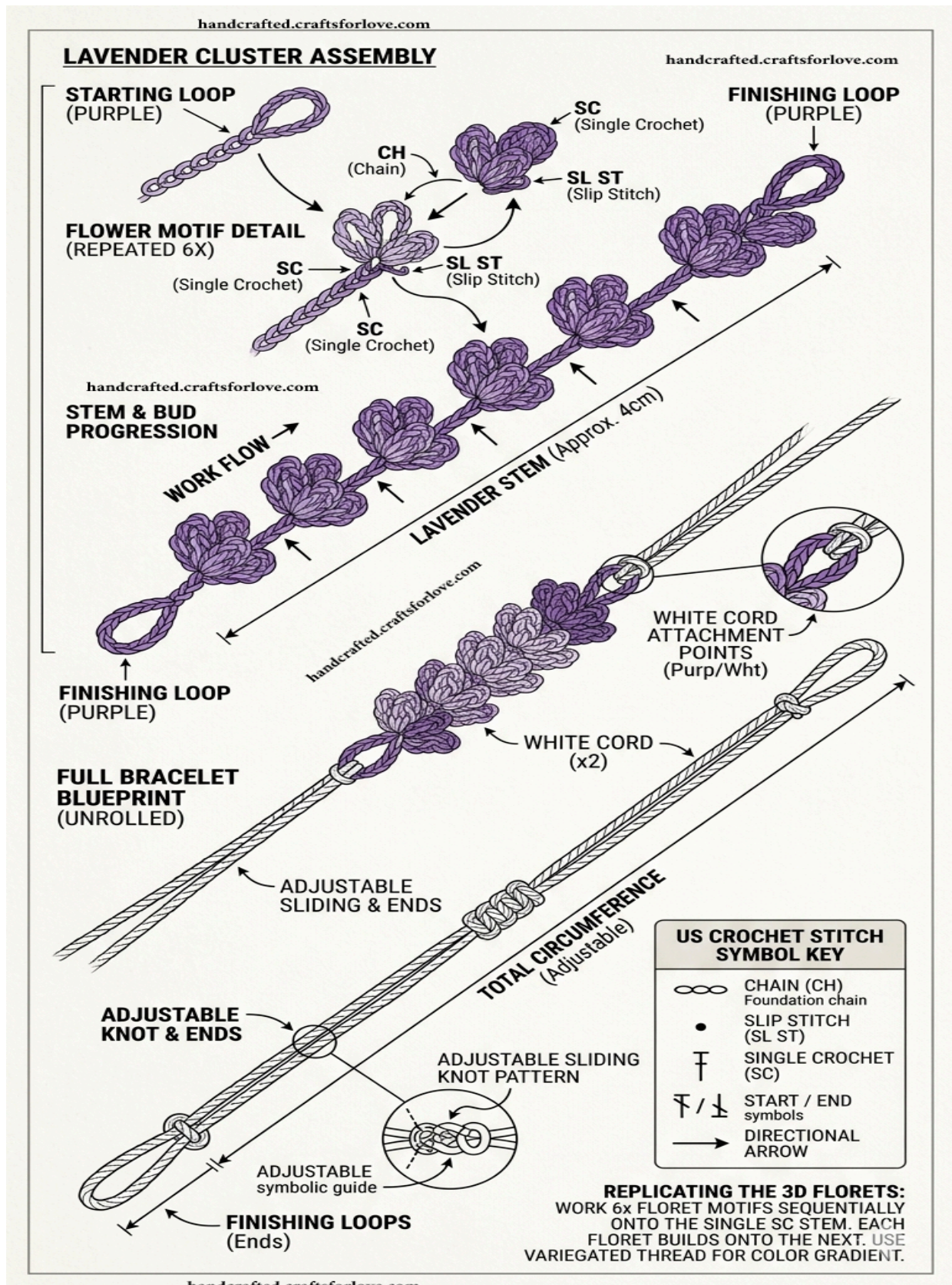


🌿 Lavender Cluster Bracelet – Complete Step-by-Step Crochet Tutorial

This detailed guide will walk you through how to create a beautiful lavender-inspired crochet bracelet, based fully on the diagram you provided. Even if you're a beginner, you'll be able to follow along from start to finish.

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Materials You'll Need

- Purple yarn (lavender tone, or variegated purple/white for gradient effect)
- White cord (2 pieces for adjustable bracelet ends)
- Crochet hook (size appropriate for your yarn, typically 2.5–3.5 mm)
- Scissors <https://handcrafted.craftsforlove.com/> **SEE THE BEST PATTERNS**
- Yarn needle (for finishing)



Stitch Abbreviations (US Terms)

- **CH (Chain):** Foundation stitch
- **SC (Single Crochet):** Insert hook, yarn over, pull through, yarn over, pull through both loops
- **SL ST (Slip Stitch):** Insert hook, yarn over, pull through all loops on hook



Step 1: Create the Starting Loop

1. Begin with your purple yarn.
2. Make a **loop (like a small adjustable ring or fixed loop)**.
3. This loop will act as one end of your bracelet closure.
4. Tighten it slightly, but keep it flexible enough to pass a cord through later.



Step 2: Crochet the Foundation Stem

1. From the starting loop, create a **chain (CH)** long enough to begin your stem.
2. Work a **few SC stitches along the chain** to create a firm base.
3. This forms the beginning of your lavender stem.



Step 3: Create the First Flower Motif

Each flower cluster is made using a combination of chain, slip stitch, and single crochet stitches. <https://handcrafted.craftsforlove.com/> **SEE THE BEST PATTERNS**

1. **Chain a small number (2–4 CH)** to create a loop.
2. Into that loop:
 - Work multiple **SC stitches** to form a petal cluster.
3. Use a **SL ST** to secure the cluster back onto the stem.

👉 This creates one small lavender “bud.”

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Step 4: Repeat the Flower Motif (6 Times)

1. Continue along the stem:
 - Work a few **SC stitches** forward
 - Then create another flower motif
2. Each new flower builds slightly on the previous one, forming a layered, 3D effect.
3. Repeat this process **6 times total**, spacing them evenly along the stem.

✨ Tip: Slightly angle each flower to mimic natural lavender growth.

Step 5: Complete the Lavender Stem

1. After finishing all 6 flower clusters:
 - Continue with **SC stitches** to extend the stem slightly
2. Aim for a total stem length of about **4 cm (approx. 1.5 inches)**

Step 6: Create the Finishing Loop

1. At the end of the stem:
 - Chain enough stitches to form a loop similar in size to the starting loop
2. Join back with a **SL ST**
3. Fasten off and secure your yarn

Now you have a complete lavender crochet segment with loops on both ends 

Step 7: Attach the White Cords

1. Take your **two white cords**
2. Attach one cord to each end loop:
 - Thread through the purple loops
 - Fold and secure with a simple knot
3. Make sure both cords extend evenly outward

Step 8: Create the Adjustable Sliding Knot

To make the bracelet adjustable:

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1. Cross the two cord ends over each other
2. Use one cord to wrap around the other cord **several times (3–5 wraps)**
3. Pull the end through the wraps to form a **sliding knot**
4. Repeat on the opposite side if desired

Now your bracelet can expand or tighten easily.

Step 9: Finish the Ends

1. Tie small knots at the ends of each cord
2. Optionally create small loops at the ends for decorative finish
3. Trim excess cord neatly


Final Fit and Adjustment

- The bracelet should now be **fully adjustable**
- Slide the knots to fit your wrist comfortably
- The lavender cluster should sit centered on top of your wrist

Tips for Best Results

- Use **variegated yarn** (purple to white) for a more realistic lavender effect
- Keep your stitches tight for a structured flower shape
- Practice one flower motif separately before starting the full piece
- Adjust the number of flowers if you want a longer or shorter design
