

# Crochet Floral Granny Square Pattern

## Materials Needed

- Worsted weight yarn:
    - Yellow (center)
    - Green (leaves)
    - White (frame)
  - Crochet hook: 4.0 mm (G/6) or size to match gauge
  - Scissors
  - Yarn needle (for weaving ends)

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### MATERIALS & LEGEND (US Terms)

#### 1. Materials Required:


Yarn: Cotton or Acrylic (US size 3-Light or 4-Worst)  
Colors: Bright Yellow, Lime Green, Bright White

Hook: Size G/6 (4.0mm) or H/8 (5.0mm)

Tapestry Needle

Stitch Markers

#### 2. Stitch & Method Legend:

MR

ch = Chain stitch

sl st = Slip stitch

sc = Single crochet

hdc = Half double crochet


dc = Double crochet

inc = Increase




#### Surface slip stitch (surface sl st)


Pattern: MR with 12 dc.







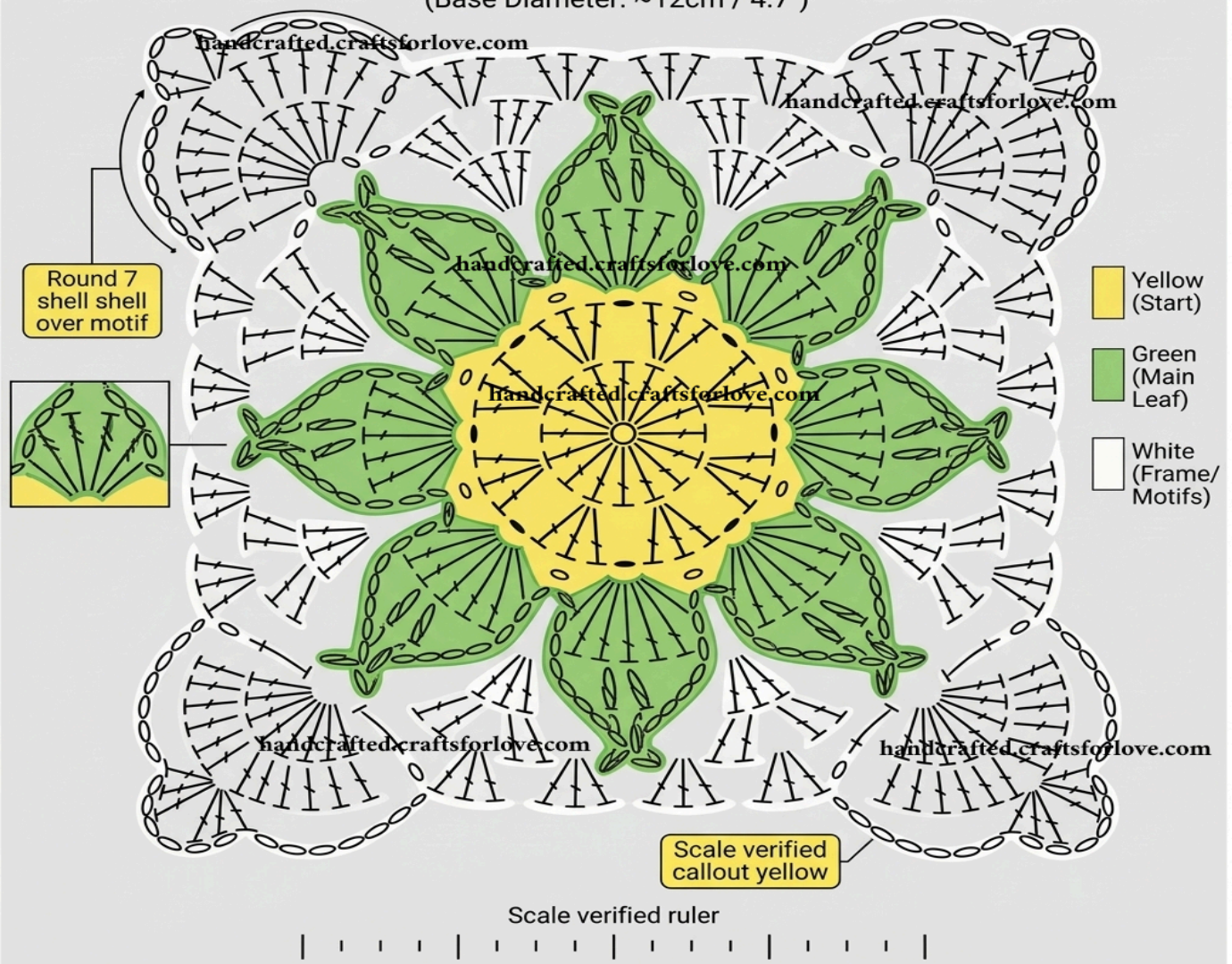

# TECHNICAL DIAGRAM: FLORAL GRANNY SQUARE

(Base Diameter: ~12cm / 4.7")



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## Abbreviations (US Terms)

- ch = chain
- sl st = slip stitch
- sc = single crochet
- hdc = half double crochet
- dc = double crochet
- tr = treble crochet
- st = stitch
- sp = space
- rep = repeat

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## Notes Before You Start

- This pattern is worked **in the round**.
- Each round is joined with a **slip stitch unless stated otherwise**.
- Chain stitches at the beginning of rounds may count as stitches where noted.
- Color changes happen at the end of the previous stitch.

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## Round 1 – Start the Center (Yellow)

- Make a **magic ring**
- ch 3 (counts as first dc)
- Work **15 dc into the ring** (16 total including ch-3)
- Join with sl st to top of ch-3

Tighten the ring securely.

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## Round 2 – Build the Base Circle

- ch 3
- 1 dc in same st
- 2 dc in each st around
- Join with sl st

You should now have **32 dc**.

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## Round 3 – Shape the Flower Base

- ch 1
- *sc in next st, hdc in next, 2 dc in next, hdc in next, sc in next*
- rep from \* around

This creates a **soft petal edge**.

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## Round 4 – Create Petal Spaces

- sl st into next st
- ch 5
- skip 2 sts, sc in next
- rep around

You now have **chain spaces** that will anchor the petals.

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## Round 5 – Petal Structure

- In each ch-5 space:
  - (sc, hdc, 3 dc, hdc, sc)

Repeat in every space.

Join and fasten off **yellow**.

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## Round 6 – Add Leaves (Switch to Green)

Join green yarn in any space between petals.

- ch 1
- sc in same space
- ch 3
- 2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc in same space
- ch 3, sc in next space

Repeat around

You now have **leaf bases forming between petals**.

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## Round 7 – Shape the Leaves

In each leaf space:

- sc, hdc, dc, 2 tr, ch 2, 2 tr, dc, hdc, sc

This forms the **pointed leaf shape**.

Repeat for all leaves and join.

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## Round 8 – Outline Leaves

- sl st around each leaf edge
- When reaching the tip (ch-2 space), work:
  - (sc, ch 2, sc)

This sharpens the leaf tips.

Fasten off green.

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## Round 9 – Begin White Frame

Join white yarn in any space between leaves.

- ch 4 (counts as tr)
- 2 tr, ch 2, 3 tr in same space
- skip to next space, sc

Repeat around

This begins forming the **square structure**.

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## Round 10 – Expand the Square

- sl st into corner space
- ch 4
- (2 tr, ch 2, 3 tr) in corner
- 3 dc in side spaces
- Repeat around

Corners become more defined here.

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## Round 11 – Build the Sides

- Work dc clusters along each side
- In each corner:
  - (3 tr, ch 2, 3 tr)

Keep sides straight and corners sharp.

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## Round 12 – Shell Round (Important Detail)

This matches the diagram's "shell over motif".

- In each side space:
  - 5 dc (shell)
- sc between shells
- In corners:
  - (5 dc, ch 2, 5 dc)

Repeat all around

This creates the **decorative scalloped edge**.

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## Round 13 – Final Edge

- sc in each st
- ch 3 at corners

Optional: add picots for extra decoration:

- (sc, ch 3, sl st in same st)

Fasten off and weave in all ends.

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## Finishing Touches

- Block your square to approximately **4.7 inches (12 cm)**
- Shape leaves and corners carefully
- Steam lightly if needed (depending on yarn type)

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## You're Done!

You now have a beautiful **Floral Granny Square** with:

- A bright flower center 
- Detailed green leaves 
- A delicate white lace frame
