

Pastel Peacock Mandala Wall Hanging Pattern

Materials You'll Need

- Worsted weight cotton yarn (multiple colors):
 - Mint green (head & body)
 - Lavender, pink, mint (crown)
 - Assorted pastel colors (tail feathers)
- Crochet hook: Size G/6 (4.0 mm) or H/8 (5.0 mm)
- Yarn needle
- Stitch markers <https://handcrafted.craftsforlove.com/> SEE THE BEST PATTERNS
- Scissors
- Pearl beads (optional, for embellishment)
- Cardboard (for tassels)

Materials

- Steel Crochet Hook (Size 3.25mm / D)
- Small and large pearls
- Small embroidery hoop (e.g., 6 inches)
- Tapestry needle
- Stitch markers

- inc = Increase (e.g., 2 sc in same loop)

Rnds 16-12: dc cluster, add, over 3 bott, cots. dc cluster on ch loops), on chrsapa.

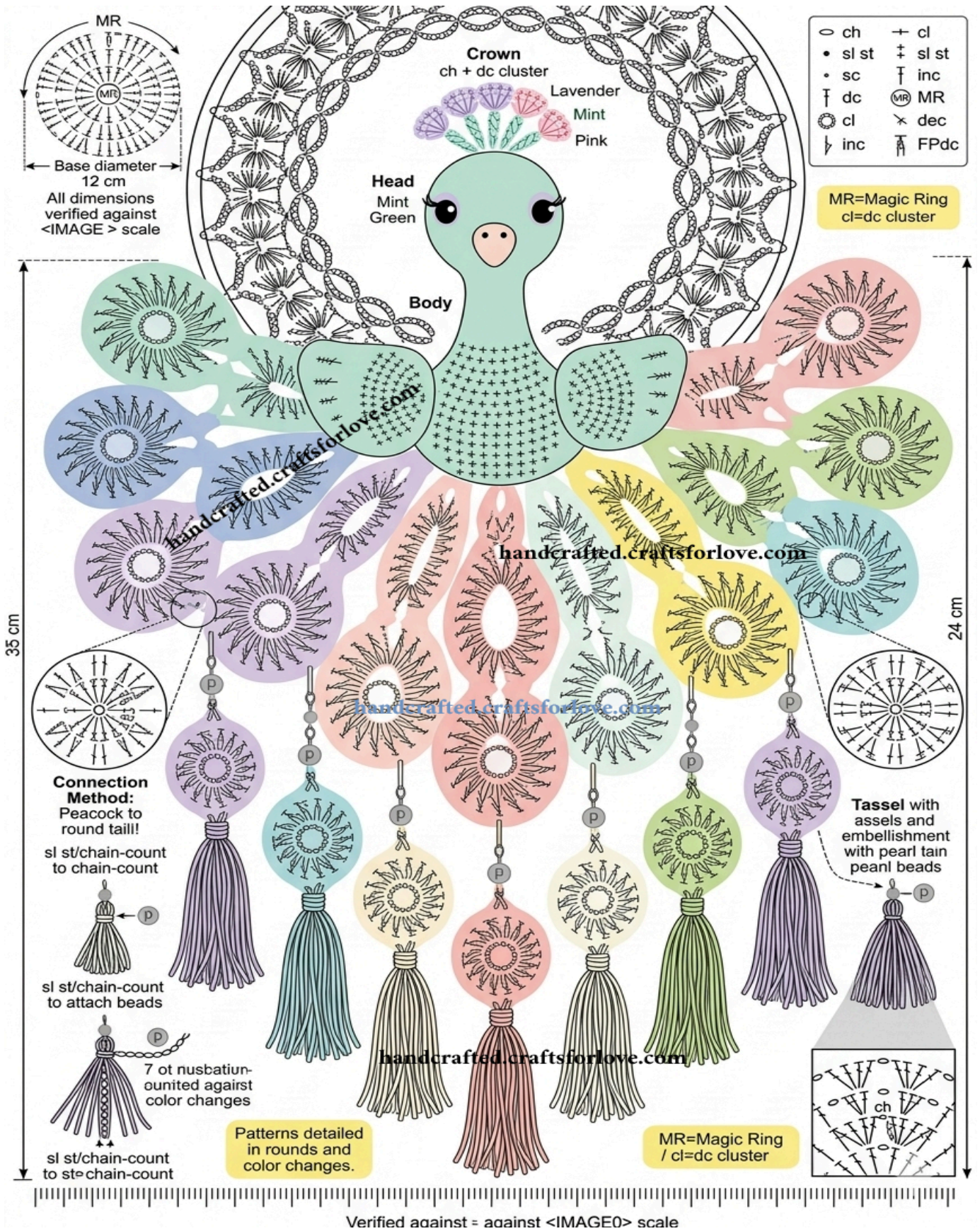

Abbreviations (US Terms)

- MR = Magic Ring
- ch = chain <https://handcrafted.craftsforlove.com/> SEE THE BEST PATTERNS
- sl st = slip stitch
- sc = single crochet
- dc = double crochet
- inc = increase (2 stitches in same stitch)
- cl = cluster (dc cluster as shown in diagram)
- FPdc = front post double crochet

Step 1: Base Circle (Doily Foundation)


This is the large circular base (approx. 12 cm diameter center, expanding outward).

1. Start with MR
2. Round 1: ch 3 (counts as dc), make 11 dc into ring, sl st to join (12 dc total)
3. Round 2: ch 3, dc inc in each stitch around (24 dc)
4. Round 3: 1 dc, 1 dc inc repeat around
5. Continue increasing evenly each round until your base circle is wide enough to support the peacock (follow diagram spacing)

 Tip: Keep the circle flat—if it curls, loosen tension or go up a hook size.

Step 2: Lace Border (Outer Decorative Ring)

1. Work *ch + dc cluster (cl)* pattern as shown in diagram
2. Each “petal loop” is made by:
 - ch 3–5 <https://handcrafted.craftsforlove.com/> SEE THE BEST PATTERNS
 - dc cluster into same or next stitch
3. Repeat around the circle to create the floral lace effect

 This is what gives the elegant mandala look behind the peacock.

Step 3: Head (Mint Green)

1. MR <https://handcrafted.craftsforlove.com/> SEE THE BEST PATTERNS
2. Round 1: 6 sc in MR
3. Round 2: inc in each stitch (12 sc)
4. Round 3: 1 sc, inc (18 sc)
5. Continue until a small oval head forms

Face Details <https://handcrafted.craftsforlove.com/> SEE THE BEST PATTERNS

- Eyes: embroider or attach safety eyes
- Beak: small oval using pink yarn (chain 4, work around)

Step 4: Crown Feathers

Make 5 small decorative feathers:

For each feather:

1. ch 5
2. In 2nd chain: sc, then hdc, then dc, then sl st
3. Attach to top of head

Colors:

- Lavender <https://handcrafted.craftsforlove.com/> SEE THE BEST PATTERNS
- Mint
- Pink

Step 5: Body (Mint Green)

1. Attach yarn below head
2. Work in rows or rounds:
 - Row 1: sc across base of head
 - Row 2+: increase outward to form teardrop shape
3. Add texture:
 - Use small “x” stitches (surface embroidery or alternating sc/dc)

 The body should widen at bottom to connect with tail.

Step 6: Tail Feathers (Main Feature)

Each feather is made individually, then attached.

Feather Pattern

1. MR <https://handcrafted.craftsforlove.com/> SEE THE BEST PATTERNS
2. Round 1: 12 dc into ring
3. Round 2: ch loops around (ch 5, sl st in next stitch)
4. Round 3: Fill loops with dc or clusters

Eye Shape (Center Oval)

- Chain 6
- Work around chain to form oval
- Attach to feather center

Make multiple feathers in different colors:


- Blue <https://handcrafted.craftsforlove.com/> SEE THE BEST PATTERNS
- Yellow
- Pink
- Green
- Purple

Arrange symmetrically under the body.

Step 7: Connecting Feathers

To join feathers to the base:

1. Use sl st and chain lengths
2. Attach each feather evenly along the lower circle
3. Use stitch markers to keep spacing consistent

 The diagram shows evenly radiating placement—follow that visual balance.

Step 8: Hanging Tassels

Making Tassels <https://handcrafted.craftsforlove.com/> SEE THE BEST PATTERNS

1. Wrap yarn around cardboard 20–30 times
2. Tie at top
3. Cut bottom loops
4. Wrap a small section near top to form head

Attach Tassels

- Use chain strands (ch 10–20)
- Add pearl beads if desired
- Attach to bottom of feathers

Step 9: Final Dimensions

- Total height: ~35 cm
- Width: ~24 cm <https://handcrafted.craftsforlove.com/> SEE THE BEST PATTERNS
- Base circle: ~12 cm



Step 10: Finishing Touches

- Weave in all ends
- Block lightly for shape
- Adjust feather placement if needed
- Add extra beads or embroidery for detail
