

Lucky Clover Sleeping Panda

Complete Crochet Pattern (US Terms)

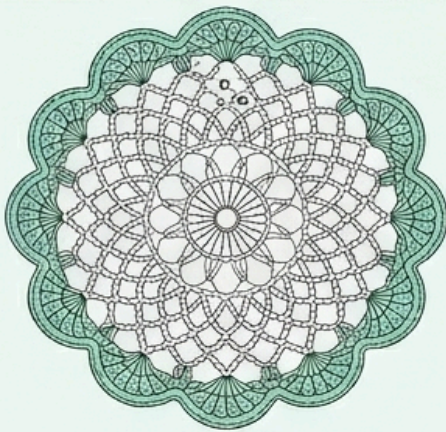
A charming sleeping panda cuddling a lucky four-leaf clover, surrounded by an elegant lace-style scalloped frame. This pattern is inspired by the provided crochet chart and is written as a complete step-by-step tutorial in standard US crochet terminology.

Skill Level: Intermediate to Advanced

Finished Size: Approximately 12–14 inches (30–36 cm) depending on yarn and hook used.

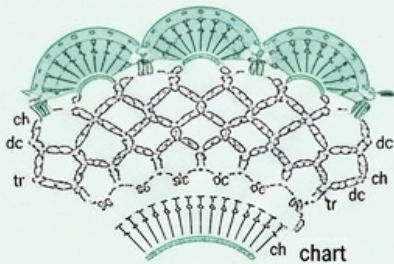
DETAILED CROCHET TUTORIAL: SLEEPING PANDA WITH CLOVER DOILY (US TERMS)

DOILY PATTERN



RND 1-5: The White Mesh Center

Using ch, sc, and dc to lean a trelle crochet, usiing, sc, and dc on-center for ch, sc and dc dc to form a trellis.



RND 6-7: The Mint Green Scalloped Border

tr, dc, dc dc, dc 0, 14 ch ch (using sc, hdc, dc to form lobes)
 tr, dc, bl, dc, dc 0, 14 ch (hdc, dc, sc, hdc, dc to form lobes)
 tr, dc, ch ch - tr 0, 14 ch ch (using sc, hdc, dc, sc, dc to form lobes)
 tr, dc, ch ch - tr (11, 24 on hollet)
 tr, dc, bl, dc, dc 0, 14 cr ch (using sc, hdc, dc, sc, dc to form lobes)
 tr, dc, ch ch - tr (11, 24 on hollet)
 tr, dc, bl, dc, dc 0, 14 cr ch (using sc, hdc, dc, sc, dc to form in lobes)
 tr, dc, ch ch - tr (11, 24 on hollet)
 cr, dc, bl dc, dc 0, 14 ch for (using sc to form lobes)

- White yarn
- Black yarn
- Mint Green yarn (medium weight recommended)
- Crochet hook (2.5mm or 3.0mm)
- Amigurumi stuffing
- Tapestry needle
- Scissors
- Black embroidery thread

THE PANDA AMIGURUMI

Part A: Head (White Yarn)

Magic Ring Start:
(magic ring)



- R1: mr, 6sc
 R2: inc around - 12sc
 R3: *sc, inc* around - 18 sc (6sc)
 R4: *2 sc, inc* around - 24 sc (3sc)
 R5: *3 sc, inc* around - 30 sc (4sc)
 R6: inc aroun* around - 60 sc (6sc)

Stuffing and points.
Embroidery thread, or diagreter.
Embroidery throun. Embroidery for forw in the embroidsens.

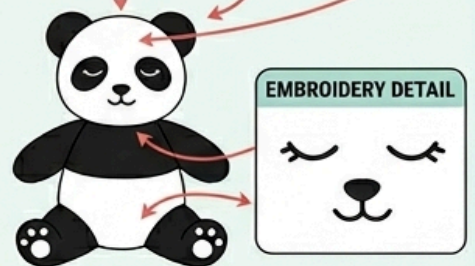
Part B: Body (Black and White Yarns)

- Color changes:** Black and White Yarns)
 R1: B:changes: Black Yarns (6sc)
 R2: B:changes: White Yarn (6sc)
 R3: mr, 6sc (3sc)
 R4: inc around - 12sc (7sc)
 R5: mr, 6sc (8sc)
 R6: inc around - 12sc (12sc)

Ending count tr stitch to poit, embroidery i points.
Stuffin stuffing.
Embroidery black embroidery thread.
 Black embroidery thread.

Part C: Black Features

- Ears (x2)** (1 esc)
Eye Patches (x2) Patchis (x2)
Paws (x4) Paws (x4)



THE CLOVER (Mint Green Yarn)

Row 1: Central Ring and Petals 1-4 and Petals 1-4 (using sc, hdc, dc to form lobes)
Row 2: Stalk



FINAL ASSEMBLY



1. Stuff and assemble Panda.



2. Sew Panda to the White Mesh of Doily.



3. Hook Clover to Panda's paws and secure.

Materials

Yarn Colors

- White (main panda color)
- Black (ears, eye patches, paws, body markings)
- Mint Green (clover and border)
- Light Mint (optional embroidery accents)

Recommended Yarn

- DK Weight (#3)
- Cotton or cotton blend recommended for best stitch definition

Hook

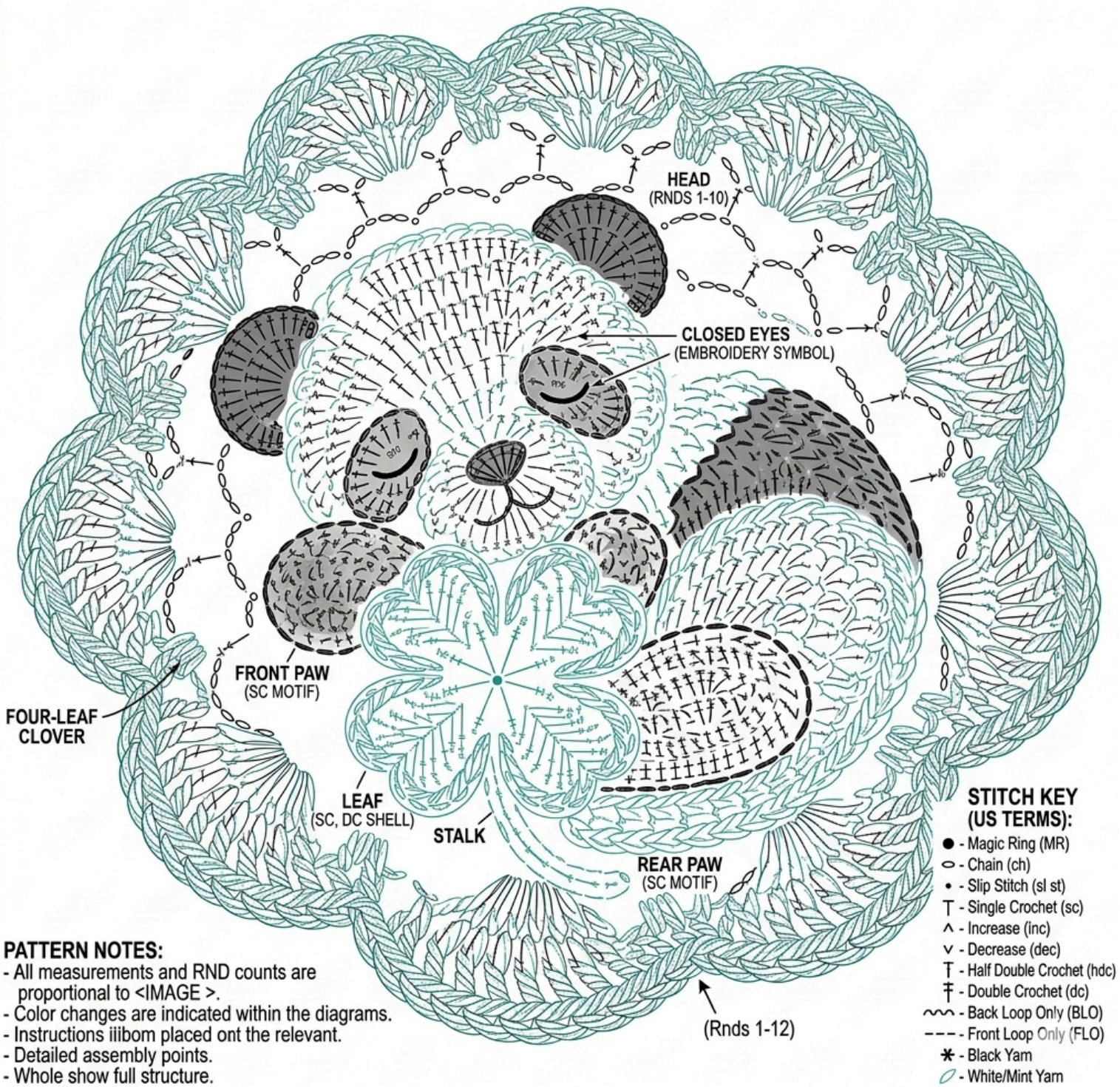
- 3.5 mm (E)
- Adjust if necessary to obtain a flat fabric

Additional Supplies

- Stitch markers
- Tapestry needle
- Scissors
- Blocking board
- Rust-proof pins

Crochet Abbreviations (US Terms)

- MR = Magic Ring
- ch = chain
- sl st = slip stitch
- sc = single crochet
- hdc = half double crochet
- dc = double crochet
- inc = increase
- dec = decrease
- FLO = front loop only
- BLO = back loop only
- st = stitch
- sp = space
- rnd = round

Construction Overview

The design is worked in individual components and assembled.

The project consists of:

1. Four-leaf clover
2. Panda head
3. Panda muzzle
4. Eye patches
5. Ears
6. Front paws
7. Rear paws
8. Body sections
9. Decorative chain framework
10. Scalloped lace border
11. Final assembly

Four-Leaf Clover Center

The clover forms the heart of the design.

Round 1

Using mint green:

- MR
- 8 sc into ring
- Join with sl st

(8 sts)

Round 2

- Ch 1
- Inc in each stitch around

(16 sts)

Join.

Round 3 – Forming the Leaves

Leaf 1

- Ch 3
- 3 dc in next st

- 2 hdc in next st
- 1 sc in next st
- Sl st into center

Repeat three more times to create four leaves.

You should now have a basic four-leaf shape.

Round 4 – Leaf Expansion

Work around each leaf:

- Sc
- Hdc
- 2 dc
- 2 dc
- Hdc
- Sc

Repeat on every leaf.

Fasten off.

Embroidered Clover Veins

Using a tapestry needle and light mint yarn:

For each leaf:

- Stitch one central vein from center outward.
- Stitch two angled veins to each side.
- Follow a natural leaf pattern.

This detail creates the texture shown in the chart.

Clover Stem

Join mint yarn at the lower center.

Row 1

- Ch 14

Turn.

Row 2

- Sc in second chain from hook.
- Sc across.

Fasten off.

Curve the stem naturally and sew in place.

Panda Head

Using white yarn.

Round 1

- MR
- 6 sc

Round 2

- Inc around

(12)

Round 3

- (Sc, inc) around

(18)

Round 4

- (2 sc, inc) around

(24)

Round 5

- (3 sc, inc) around

(30)

Round 6

- (4 sc, inc) around

(36)

Round 7

- (5 sc, inc) around

(42)

Round 8

- (6 sc, inc) around

(48)

Round 9

Work even.

Round 10

Work even.

Fasten off leaving a long tail.

The head should be slightly oval rather than perfectly round.

Panda Muzzle

Using white yarn.

Round 1

- MR
- 6 sc

Round 2

- Inc around

(12)

Round 3

- (Sc, inc) around

(18)

Fasten off.

Sew centered on the lower half of the head.

Nose

Using black yarn.

Round 1

- MR
- 6 sc

Round 2

- Inc around

(12)

Fasten off.

Sew to center of muzzle.

Eye Patches

Make 2.

Using black yarn.

Round 1

- 6 sc

Round 2

- Inc around

(12)

Round 3

- Work even

Shape into an oval while sewing.

Attach slightly angled.

The chart shows the eye patches positioned diagonally for a sleeping expression.

Closed Eyes

Using black embroidery thread.

Embroider:

- A short curved line beneath each eye patch.
- Slight downward tilt at the outer edge.

This creates the sleeping panda expression.

Panda Ears

Make 2.

Using black yarn.

Round 1

- MR
- 8 sc

Round 2

- Inc around

(16)

Round 3

- (Sc, inc) around

(24)

Fasten off.

Fold slightly before attaching.

Position near the top of the head.

Front Paw (Make 2)

Using black yarn.

Round 1

- MR
- 6 sc

Round 2

- Inc around

(12)

Round 3

- (Sc, inc) around

(18)

Round 4

Work even.

Fasten off.

Flatten lightly.

Rear Paw (Make 2)

Using black yarn.

Round 1

- MR
- 8 sc

Round 2

- Inc around

(16)

Round 3

- (Sc, inc) around

(24)

Round 4

Work even.

Fasten off.

The rear paws should be larger than the front paws.

Panda Body

Using white yarn.

Foundation

- Ch 22

Round 1

Work around both sides of the chain.

- Sc across
- 3 sc in end
- Sc opposite side
- 3 sc in final end

Join.

Round 2

Increase evenly around.

Round 3

Increase evenly around.

Round 4

Work even.

The body should resemble a soft oval cloud shape.

Black Body Markings

Create several separate patches.

Small Patch

Using black yarn:

- MR
- 6 sc
- Increase to 12
- Work one round even

Medium Patch

Using black yarn:

- MR
- 8 sc
- Increase to 16
- Increase to 24

Make:

- Two medium patches
- Two small patches

Attach following the chart placement.

Assembly of Panda

Place all pieces before sewing.

Head Placement

Position head above the clover.

Eye Patches

Attach symmetrically.

Muzzle

Attach beneath eye patches.

Nose

Center on muzzle.

Ears

Attach to top sides of head.

Front Paws

Position around lower sides of clover.

Rear Paws

Position beneath body.

Body Patches

Attach as shown in the chart.

Sew all pieces securely.

Decorative Background Rings

Using black yarn.

The chart shows circular chain pathways behind the panda.

Round A

Join behind assembled panda.

- Ch 5
- Skip 3 sts
- Sl st

Repeat continuously around.

This creates decorative loops.

Round B

Work another round of chain arches.

- Ch 4
- Sl st into next arch

Repeat around.

These arches imitate the circular framework visible in the diagram.

Mint Decorative Shell Layer

Join mint yarn.

Round 1

Work inside each arch:

- Sc
- Hdc
- 3 dc
- Hdc
- Sc

Repeat around.

The project begins to resemble flower petals around the panda.

Outer Lace Border

The border corresponds to rounds 1–12 indicated in the chart.

Border Round 1

- Ch 5
- Skip 2 sts
- Sc

Repeat around.

Border Round 2

In each loop:

- Sc
- Hdc
- 5 dc
- Hdc
- Sc

Repeat around.

Border Round 3

Work behind shells:

- Ch 6
- Sc between shells

Repeat around.

Border Round 4

Inside each new loop:

- Sc
- Hdc
- 7 dc
- Hdc
- Sc

Repeat around.

Border Round 5

Work in FLO only around shell tops.

This begins creating the layered lace appearance shown in the diagram.

Border Round 6

Behind previous shells:

- Ch 5
- Sc between petals

Repeat around.

Border Round 7

In each loop:

- Sc
- Hdc
- 5 dc
- 5 dc
- Hdc
- Sc

Repeat around.

Border Round 8

Work decorative surface slip stitches along shell edges.

Border Round 9

Work BLO around shell bases.

This creates depth.

Border Round 10

Add additional shell layer:

- Sc
- Hdc
- 7 dc
- Hdc
- Sc

Repeat.

Border Round 11

Surface chain embellishment around outer edge.

Border Round 12

Final finishing round:

- Sc evenly around entire perimeter.

Fasten off.

Blocking

Pin every scallop individually.

Shape:

- Clover leaves
- Panda ears
- Paws
- Outer lace petals

Lightly steam block if using cotton.

Allow to dry completely.

Finishing Details

Optional Cheeks

Using pale pink thread:

Add a tiny blush circle beneath each eye patch.

Optional Sparkle Embroidery

Using light mint yarn:

Add decorative stitches around the clover.

Optional Hanging Loop


Add:


- Ch 20
- Sl st to base

For wall display.

Finished Appearance


The completed piece features:

 A peacefully sleeping panda

 A large lucky four-leaf clover held between its paws

 Detailed embroidered leaf veins

 Layered lace-style crochet background

 Elegant scalloped mint-green border inspired directly by the chart

The finished design works beautifully as a decorative doily, framed crochet artwork, nursery decoration, tabletop centerpiece, seasonal lucky charm display, or handmade gift.
