

# 🧵 Complete Tutorial: Black & White Snowman Patchwork Wall Hanging

This step-by-step guide walks you through creating a charming black-and-white snowman quilted wall hanging, from preparing materials to final finishing. All measurements are in centimeters (cm), just like in the original diagram.

## COMPLETE TUTORIAL: BLACK & WHITE SNOWMAN PATCHWORK WALL HANGING (Everything Detailed in One Page)

### STAGE 1: PATTERN PREP & GATHER MATERIALS

Base Blocks: (4x) [handcrafted.craftsforlove.com](https://handcrafted.craftsforlove.com)

Base Fabric: CM CM  
 ■ Black (0.5m)  
 □ White (0.5m)

Appliqué Fabric:  
 ■ Solid Black  
 ■ Solid White  
 □ Specific patterned for scarfs/hats

Interfacing (fusible):  
 □ for snowman bodies

Threads:  
 □ White  
 ■ Specific patterned for topstitching

Snowman Bodies: (4x)  
 (4x) (4x) (8x) (8x)

### STAGE 2: FORM PATCHWORK TOP

(A) RST (Right Sides Together) (B) Piecing

(A) Join base blocks to form a 2x2 grid

(B) CM CM guideline markers for stitching lines

### STAGE 3: ATTACH SNOWMAN BODIES & FACE DETAILS (Hand or Machine)

(A) Detailed placement guide for the four specific 2x2 base.

(a) Backstitch for smile  
 (c) Thread eyes

### STAGE 4: QUILT LAYERS & TOPSTITCH (Q)

Quilt Sandwich

(A) Machine Quilting

(B) Machine Quilting

(B) Topstitching (Q)

Edge callet

### STAGE 5: ATTACH BINDING & FINISHING (F)

(A) 4cm (e.g., cut from 4cm width patterned fabric strips, 200cm total length)

(B) Standard mitere FST perimeter

(C) Invisible hand ladder stitch for standard back-side

(A) 1cm Apply binding RST (Right Sides Together) to the

1cm finished edge

4cm finished

### STAGE 6: FINAL PROJECT REVIEW & LEGEND

Optional panel

CM size

Final Finished Size: approx. 52cm x 52cm (including binding)

### LEGEND OF KEY US SEWING & QUILT METHODS:

**A** APPLIQUÉ  
Stitching one fabric piece onto another.

**P** PIECING  
Joining varied fabric shapes together.

**Q** QUILTING  
Layering top, batting, backing, and backing.

**TS** TOPSTITCHING  
Visible, decorative, or reinforcement stitching.

**F** FINISHING  
Standard seam finishes and binding.

**RST** RIGHT SIDES TOGETHER

## Stage 1: Pattern Prep & Gather Materials

**Base Blocks** <https://handcrafted.craftsforlove.com/> SEE THE BEST PATTERNS

- Cut **4 squares** of fabric:
  - Size: **25 cm x 25 cm each**
  - Use a mix of:
    - Black fabric
    - White fabric

### **Snowman Bodies & Accessories (Appliqué Pieces)**

Prepare the following fabric shapes:

- **4 snowman bodies**
- **4 hats**
- **4 winter hats (beanies)**
- **8 scarves**
- Optional: mix patterns for scarves and hats for variety

### **Fabric Requirements**

- **Base Fabric:** <https://handcrafted.craftsforlove.com/> SEE THE BEST PATTERNS
  - Black (0.5 m)
  - White (0.5 m)
- **Appliqué Fabric:**
  - Solid black
  - Solid white
  - Patterned fabric (for scarves/hats)
- **Interfacing (fusible):**
  - For stabilizing snowman shapes

### **Thread**

- White thread
- Patterned or contrasting thread (for decorative topstitching)

**Tools** <https://handcrafted.craftsforlove.com/> SEE THE BEST PATTERNS

- Sewing machine
- Iron
- Scissors or rotary cutter
- Pins or clips

## Stage 2: Form the Patchwork Top

### Step A: RST (Right Sides Together)

- Pair your 4 base squares.
- Sew them together with **right sides facing each other**.
- First, join 2 squares to make a row.
- Repeat for the second row.

### Step B: Join Rows <https://handcrafted.craftsforlove.com/> SEE THE BEST PATTERNS

- Sew both rows together to form a **2 x 2 grid**.

### Step C: Piecing Guidelines

- Align seams carefully.
- Final top size: approximately **50 cm x 50 cm**
- Mark **center lines (CM)** horizontally and vertically for alignment.



## Stage 3: Attach Snowman Bodies & Face Details

### Layout Placement <https://handcrafted.craftsforlove.com/> SEE THE BEST PATTERNS

- Each square will contain one snowman.
- Arrange them so each has a unique pose or accessory.

### Appliqué Method

- Use fusible interfacing to secure shapes.
- Position:
  - Snowman body centered in each square
  - Add hats and scarves on top

### Stitching <https://handcrafted.craftsforlove.com/> SEE THE BEST PATTERNS

- Use **appliqué stitching** (machine or hand) to secure pieces.

### Face Details

- Eyes: stitch with thread (small knots or satin stitch)
- Smile: use **backstitch**
- Nose: small triangle (orange fabric or embroidery)

Take your time here—this step brings your snowmen to life 😊

## Stage 4: Quilt Layers & Topstitch

### Quilt Sandwich Assembly

Layer your quilt like this: <https://handcrafted.craftsforlove.com/> SEE THE BEST PATTERNS

1. Backing fabric (bottom layer)
2. Batting (approx. 0.5 cm thick)
3. Pieced top (your snowman quilt)

Make sure all layers are smooth and aligned.

### Machine Quilting Options

- Stitch “in the ditch” along seam lines
- Add vertical or decorative quilting lines across the quilt
- You can also outline shapes like the center cross for emphasis

### Topstitching Details

- Stitch around:
  - Hats
  - Scarves
  - Snowman edges
- This adds dimension and durability

## Stage 5: Attach Binding & Finishing

Prepare Binding <https://handcrafted.craftsforlove.com/> SEE THE BEST PATTERNS

- Cut fabric strips:
  - Width: **4 cm**
  - Total length: about **200 cm**
- Join strips into one long piece

### Attach Binding (RST)

- Place binding **right sides together** with quilt edge
- Sew around the perimeter

**Corners** <https://handcrafted.craftsforlove.com/> **SEE THE BEST PATTERNS**

- Use **standard mitered corners** for clean edges

### **Final Step**

- Fold binding to the back
- Secure using **invisible hand ladder stitch**

Finished binding width: about **1 cm visible edge**



## **Stage 6: Final Project Review & Optional Panel**

### **Finished Size**

- Approximately **52 cm x 52 cm** (including binding)

### **Optional Hanging Panel**

- Add a sleeve or loops on the back for hanging

**Final Check** <https://handcrafted.craftsforlove.com/> **SEE THE BEST PATTERNS**

- Trim loose threads
- Press lightly
- Ensure all stitching is secure



## **Key Sewing Methods (Quick Reference)**

- **Appliqué:** Stitching fabric shapes onto a base
- **Piecing:** Sewing fabric sections together
- **Quilting:** Stitching through all layers
- **Topstitching:** Decorative or reinforcing stitches
- **Finishing:** Binding edges and completing the quilt
- **RST (Right Sides Together):** Fabric fronts facing each other while sewing
