

# Sea turtle remote holders Pattern

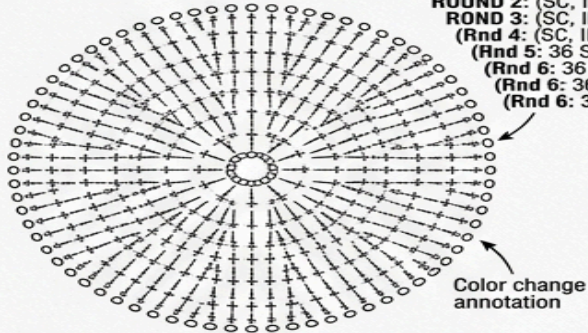
## Materials & Tools

- Medium weight yarn (Worsted / Category 4)
- Crochet hook (recommended: 3.5–4.5 mm / E–G)
- Stitch markers
- Yarn needle
- Scissors
- 12 mm safety eyes
- Fiberfill stuffing
- Standard TV remote (for sizing)

### HEAD CONSTRUCTION DIAGRAM (EXPLODED)

START: Magic Ring (MR)  
ROUND 1: 6 SC in MR

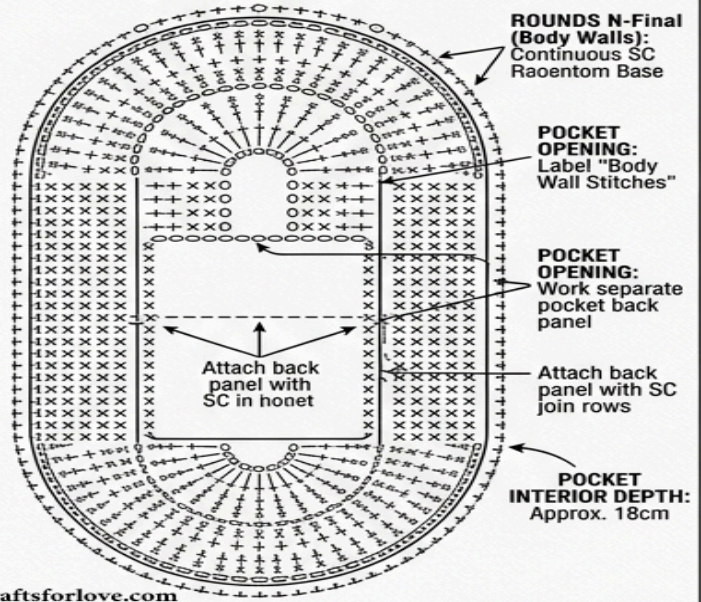
ROUND 2: (SC, INC) Repeat  
ROUND 3: (SC, INC) Repeat  
ROUND 4: (SC, INC) Repeat  
(Rnd 5: 36 SC)  
(Rnd 6: 36 SC)  
(Rnd 6: 36 SC)



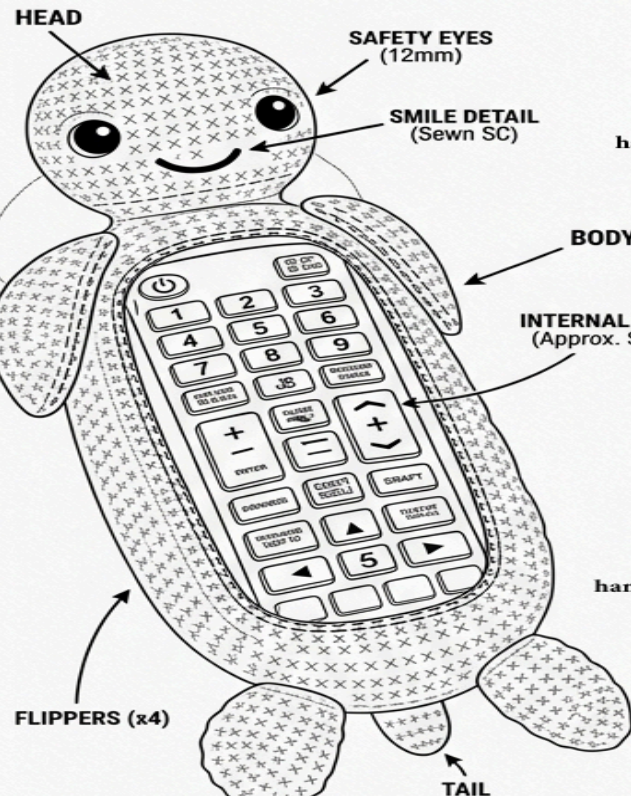
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### BODY CASING & REMOTE POCKET DIAGRAM (EXPLODED)

START: Foundation CH (Approx 10-12 CHs for bottom base)  
ROUND 1 (Base): SC around CH to form base oval  
ROUNDS 3-N (Increasing): INC (2 SC in 1 st) on curves. Detail key for  
ROUNDS N-Final (Body Walls): Continuous SC Rounds.



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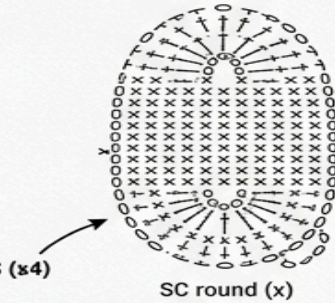


### ASSEMBLED REMOTE HOLDER BLUEPRINT



NOTE: Pattern designed to fit standard remotes. Final stitch counts may vary by remote size and yarn tension.

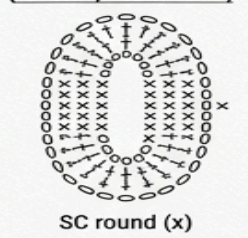
### BODY / CASING & REMOTE - FULL TECHNICAL LAYOUT (EXPLODED)

### FLIPPER DIAGRAM (SINGLE, REPEAT 4X)



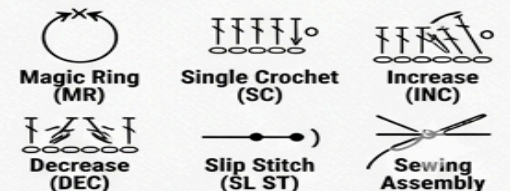
### TAIL DIAGRAM



### KEY TECHNIQUES & ASSEMBLING GUIDE

- ASSEMBLY FLOW:**
1. Crochet Head & Features.
  2. Crochet Body Casing & Back Pocket Panel.
  3. Join Pocket Panel to Casing.
  4. Attach Flippers (4x) & Tail.
  5. Stuff Head.
  6. Finish All Tails.

### KEY STITCHES:



## Abbreviations (US Terms)

- MR = Magic Ring <https://handcrafted.craftsforlove.com/> SEE THE BEST PATTERNS
- SC = Single Crochet
- INC = Increase (2 SC in same stitch)
- DEC = Decrease (invisible decrease recommended)
- SL ST = Slip Stitch

## Overview of the Project

You will create:

- Head (round sphere)
- Body casing (oval base + walls)
- Back pocket panel (for remote)
- 4 flippers
- Tail
- Assembly

## Step 1: Crochet the Head

**Round 1** <https://handcrafted.craftsforlove.com/> SEE THE BEST PATTERNS

- Start with MR
- 6 SC in MR  
(6 stitches)

### Round 2

- INC in each stitch around  
(12 stitches)

### Round 3

- (SC, INC) repeat around  
(18 stitches)

### Round 4–5

- (SC, INC) repeat pattern evenly
- Continue increasing until you reach **36 stitches**

### Rounds 6–8

- SC in each stitch around  
(36 stitches maintained)

**Add Details** <https://handcrafted.craftsforlove.com/> **SEE THE BEST PATTERNS**

- Insert **12 mm safety eyes**
- Place between rounds 5–6, about 6–8 stitches apart
- Sew a small curved smile using yarn

## Finish Head

- Lightly stuff with fiberfill
- Do not overstuff yet—you'll finish after attaching

## **Step 2: Crochet the Body Base (Oval)**

### Foundation

- Chain enough stitches to form an oval base (approx. 10–12 cm long)

### Round 1 (Base Oval)

- SC around the chain
- Work 3 SC in each end to form curves

### Rounds 2–3

- Continue increasing:
  - Add INC stitches at both curved ends
  - Keep sides straight

### Goal

- Create a smooth oval base sized slightly larger than your remote

## **Step 3: Build the Body Walls**

### Rounds 4–Final

- SC continuously (no increases)
- This creates vertical walls

**Height** <https://handcrafted.craftsforlove.com/> **SEE THE BEST PATTERNS**

- Continue until body height fits your remote (approx. 18 cm depth)

## **Step 4: Create the Pocket Opening**

- Mark a rectangular section on the front
- Leave this section open (do not stitch across it)
- Continue working around remaining stitches

This creates the **front opening for the remote**

## **Step 5: Crochet the Back Pocket Panel**

- Crochet a flat rectangle using SC rows
- Size it to fully cover the opening area from the inside

### **Attach Panel**

- Place inside the body
- Sew edges using SC join or whip stitch

This forms the **internal compartment**

## **Step 6: Crochet the Flippers (Make 4)**

### **Round 1**

- MR, 6 SC

### **Round 2**

- SC around (no increase)

### **Round 3–4**

- Continue SC rounds until oval shape forms
- Lightly stuff (optional)
- Flatten slightly before attaching

## **Step 7: Crochet the Tail**

### **Round 1**

- MR, 6 SC

### **Round 2**

- (SC, INC) around

### **Round 3–5**

- SC around to form a small cone shape

## **Step 8: Assembly**

### **Follow this order:**

#### **1. Attach Head**

- Sew securely to top of body
- Add more stuffing if needed before closing

#### **2. Attach Flippers**

- Two on each side
- Position evenly for balance


#### **3. Attach Tail**

- Centered at bottom back

#### **4. Secure Pocket Panel**

- Ensure seams are tight and durable

## **Step 9: Final Touches**

- Check all seams
- Hide yarn ends
- Test with your remote inside 
- Adjust shape if needed

## Tips for Success

- Use stitch markers to track rounds
- Keep tension consistent
- Test-fit your remote frequently
- Adjust stitch count if your remote is larger/smaller
