



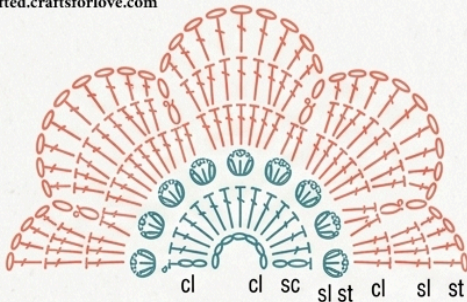
Crochet Flower Bracelet Tutorial

Materials You Will Need

Before starting, gather all the materials below:

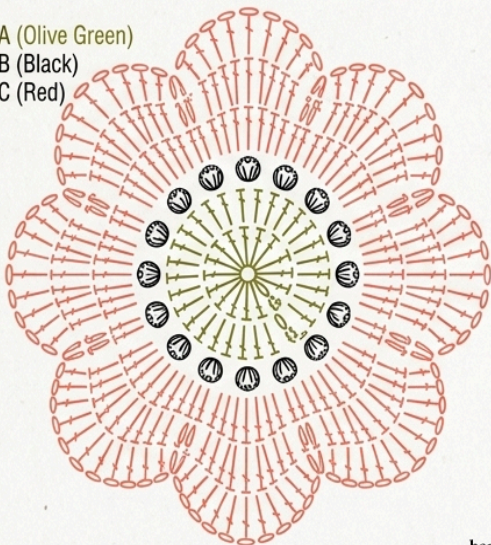
- Cotton crochet thread or lightweight yarn in:
 - Color A — Olive Green
 - Color B — Black
 - Color C — Red
- Crochet hook suitable for your yarn size
 - Usually 2.0 mm–3.5 mm works well
- Scissors
- Yarn needle
- Stitch markers (optional)
- Small beads (optional, for decoration)
- Measuring tape

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Color A (Olive Green)
Color B (Black)
Color C (Red)



Round A
(Olive Green)

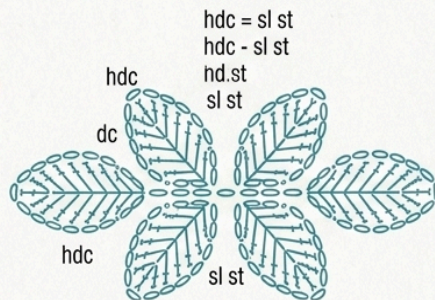
- Magic Ring (MR)
- Chain (ch)
- Slip Stitch (sl st)
- + Single Crochet (sc)
- ⌣ Half Double Crochet (hdc)
- ⌣ Double Crochet (dc)
- ⌣ Triple Crochet (tr)

- inc Increase (inc)
- ⌣ Cluster (cl), 5 dc cluster, (specific description, e.g.)
- ⌣ Shell (sh)
- ⌣ Picot (p)
- ⌣ Post-Stitch (front front)
- ⌣ Post-Stitch (back back)

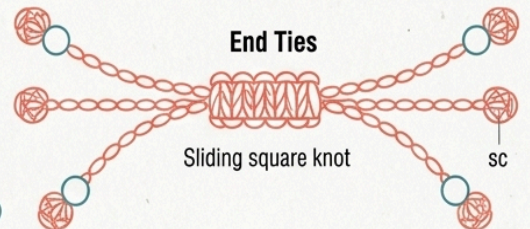
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Assembly Notes:

Attach the poppy flower, onto: cl sc sttch inners and otrach the components to air black.
Attach the components in car final beaded sc clusters.

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This project creates:

- A floral center motif
- A decorative braided bracelet band
- Adjustable sliding knot ties

Perfect for beginners who already know basic crochet stitches.

Crochet Abbreviations Used in This Pattern

- MR = Magic Ring
- ch = Chain
- sl st = Slip Stitch
- sc = Single Crochet
- hdc = Half Double Crochet
- dc = Double Crochet
- tr = Triple Crochet
- inc = Increase
- cl = Cluster
- sh = Shell
- p = Picot



Finished Size

The bracelet is adjustable because of the sliding knot closure.

Average finished bracelet:

- Fits most adult wrists
- Approximately 6.5–8 inches adjustable



Step 1 — Make the Center Flower Base (Color A)

Start with Olive Green yarn.

Round 1

1. Make a Magic Ring (MR).
2. Chain 3.
3. Work 15 dc into the ring.
4. Pull the ring tight.
5. Join with a sl st to the top of the first dc.

You should now have:

- 16 total dc stitches forming a circle.

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Step 2 — Add the Inner Popcorn/Cluster Round (Color B)

Switch to Black yarn.

Round 2

1. Attach yarn in any stitch.
2. Chain 1.
3. In the same stitch, make a cluster stitch:
 - Yarn over
 - Insert hook
 - Pull up loop
 - Repeat until cluster is complete
4. Chain 1.
5. Skip 1 stitch.
6. Make another cluster in the next stitch.

Repeat around the circle.

You should end with:

- Evenly spaced puff/cluster stitches around the center.

Join with sl st.

Fasten off Black yarn.

Step 3 — Crochet the Large Flower Petals (Color C)

Attach Red yarn.

This round creates the large outer petals shown in the diagram.

Petal Pattern

In the space between clusters:

1. Chain 3.
2. Work multiple dc stitches into the same space.
3. Continue increasing gradually to form a fan shape.
4. Add tr stitches at the highest point of the petal.
5. Decrease symmetrically using dc stitches.
6. Finish petal with sl st.

The petal should look like a rounded shell/fan.

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Continue Around

Repeat the same petal structure around the entire flower.

The chart shows:

- 5 large rounded petals total.

Once all petals are complete:

- Join with sl st.
- Fasten off.



Step 4 — Crochet the Small Leaf Motifs

Using Olive Green yarn:

Each leaf is worked separately.

Leaf Pattern

1. Chain 10.
2. Starting in second chain from hook:
 - Work hdc stitches along one side.
3. At the tip:
 - Work hdc + ch 1 + hdc.
4. Continue on opposite side of chain.
5. Join with sl st.

The leaf should form an oval pointed shape.

Make Multiple Leaves

Create:

- 5 or 6 leaves depending on preference.

Fasten off each leaf leaving a long tail for sewing.



Step 5 — Create the Braided Bracelet Band

Use Red yarn.

Foundation

1. Chain enough stitches to fit around wrist comfortably.
2. Add a few extra chains for flexibility.

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Band Row

The chart shows an interwoven braided effect.

To recreate it:

1. Work dc stitches evenly across the row.
2. Chain spaces are used between sections.
3. Long crossover stitches create the braided appearance.
4. Continue repeating:
 - dc
 - crossover dc
 - chain spacing
 - dc

The design should naturally twist and braid visually.

Border

Once braid section is complete:

1. Crochet chains around outer edge.
2. Join both ends with rounded loops as shown in chart.

These loops connect to the adjustable ties.

Step 6 — Make the Adjustable Sliding Knot Ties

Create two long cords.

Cord Instructions

1. Chain approximately 35–45 stitches.
2. Sl st back across the chain for stronger cords.

Make:

- 2 identical cords.

Step 7 — Create the Sliding Square Knot

Lay the bracelet ends overlapping.

Using an additional short yarn piece:

1. Wrap yarn around both cords.
2. Tie square knots repeatedly around them.
3. Keep knot section loose enough to slide.

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This creates:

- Adjustable bracelet sizing.

Step 8 — Attach the Flower to the Bracelet

Position flower at center of bracelet band.

Using yarn needle:

1. Sew flower securely onto band.
2. Attach leaves underneath flower.
3. Hide all yarn tails carefully.

Optional:

- Add beads at tie ends.
- Add beads in flower center.



Finishing Tips

- Block the flower lightly for a cleaner shape.
- Steam gently if using cotton yarn.
- Make sure sliding knot moves smoothly.
- Reinforce attachment points securely.



Beginner Tips for Best Results

- Count stitches after every round.
- Use stitch markers if needed.
- Keep tension consistent.
- Do not pull petals too tightly.
- Practice cluster stitches separately first if new to crochet.



Color Suggestions

You can customize colors easily:

- Sunflower Style:
 - Brown center
 - Yellow petals
 - Green leaves
- Rose Style:
 - Burgundy petals
 - Dark green leaves
- Boho Style:

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- Cream
- Terracotta
- Mustard



Skill Level

- Advanced Beginner to Intermediate



Approximate Time

- Flower: 1–2 hours
- Bracelet band: 1 hour
- Assembly: 30 minutes



Final Result

You will have:

- A beautiful handmade floral crochet bracelet
- Adjustable fit
- Decorative braided band
- Dimensional flower centerpiece
