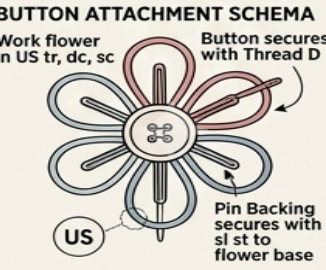
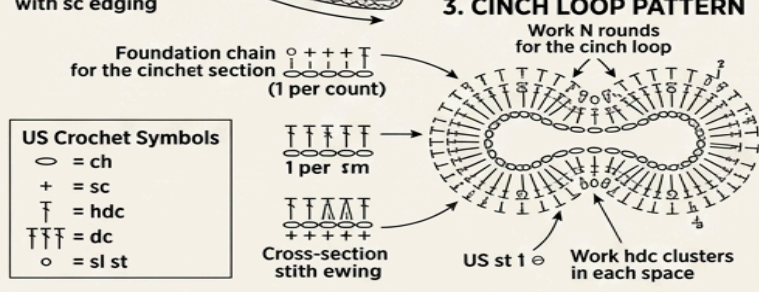
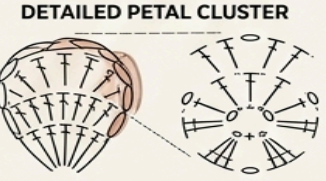
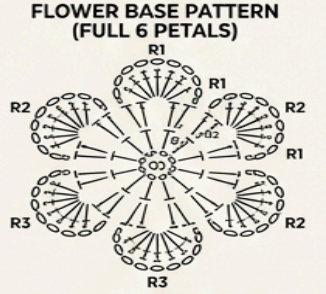
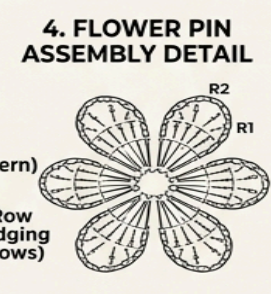
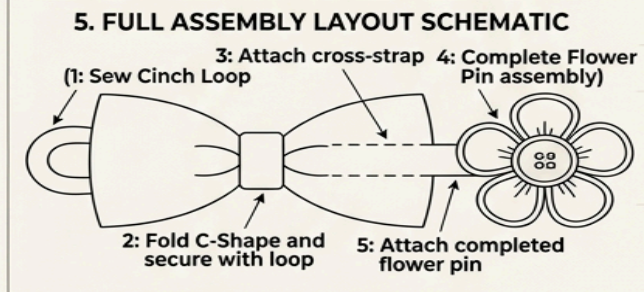
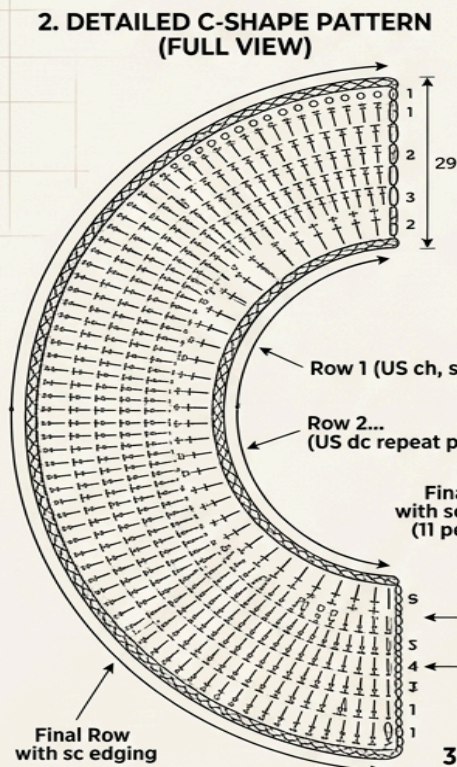
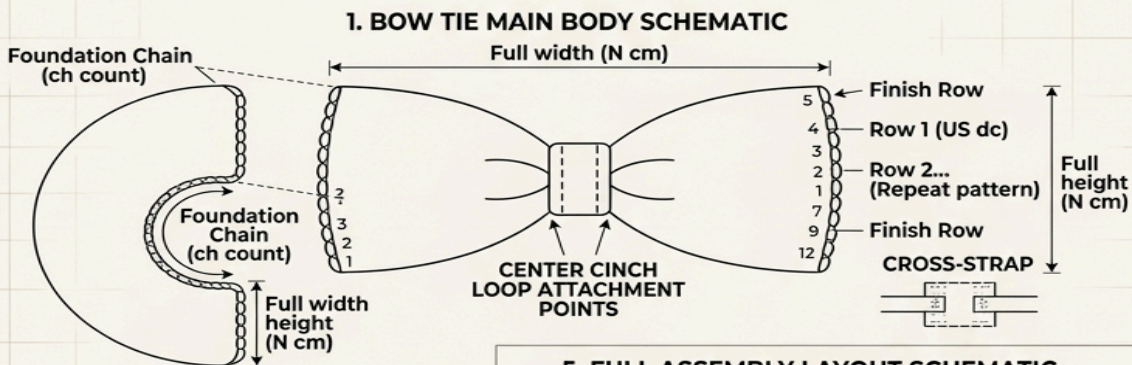


Crochet Flower Scarf Pattern

This elegant crochet scarf features a beautiful five-petal flower at the center with a decorative button and two long textured leaves extending from each side. The design is worked in three sections: the flower, the left leaf, and the right leaf. The leaves are identical and are crocheted directly from oval foundations, creating the graceful shape shown in the chart.

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Skill Level

Intermediate

This pattern uses several basic crochet stitches and simple shaping techniques to create the leaf form.

Materials

- Lightweight cotton yarn or crochet thread
- Crochet hook suitable for your yarn
- One decorative button
- Yarn needle
- Scissors

Abbreviations

- ch = chain
- sl st = slip stitch
- sc = single crochet
- hdc = half double crochet
- dc = double crochet
- tr = treble crochet
- st = stitch
- sp = space
- rnd = round

Finished Scarf Structure

The scarf consists of:

- One flower center
- One leaf on the left side
- One matching leaf on the right side
- One decorative button sewn into the flower center

The flower sits at the center of the scarf while the leaves form the two ends.

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Create the Flower Center

Begin with:

- Ch 6
- Join with a sl st to form a ring

Round 1:

Work 20 dc into the ring.

Join with a sl st to the first dc.

The center should form a flat circle.

Create Petal One

Work into the next section of the center ring:

- Sl st
- Sc
- Hdc
- Dc
- Tr
- Dc
- Hdc
- Sc
- Sl st

This creates one complete petal.

Create the Remaining Petals

Repeat the petal sequence four more times.

Each petal should contain:

- 1 sc
- 1 hdc
- 1 dc
- 1 tr
- 1 dc
- 1 hdc
- 1 sc

Secure each petal with a slip stitch before beginning the next.

When all five petals are complete, fasten off.

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Set the flower aside temporarily.

Begin the First Leaf

Chain 18.

Join with a slip stitch to form an oval foundation exactly as shown in the chart.

This oval becomes the base of the leaf.

Leaf Round 1

Work dc stitches around the entire oval.

At both rounded ends:

- Place several dc stitches into the end spaces

This allows the leaf to curve naturally.

Join with a sl st.

Leaf Rounds 2–5

Continue working dc around.

Increase slightly at both ends during each round.

The leaf should begin growing longer and wider.

Do not increase along the straight sides.

Only increase around the rounded ends.

Join each round with a slip stitch.

First Decorative Band

Work one complete round of sc around the leaf.

Sc in every stitch.

Join with a sl st.

This creates the first textured band visible in the chart.

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Leaf Rounds 6–10

Return to dc stitches.

Work evenly around.

Continue maintaining the leaf shape by placing increases only at the rounded ends.

The leaf should now appear elongated and full.

Second Decorative Band

Work one complete round of sc.

Sc in every stitch around.

Join with a sl st.

This forms the second horizontal textured band shown in the diagram.

Shape the Upper Leaf

Continue working dc rounds.

Begin decreasing gradually on both sides near the top portion.

Keep the decreases symmetrical.

The leaf should slowly taper inward.

Avoid sharp decreases.

The narrowing should happen gradually over several rounds.

Form the Leaf Tip

Continue decreasing evenly on both sides.

Work dc stitches until only a narrow section remains.

At the top:

- Continue reducing stitches
- Maintain symmetry

The final rounds create the pointed tip shown in the chart.

Finish with a slip stitch.

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Fasten off.

Create the Second Leaf

Repeat all leaf instructions exactly.

The second leaf should be identical in size and shape.

Attach the Leaves to the Flower

Position the flower so one petal points upward.

Attach one leaf to the left side of the flower.

Attach the second leaf to the right side.

Use a yarn needle and matching yarn.

Sew securely through the base of each leaf.

The leaves should emerge from opposite sides of the flower center.

Sew the Button

Place the button directly in the center of the flower.

Sew firmly through the flower center.

Do not pull too tightly.

The petals should remain slightly raised and natural-looking.

Finishing

Weave in all yarn tails.

Check that:

- Both leaves are identical
- The flower lies flat
- The button is secure
- All joins are firm

Lightly block the scarf if desired.

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How to Wear the Scarf ✨

Place the flower at the front of the neck.

Allow one leaf to fall down each side.

The floral center acts as the focal point while the two long leaves create an elegant, lightweight scarf suitable for spring, summer, or decorative indoor wear.

The finished scarf features:

- A five-petal flower centerpiece
- A decorative button accent
- Two textured leaves
- Elegant botanical styling inspired by vintage crochet designs
