

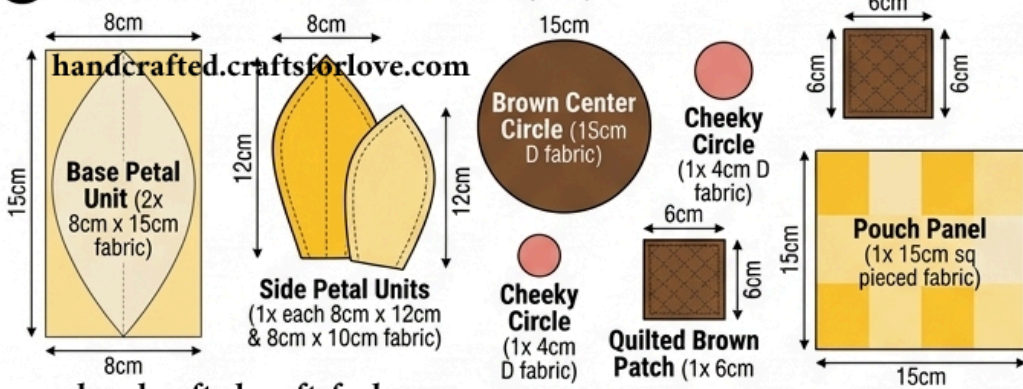


# DIY Patchwork Sunflower Phone Charger Station Tutorial

## DIY PATCHWORK SUNFLOWER PHONE CHARGER STATION TUTORIAL

### 1 PREPARE PATTERNS & FABRIC (CM)

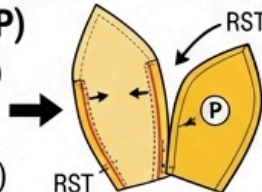
### METHOD LEGEND

- (A) APPLIQUÉ** - Stitching one fabric piece onto another.
- (P) PIECING** - Sewing varied fabric shapes together to form a block or top.
- (Q) QUILTING** - Layering top, batting, and backing, then stitching through all.
- (E) EMBROIDERY** - Hand or machine detailed stitching for features.
- (F) FINISHING** - Edging and binding.

RST = Right Sides Together (method instruction).

### 2 FORM INDIVIDUAL PETALS (P)

- A. Match fabric types for a unit. RST (P) sew side seams. CM guidelines.
- B. Topstitch (P) along seams.
- C. Form all petal units (8x base, 4x side)



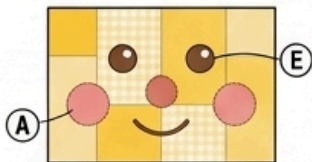
### 3 TREAT- PETALUNITS (P)

- A. Match fabric types for a unit. RST (P) sew side seams.
- B. Topstitch (P) along seams.
- C. Form all petal units (8x side)

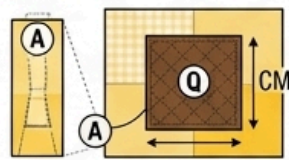


### 3 PIECE THE SUNFLOWER FACE & POUCH

- A. Face: Piecing the face panel with alternating fabrics (P). Appliqué (A) cheeks and nose. Emb. Embroider (E) mouth.



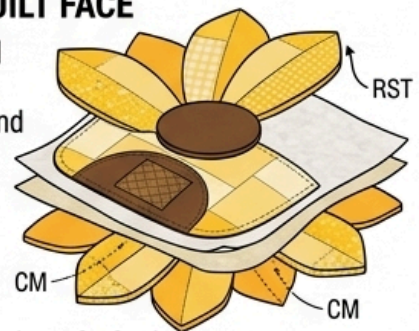
- B. Pouch: Quilt (Q) brown patch (CM size callout).



Appliqué (A) brown patch to pouch panel.

### 4 ASSEMBLE AND QUILT FACE

- A. Position RST pouch panel over RST face panel.
- B. Position base petals around RST brown center RST.
- C. Secure RST layers to a batting and backing layer.
- D. Quilt (Q) all layers together (CM stitch).

### 5 ATTACH SIDE PETALS AND REINFORCE POCKET

- A. Position RST side petals on face.
- B. RST layers again for side petal secure stitch (P).
- C. Reinforce the pouch edge for stability.

### 6 FINAL ASSEMBLY & FINISHING (F)

- A. Stitch loop to top petal. CM callout for loop size.
- B. Finish edges with bias binding (F).
- C. Finished!

## Step 1: Prepare Patterns & Fabric (Measurements in cm)

Start by cutting all your fabric pieces according to the sizes below:

**Petals:** <https://handcrafted.craftsforlove.com/> SEE THE BEST PATTERNS

- Base Petal Units: Cut 2 pieces, each **8 cm x 15 cm**
- Side Petal Units:
  - Cut 1 piece **8 cm x 12 cm**
  - Cut 1 piece **8 cm x 10 cm**

**Center & Details:**

- Brown Center Circle: Cut 1 circle, **15 cm diameter**
- Cheek Circles: Cut 2 circles, **4 cm diameter**

**Patch & Pouch:**

- Quilted Brown Patch: Cut 1 square, **6 cm x 6 cm**
- Pouch Panel: Create a **15 cm x 15 cm** square using pieced fabric (patchwork style)

 Tip: Use a variety of yellow and brown fabrics for a classic sunflower look.

## Step 2: Form Individual Petals

### A. Assemble Each Petal Unit

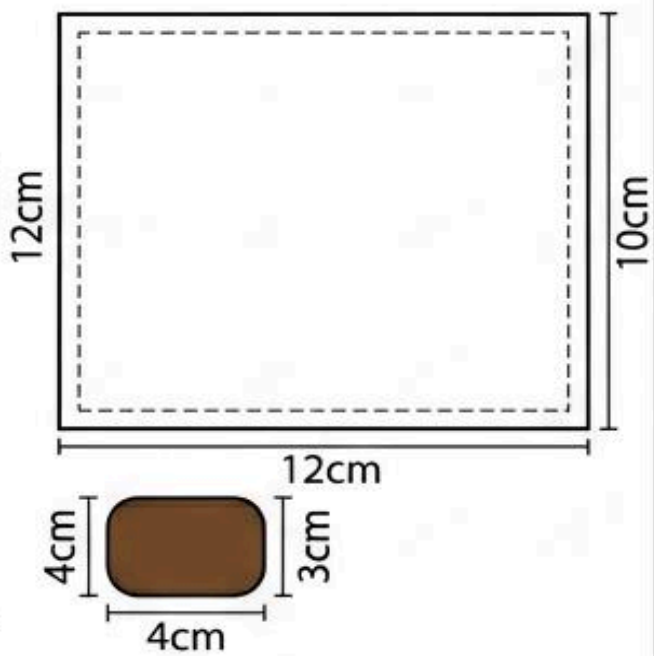
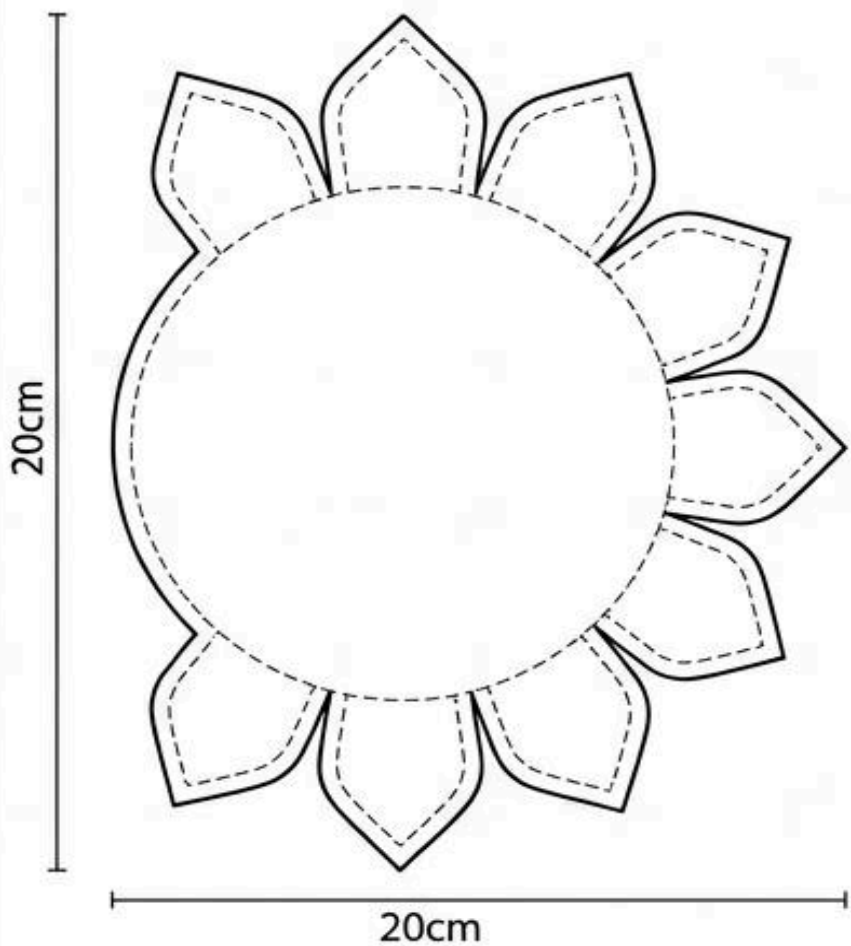
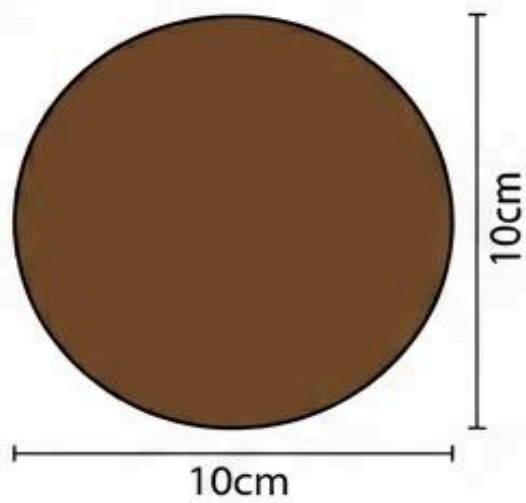
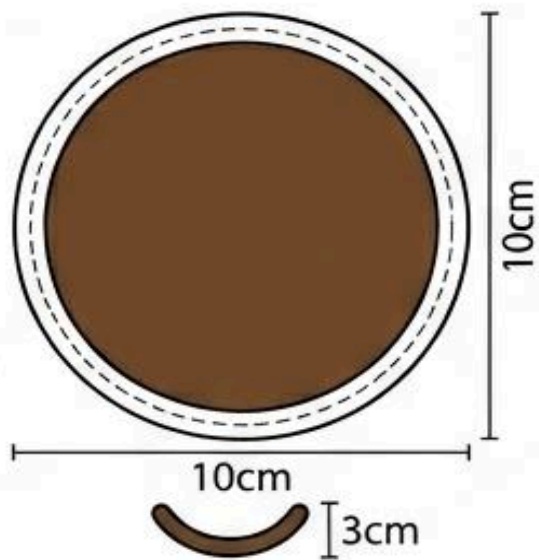
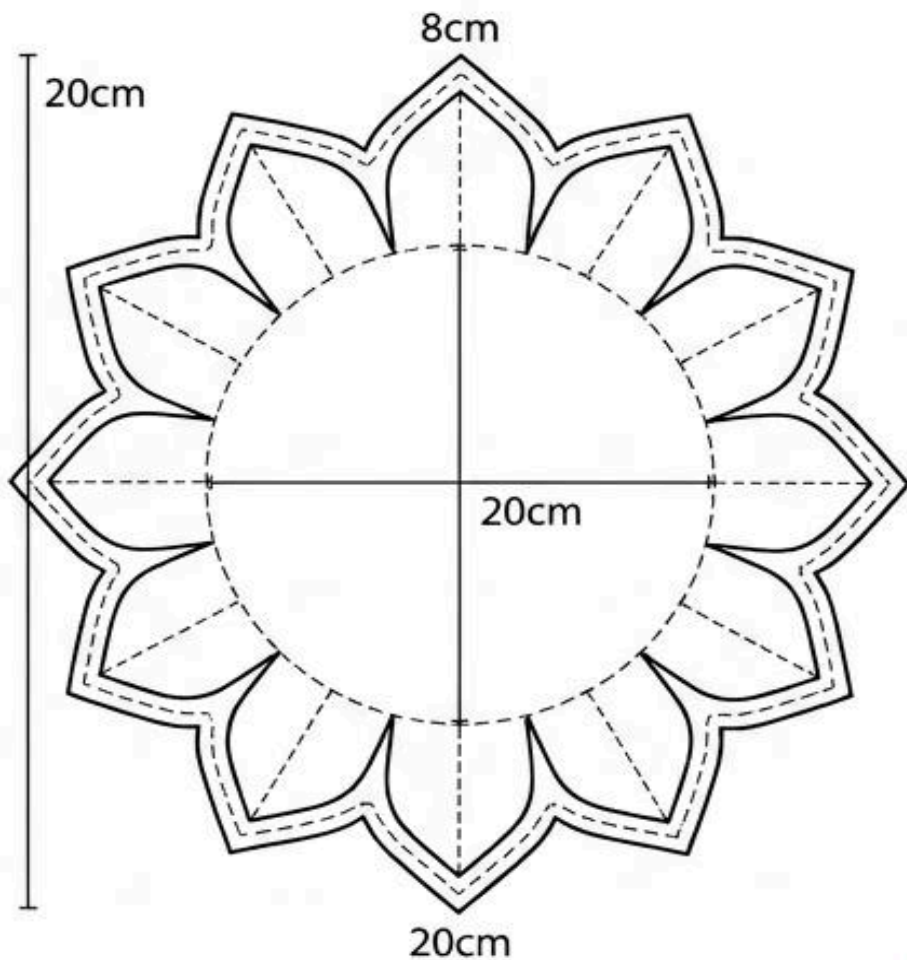
- Match fabrics for each petal.
- Place pieces **right sides together (RST)**.
- Sew along the side seams following a **consistent seam margin (CM)**.

### B. Topstitch <https://handcrafted.craftsforlove.com/> SEE THE BEST PATTERNS

- Turn the petals right side out.
- Press flat and topstitch along edges for a clean finish.

### C. Complete Petal Sets

- Make:
  - **8 base petals**
  - **4 side petals**



## Step 3: Create Side Petal Units

Repeat the same process as Step 2, but for the side petals only:

- Sew with **RST** <https://handcrafted.craftsforlove.com/> **SEE THE BEST PATTERNS**
- Turn, press, and topstitch
- Complete **8 side petal units**

These will layer behind or between the base petals for fullness.

## Step 4: Piece the Sunflower Face & Pouch

### A. Sunflower Face

- Use patchwork technique (piecing) to create a **15 cm square face panel**.
- Alternate fabric colors for a checkerboard effect.

Add facial features:

- Appliqué the **cheek circles** onto the face.
- Embroider the mouth using thread (simple curved stitch).
- Add small eyes (embroidered or appliqué).

### B. Pouch Panel <https://handcrafted.craftsforlove.com/> **SEE THE BEST PATTERNS**

- Take your 15 cm patchwork square.
- Attach the **quilted brown patch (6x6 cm)** using appliqué.
- Quilt the pouch panel lightly for structure.

## Step 5: Assemble and Quilt the Face

### A. Layer the Panels

- Place pouch panel over the face panel, **RST**.

### B. Add Base Petals

- Arrange base petals evenly around the edge of the brown center circle area.

### C. Build the Quilt Sandwich

- Stack layers: <https://handcrafted.craftsforlove.com/> **SEE THE BEST PATTERNS**
  - Top: Face + petals
  - Middle: Batting
  - Bottom: Backing fabric

## D. Quilt Layers Together

- Stitch through all layers (quilting).
- Follow seam margins and secure all pieces firmly.



## Step 6: Attach Side Petals & Reinforce Pocket

### A. Add Side Petals <https://handcrafted.craftsforlove.com/> SEE THE BEST PATTERNS

- Place side petals behind or between base petals.
- Sew in place using **RST method**.

### B. Secure Layers

- Stitch again through layers to reinforce structure.

### C. Reinforce Pouch Edge

- Sew along the top edge of the pouch to strengthen it.
- This ensures it can hold a phone securely.



## Step 7: Final Assembly & Finishing

### A. Add Hanging Loop

- Sew a fabric loop to the top petal.
- Keep size practical for hanging on a charger plug.

### B. Finish Edges

- Bind all edges using **bias binding** for a clean, durable finish.

### C. You're Done!

Your sunflower charger station is ready to use 🌻 📱
