
 - Green (base, stem, leaves)
 - Cream (walls)
 - Coral & Lavender (roof + rug)
 - Yellow (petals)
 - Brown (sunflower center)
- Crochet hook: 3.5–4.0 mm (E–G)
- Stitch markers
- Yarn needle
- Fiberfill stuffing (light amount)
- Craft wire (for stem support)
- Safety eyes or beads (optional center detail)

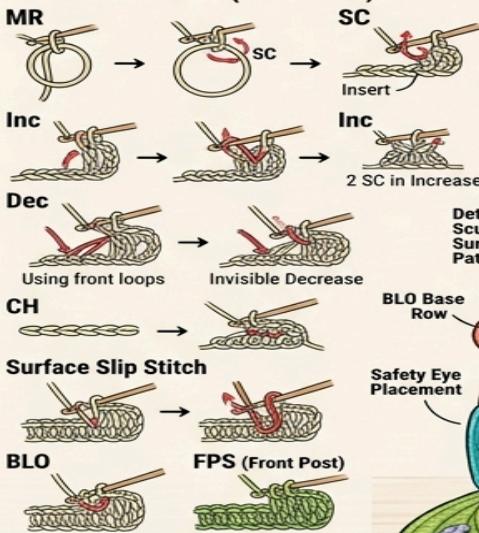
COMPLETE TUTORIAL: CROCHET SUNFLOWER FAIRY HOUSE DIORAMA (US TERMS)

PART 1: THE FAIRY HOUSE

1. MATERIALS REQUIRED

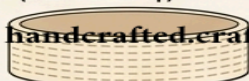


2. STITCH GUIDE (US Terms)



3. House Pattern

Walls (Start Bottom-Up)



Color: Cream. ch desired length (approx. 20 cm / 8 inches), join in circle.
Rnd 1-X: sc around until wall height reached. Fasten off and weave in ends.

Roof (Color Striping)

Color: Coral/Pink.
(Rnd X+1) BLO sc around, inc rounds to roof size.



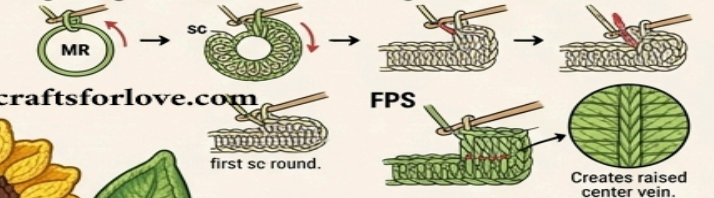
Rnd X+2: Transition to Lavender, sc around. Alternate colors every X rows. Finish with Lavender at the peak.
 Pattern for specific increasing counts. Attach miniature windows to wall.
 Sew complete roof piece over wall piece.

PART 2: THE SUNFLOWER & DIORAMA

4. MATERIALS REQUIRED (Additional)



5. STITCH GUIDE handcrafted.craftsforlove.com



6. PATTERN (Row-by-Row)

Main Mat (Row-by-Row work, Size 7 hook): ch length (approx. 20 cm / 8 inches), sc in rows, alternate Mixed Green and Light Green stripe colors to match the house panel. Finish with decorative Cream edge. Pattern for a multi-layered effect.

Sunflower

Center (Color: Brown): MR with 6 sc, inc pattern to size. FPS rows for texture.
Petals (Color: Yellow): Join Yellow yarn to center piece.
Pattern: (ch 2, dc, dc cluster, ch 1, dc cluster, ch 1 cluster, ch 1, rep) for petals: ch 2, dc 2, ch 1, ch 1.

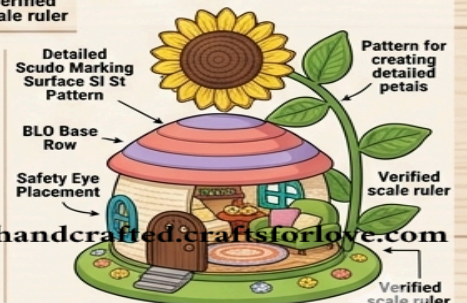
Assemble: Add Poly-fill, sew petals around center piece.

Stem and Leaves

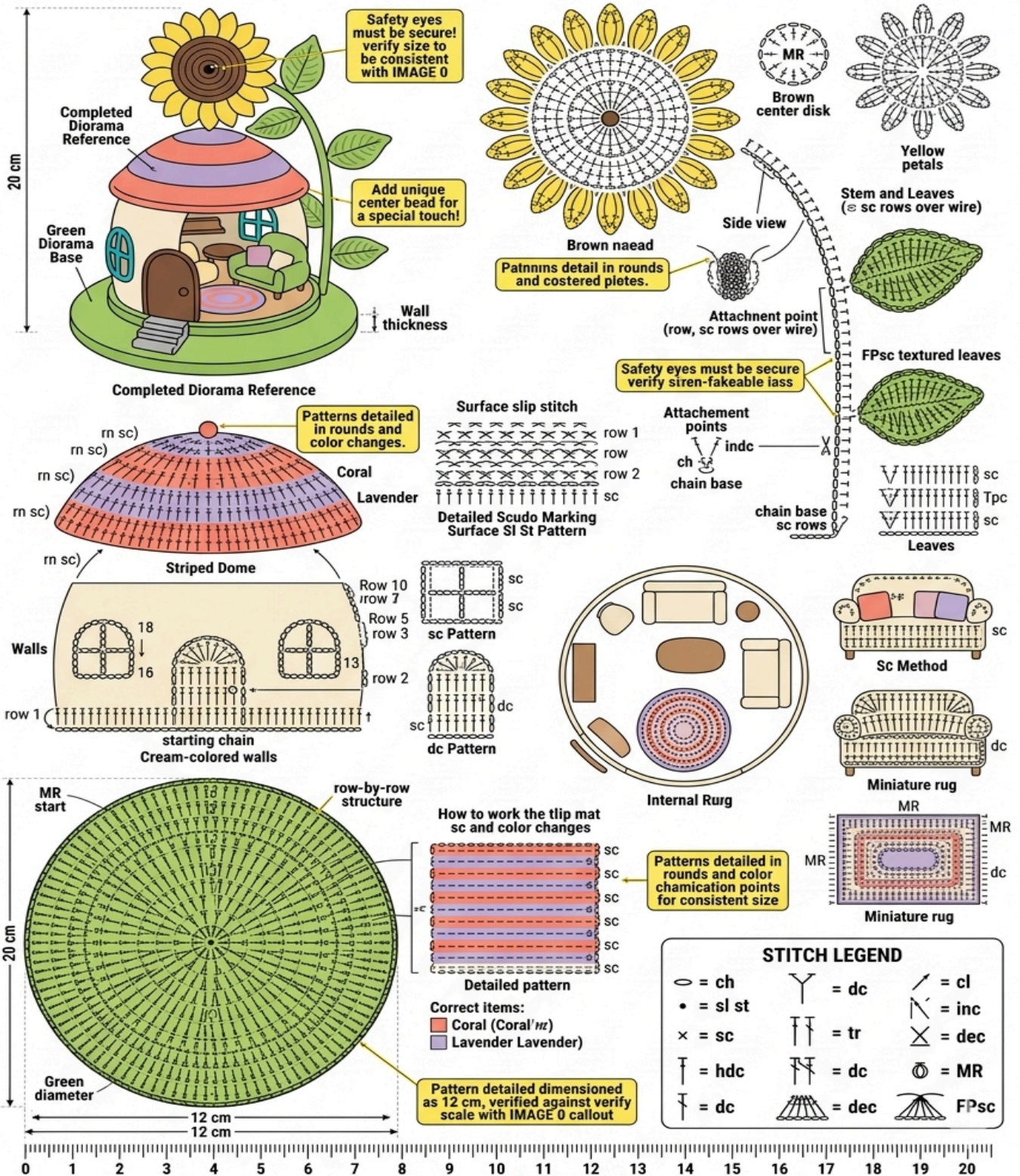
Stem: ch with wire inset. Dark Green sc rows around wire, transition to Light Green for upper sections. Attach finished leaves.
Pattern for leaves with Front Post Vein detail.
 Attach finished Sunflower head to stem.

7. FINAL ASSEMBLY & TOUCHES

1. Block all main pieces for flat shape.
 2. Securely sew completed House piece to Center Diorama base.
 3. Attach finished Sunflower to stem and position behind house.
 4. Attach all miniature furniture and items.
 5. Perform final weaving and trim.
- Pattern detailed dimensions (e.g., base diameter 20 cm, total height 30 cm) and callouts for correct items and colors are listed.
 Scale verified with <MAGE> callout.



US CROCHET PATTERN DIAGRAM: SUNFLOWER FAIRY HOUSE



Abbreviations (US Terms)

- ch = chain <https://handcrafted.craftsforlove.com/> SEE THE BEST PATTERNS
- sl st = slip stitch
- sc = single crochet
- hdc = half double crochet
- dc = double crochet
- tr = treble crochet
- inc = increase (2 stitches in same stitch)
- dec = decrease
- MR = magic ring
- FPsc = front post single crochet

Step 1: Green Base (Round Diorama Platform)

This is the circular foundation (approx. 12 cm diameter).

1. Start with MR.
2. Round 1: 6 sc into MR.
3. Round 2: inc in each stitch (12).
4. Round 3: (1 sc, inc) repeat (18).
5. Round 4: (2 sc, inc) repeat (24).
6. Continue increasing evenly each round until diameter reaches ~12 cm.

Tip: Keep the circle flat. If it curls, add more increases.

Fasten off and weave in ends.

Step 2: Cream Walls

Worked in rows to form a rectangle, then shaped.

1. Chain a base long enough to wrap around the base.
2. Row 1: sc across.
3. Continue rows in sc until wall height is reached (~5–7 cm).

Windows & Door

- Leave gaps in rows for:
 - 2 windows (approx. 16–18 stitches wide)
 - 1 door opening (~13 stitches)

Arches <https://handcrafted.craftsforlove.com/> SEE THE BEST PATTERNS

- Use dc stitches to curve the tops of windows and door.

Do not fasten off yet—this piece will be joined later.

Step 3: Striped Dome Roof

Worked in continuous rounds.

1. MR, 6 sc.
2. Increase each round evenly like the base.
3. Alternate colors:
 - Coral → Lavender → Coral
4. Continue until dome shape forms naturally.

Tip: Stop increasing when it starts curving into a dome.

Fasten off.

Step 4: Surface Slip Stitch Detail

Add texture to the roof:

- Use surface slip stitches across rounds.
- Insert hook from outside → yarn over → pull through → sl st along round.

This creates decorative ridges.

Step 5: Stem (with Wire Support)

1. Insert craft wire as core.
2. Chain length of stem.
3. Row 1: sc along chain.
4. Continue sc rows around wire (or spiral).

Leave a tail for attaching to house and flower.

Step 6: Leaves (Two Styles)

Basic Leaf <https://handcrafted.craftsforlove.com/> SEE THE BEST PATTERNS

1. Chain 8–10.
2. Work along chain:
 - sc, hdc, dc, hdc, sc
3. On opposite side, mirror stitches.

Textured Leaf (FPsc)

- Work same shape but add FPsc around stitches for ribbing.

Make 2–4 leaves.

Step 7: Sunflower Center (Brown Disk)

1. MR.
2. Round 1: 6 sc.
3. Round 2+: increase evenly.
4. Add surface stitching or beads for texture.

Optional: Insert a bead or safety eye in center.



Step 8: Sunflower Petals

Worked around the brown disk.

1. Attach yellow yarn.
2. *ch 3, sl st in next stitch* repeat around.

- (ch 2, dc, ch 2, sl st in same stitch)

Repeat all around.



Step 9: Interior Rug

1. MR.
2. Work in rounds using coral & lavender stripes.
3. Increase evenly to desired size.



Step 10: Mini Furniture (Optional)

Couch (sc or dc method)

- Chain base
- Build rows upward
- Add armrests with decreases

Mini Rug (Rectangular)

- MR or chain base
- Work in rows using dc
- Change colors for border

Step 11: Assembly

1. Attach walls around base using sl st or sewing.
2. Place roof on top and sew securely.
3. Attach door and window edges neatly.
4. Insert stem into base and secure firmly.
5. Attach sunflower to top of stem.
6. Sew leaves along stem.

Step 12: Final Adjustments

- Ensure base is flat.
- Adjust stem angle slightly (wire allows shaping).
- Add interior pieces (rug, furniture).
- Weave in all ends.

Tips for Success

- Use stitch markers to track rounds.
- Keep tension consistent for symmetry.
- Block pieces lightly if needed.
- Customize colors for your own theme.
