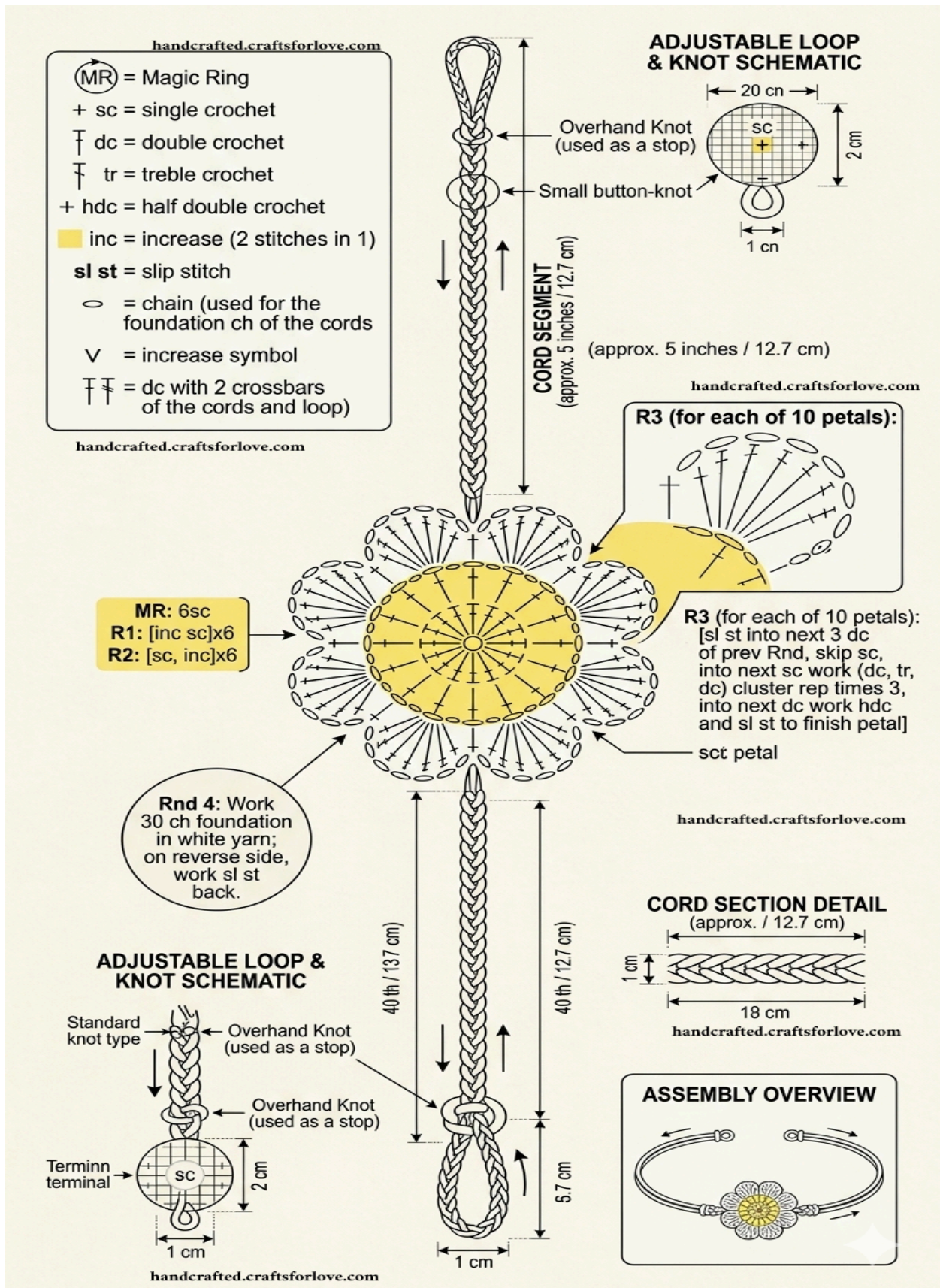




Materials You Will Need

- Cotton yarn (2 colors: **yellow** for the center, **white** for petals and cords)
- Crochet hook (size appropriate for your yarn, typically 2.5–3.5 mm)
- Yarn needle
- Scissors <https://handcrafted.craftsforlove.com/> **SEE THE BEST PATTERNS**



✨ Abbreviations Used

- MR = Magic Ring
- sc = single crochet
- dc = double crochet
- tr = treble crochet
- hdc = half double crochet
- inc = increase (2 stitches in the same stitch)
- sl st = slip stitch
- ch = chain <https://handcrafted.craftsforlove.com/> SEE THE BEST PATTERNS

🌻 Step 1: Create the Flower Center

Round 1 (R1)

- Start with a **Magic Ring (MR)**
- Work **6 single crochets (6 sc)** into the ring
- Pull tight to close

Round 2 (R2)

- Work [**sc, inc**] x6
- You will have **12 stitches total**

🌻 Step 2: Build the Petal Base

This round prepares the structure for the petals.

- Work evenly around the circle as shown in the chart
- Follow the stitch placement to maintain spacing for **10 petals**

🌻 Step 3: Crochet the Petals (R3)

You will repeat this sequence **10 times (one per petal)**:

For each petal: <https://handcrafted.craftsforlove.com/> SEE THE BEST PATTERNS

1. Slip stitch into the next **3 dc from previous round**
2. Slip stitch into the next sc
3. In the next stitch, work:
 - **dc, tr, dc cluster**
4. Repeat the cluster **3 times in adjacent stitches**
5. In the next stitch, work **hdc**
6. Slip stitch to finish the petal

✨ This creates the rounded petal shape.

Repeat until all **10 petals** are completed.

Step 4: Add the Cord Foundation (Round 4)

- Attach white yarn
- Chain **30 stitches (ch 30)**
- Turn your work
- On the return row, **slip stitch into each chain back**

This forms one side of the bracelet cord.

Step 5: Make the Adjustable Cord Sections

You need **two cord segments**, each approximately:

- **5 inches (12.7 cm)** long
- About **40 stitches**

- Chain to desired length (~40 ch)
- Slip stitch back along the chain

Repeat to create the second cord.

Step 6: Create the Adjustable Loop & Knot

Loop Side

1. Fold the cord to form a loop (~1 cm wide)
2. Secure with an **overhand knot** (acts as a stopper)
3. Add a **small button knot** below it

Sliding Knot Section

1. Cross both cords
2. Wrap one cord around the other several times
3. Pull tight to create a **sliding adjustable knot**
4. Add overhand knots at ends to prevent slipping

Step 7: Add End Terminals

At each cord end: <https://handcrafted.craftsforlove.com/> SEE THE BEST PATTERNS

- Crochet a small circle:
 - MR with **6 sc**
- Tighten and fasten off
- This creates a neat stopper and decorative finish

Step 8: Assembly


- Attach cords securely to both sides of the flower
- Ensure symmetry
- Adjust knot so bracelet can slide open/closed easily

Final Measurements (Approximate)

- Flower diameter: ~2 cm
- Cord length: ~5 inches (12.7 cm) each side
- Adjustable loop: ~1 cm

You now have a beautiful crocheted flower bracelet with:

- A detailed center 
- 10 decorative petals
- Adjustable cord closure
