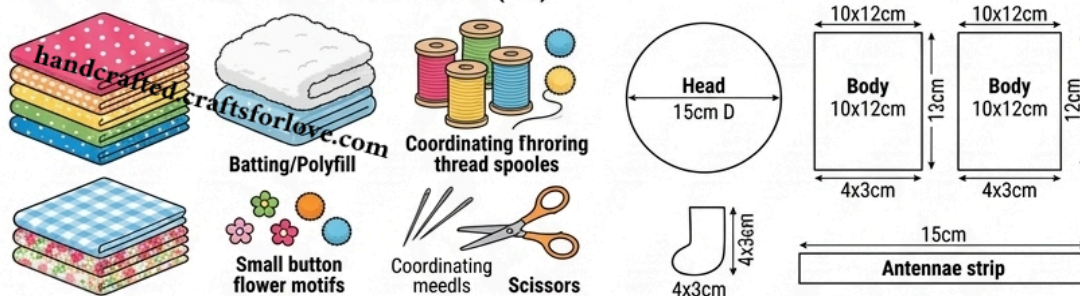

1. GATHER MATERIALS & PREPARE PATTERN (CM)



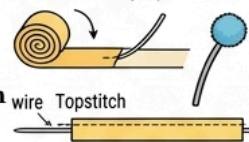
2. CONSTRUCT LEGS & ANTENNAE (Hand or Machine)

A. Legs



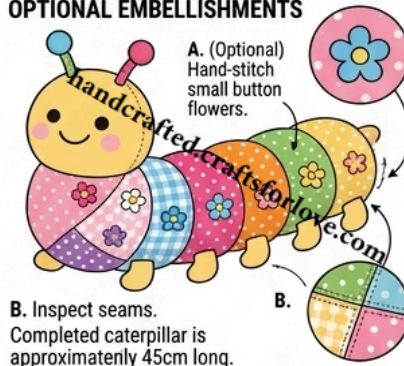
A. Legs (x8) - Turn Right Side (R.S.) out and stuff.

B. Antennae (x2)



B. Antennae - Stitch and reinforce.

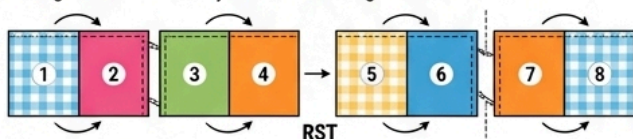
6. COMPLETED PROJECT & OPTIONAL EMBELLISHMENTS



B. Inspect seams. Completed caterpillar is approximately 45cm long.

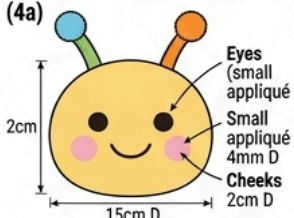
3. SEW BODY SEGMENTS (Piecing - P)

Join segments to form body chain. Ensure aligned corners.



4. FORM HEAD & FACE (Appliqué - A / Hand Embroidery - E)

(4a)



Attach eyes (e.g., smile), and hand-embroider a smile (backstitch).

(4b)



Position face details. Topstitch face. Secure appendages.

METHOD LEGEND (US Sewing Terminology):

- (A) APPLIQUÉ:** Stitching one fabric piece onto another, to form a block or pattern.
- (E) HAND EMBROIDERY:** Detailed hand-stitched features (e.g., smile).
- (S) STUFFING:** Polyfill used to add body and form (e.g., smile).
- (LS) LADDER STITCH:** Invisible hand stitch for closures.
- (BST) RIGHT SIDES TOGETHER**

5. FINAL ASSEMBLY & STUFFING (Stuffing - S)



- A. Stitch head to body RST, leave opening.
- B. Insert legs/antennae.
- C. Stitch back panel to front (leave turn-through gap).
- D. Turn R.S. out, stuff with Polyfill (S), and hand-stitch closure (Ladder Stitch - LS).

Step 1: Gather Materials & Prepare the Pattern

Before you begin, collect all your supplies and prepare your pattern pieces.

Materials:

- Assorted cotton fabrics (various colors and patterns for patchwork)
- Batting or polyfill stuffing
- Coordinating sewing thread (multiple colors recommended)
- Small buttons or flower appliqués (optional decoration)

- Sewing needles (for hand sewing)
- Sewing machine (optional but faster)
- Fabric scissors
- Pins or clips

Pattern Pieces (add 1 cm seam allowance to all edges):

- Head: Circle, 15 cm diameter
- Body segments: Rectangles, 10 x 12 cm (you'll need multiple pieces)
- Leg pieces: 4 x 3 cm (cut 8 total)
- Antennae strip: 15 cm long
- Small strip pieces: 4 x 3 cm (for body ends)

Cut all pieces from your chosen fabrics.

Step 2: Construct the Legs & Antennae

A. Legs (Make 8) <https://handcrafted.craftsforlove.com/> SEE THE BEST PATTERNS

1. Fold each leg piece in half (right sides together).
2. Stitch around the curved edge, leaving the top open.
3. Turn right side out.
4. Stuff lightly with polyfill.
5. Set aside.

B. Antennae (Make 2)

1. Roll or fold fabric strip tightly.
2. Insert a thin wire inside for structure.
3. Stitch along the edge (topstitch) to secure.
4. Add a small fabric ball or knot at the tip if desired.
5. Reinforce stitching so they hold their shape.

Step 3: Sew the Body Segments (Piecing)

1. Arrange your fabric rectangles in a pleasing color order.
2. Sew pieces together in pairs (right sides together).
3. Continue joining until you form a long strip of segments (like a chain).
4. Press seams flat.
5. Make sure corners align neatly for a clean patchwork look.

Step 4: Form the Head & Face

A. Face Base <https://handcrafted.craftsforlove.com/> SEE THE BEST PATTERNS

1. Cut two head circles (front and back).
2. On the front piece, position facial features:
 - Eyes: small fabric circles or embroidered dots
 - Cheeks: small circles (~2 cm diameter)
 - Smile: hand-embroidered using backstitch

B. Attach Details <https://handcrafted.craftsforlove.com/> SEE THE BEST PATTERNS

1. Sew or glue eyes and cheeks in place (appliqué method).
2. Embroider the smile carefully.
3. Attach antennae to the top of the head (between fabric layers or stitched on top).
4. Use satin stitch for decorative elements if desired.

Step 5: Final Assembly & Stuffing

1. Attach the head to the first body segment (right sides together).
2. Continue attaching body segments into a full caterpillar shape.
3. Insert legs evenly along the bottom between seams.
4. Leave a small opening along one seam.

Stuffing

1. Turn the entire caterpillar right side out.
2. Fill with polyfill evenly:
 - Start with the head
 - Continue through each body segment
3. Adjust stuffing so it's firm but soft.

1. Hand-stitch the opening closed using a ladder stitch (invisible stitch).



Step 6: Finishing Touches & Embellishments

1. Inspect all seams to ensure they are secure.
2. Add optional decorations:
 - Hand-stitched button flowers
 - Extra embroidery details
3. Shape the caterpillar by gently adjusting stuffing.

Your finished caterpillar should be about **45 cm (18 inches) long**.



Sewing Terms (Quick Reference)

- **Appliqué:** Sewing fabric pieces onto another fabric for decoration
- **Backstitch:** Strong hand stitch used for outlines (like smiles)
- **Satin Stitch:** Dense stitching for filling shapes
- **Stuffing:** Filling plush with polyfill for shape
- **Ladder Stitch:** Invisible stitch for closing seams
- **Right Sides Together (RST):** Sewing with the patterned sides facing inward
