TITLE: US CROCHET PATTERN DIAGRAM - HEART LINK BRACELET MOTIF (FULL-FORM VIEW)



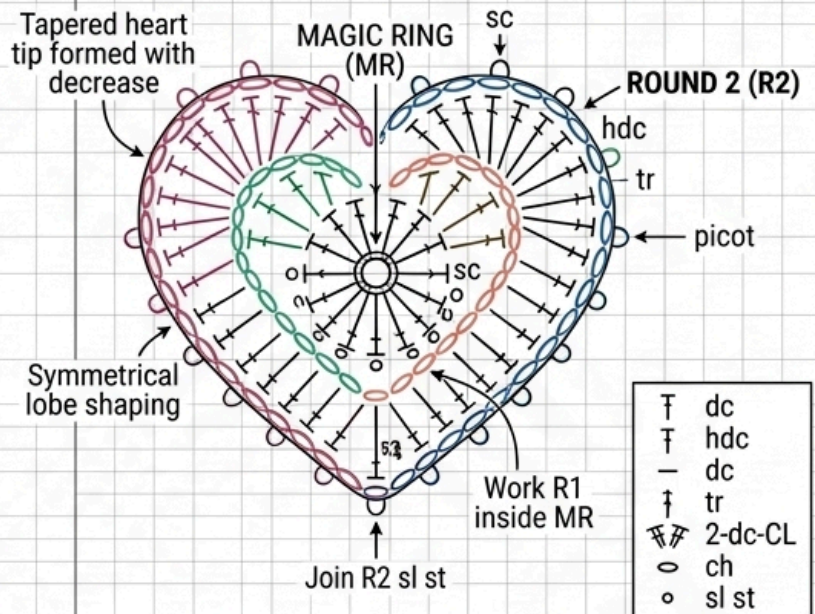
Recommended Materials

- 7 Hearts (2 hearts)
- 1 Pink (off) hearts
- 2 Pink (nhite tint) colors

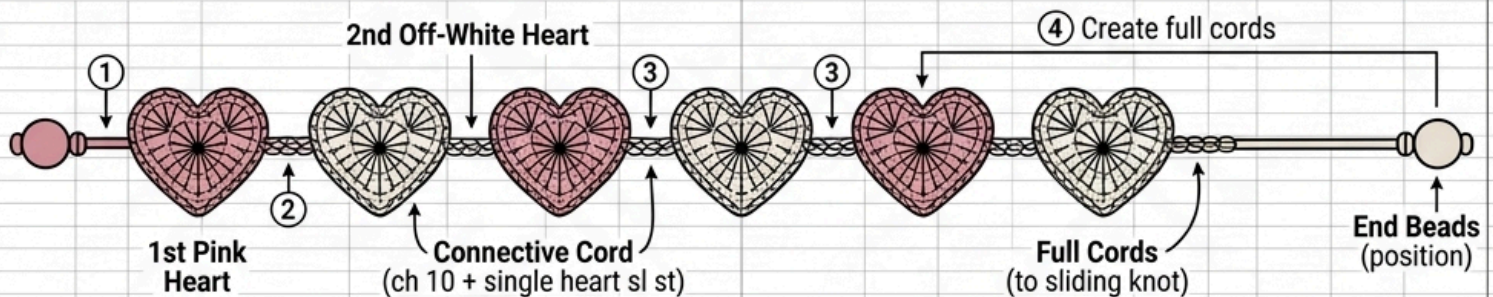

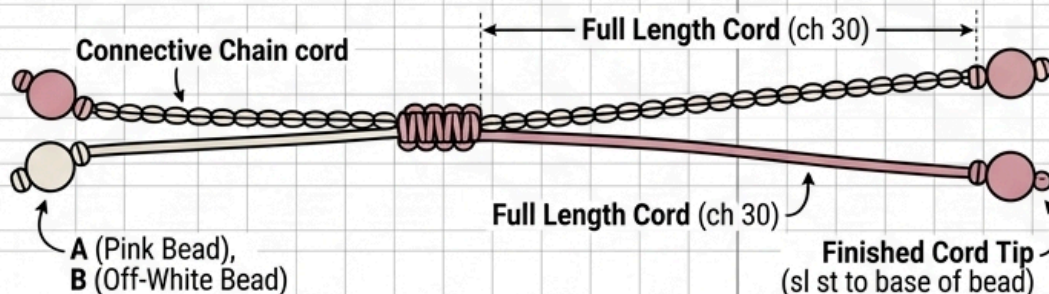

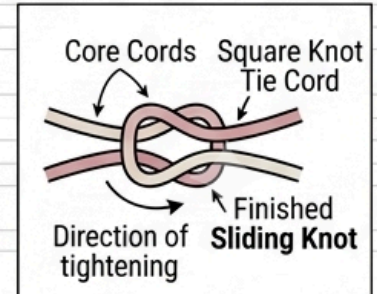
FULL MOTIF DIAGRAM (COMPLETE STRIP)

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Finished Bracelet

This bracelet consists of:

- 5 crochet hearts
- Alternating colors
- Small chain connectors between hearts
- Two adjustable cords
- Sliding knot closure
- Decorative end beads

The finished bracelet is lightweight, adjustable, and perfect as a gift or friendship bracelet.

You should know how to:

- Make a Magic Ring
- Chain (ch)
- Slip Stitch (sl st)
- Single Crochet (sc)
- Half Double Crochet (hdc)
- Double Crochet (dc)
- Treble Crochet (tr)
- Crochet decreases

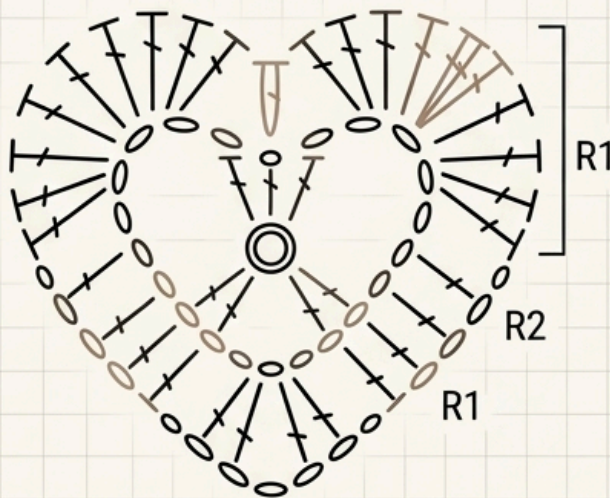

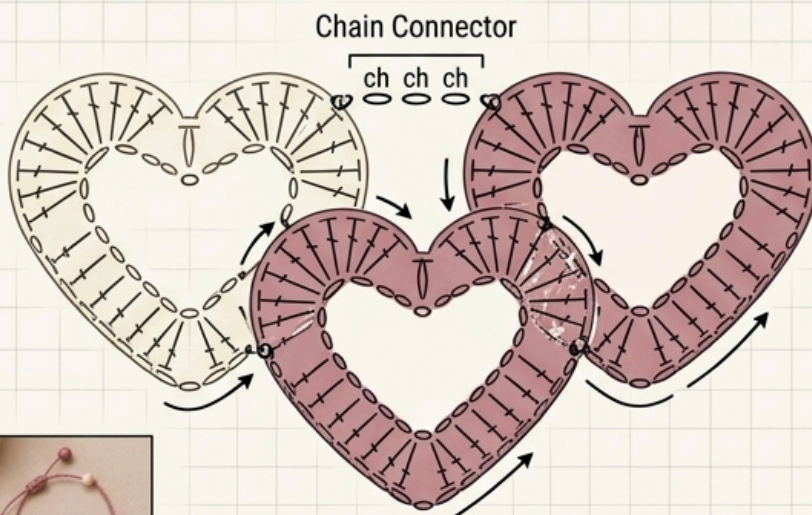

PATTERN KEY (US TERMINOLOGY)

- : chain (ch)
- ⊕ : single crochet (sc)
- ⌈ : double crochet (dc)

SINGLE HEART PATTERN (Detailed)

Round 1: Into MR, [ch 2, dc, dc, hdc, sc, sc, hdc, dc, dc, ch 2, sl st]. Pull MR tight.

Round 2: ..., Ch 2L, [ch 2, dc, dc, hdc, sc, sc, sc, hdc, dc, dc, ch 2, sl st]. Pull MR tir, hdc, sc, sc, dc, dc, dc, dc, all MR irth: sc, ch 2, sc, [ch, dc, dc, dc, dc, trc), sc, sc, hdc, dc, tr, dc, ch 2, st]. Sufatgit tight.

HEART CHAIN ASSEMBLY (Detailed)

Row 1: Complete 1st Heart (Off-White). Ch 3.

Row 2: Make 2nd Heart (Dusty Rose), working MR into 3rd chain from hook, **but interlocking around 1st heart's lower lobe**, for interlocking around 1st heart's lower lobe, the heart-connection will be thredanizing around 1st heart's lower lobe.

FINISHING

Make the adjustable slip knot until make the slip knot for crassay agent and miornn faant, and add beads to your catomnters.

SUGGESTED MATERIALS

- DK cotton (dnm ronar yarn)
- Dusty Rose: Dusty Rose
- Off-White: Off-White
- Hook size: 3mm
- Beads: 2 gram loss or

FINISHED WORK



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Materials

Yarn Colors

- Pink yarn
- Off-white yarn

Quantity

For the bracelet shown:

- 3 Pink Hearts
- 2 Off-White Hearts

Additional Supplies

- Crochet hook suitable for your yarn
- Yarn needle
- Scissors
- 2 beads (one pink, one off-white)
- Measuring tape

Bracelet Layout

Follow this color sequence:

1. Pink Heart
2. Off-White Heart
3. Pink Heart
4. Off-White Heart
5. Pink Heart

Each heart is connected by a short crochet chain cord.

Crochet Heart Motif

Every heart is made individually before joining.

Step 1: Create the Magic Ring

Make a Magic Ring (MR).

This ring forms the center of the heart.

Do not tighten it completely until Round 1 is finished.

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CROCHET HEART BRACELET DIAGRAM



US Terms Key

∞ ch • sl st • sc ⌈ dc ⌈ tr + ⌈ tr

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Step 2: Round 1 (R1)

Work the following stitches into the Magic Ring:

- 3 sc
- 3 hdc
- 3 dc
- 3 tr
- 3 dc
- 3 hdc
- 3 sc

Join with a sl st.

Pull the Magic Ring tail to close the center tightly.

You should now see the basic heart shape beginning to form.

Step 3: Round 2 (R2)

Work around the stitches from Round 1.

This round creates the final heart outline.

Left Side of Heart

Work:

- sc
- hdc
- dc
- dc
- tr
- tr
- tr

Space stitches evenly along the side.

Top Left Curve

To create the rounded lobe:

- Work several dc stitches into the same area
- Shape the curve gently
- Avoid pulling too tightly

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Top Center Indentation

At the center top of the heart:

- Work a decrease (dc dec)
- This forms the heart's center dip

Top Right Curve

Mirror the stitches from the left side:

- Multiple dc stitches
- Rounded shaping

Right Side

Work:

- tr
- tr
- tr
- dc
- dc
- hdc
- sc

Decorative Picots

As shown in the diagram, create small picots around the outer edge.

For each picot:

- ch 3
- sl st into first chain

Place them evenly around the heart outline.

Bottom Point

At the tip of the heart:

- Work a decrease
- Pull slightly tighter

This creates the tapered point shown in the diagram.

Join Round

When you return to the starting stitch:

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- Join with sl st

Fasten off.

Leave a short tail for weaving in.

Step 4: Shape the Heart

Before weaving ends:

- Gently pull both sides into symmetry
- Adjust the center dip
- Shape the bottom point

The heart should have:

♥ Rounded lobes

♥ Deep center indentation

♥ Defined point

Step 5: Make All Five Hearts

Create:

- 3 Pink Hearts
- 2 Off-White Hearts

Arrange them in alternating order.

Connective Cord Between Hearts

The diagram shows a short connecting cord between motifs.

Step 6: Attach the First Connector

Join yarn to the side of the first heart.

Chain:

ch 10

This forms the connector.

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Step 7: Join the Second Heart

Position the second heart beside the first.

Insert hook into the joining point on the second heart.

Work:

- 1 sl st

This secures the hearts together.

Step 8: Continue Across the Bracelet

Repeat:

- ch 10
- sl st into next heart

Until all hearts are connected.

The sequence should be:

Pink → Off-White → Pink → Off-White → Pink

The bracelet strip is now complete.

Creating the Adjustable Cords

The bracelet uses two long cords and a sliding knot.

Step 9: Left Cord

Attach yarn near the first heart.

Chain:

ch 30

This creates the first adjustable cord.

Fasten off.

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Step 10: Right Cord

Attach yarn near the last heart.

Chain:

ch 30

Create a second cord of equal length.

Fasten off.

Both sides should now have matching cords.

Step 11: Add End Beads

Thread:

- Pink bead onto one cord end
- Off-white bead onto the other cord end

Secure each bead by:

- Making a knot
- Or using a slip stitch at the base

The beads prevent the cords from slipping out.

Sliding Knot Closure

This closure allows the bracelet to fit different wrist sizes.

Step 12: Cross the Cords

Lay the bracelet flat.

Cross the two long cords over each other.

The cords should overlap approximately 1½–2 inches (4–5 cm).

Step 13: Create the Sliding Knot

Using a separate strand of yarn:

Wrap around both crossed cords.

Tie a square knot around the two core cords.

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The knot must grip the cords but still slide freely.

Do not pull excessively tight.

Step 14: Secure the Knot

Make several wraps around the cords.

Finish with:

- sl st
- small hidden knot

Trim excess yarn.

Weave ends neatly.

Step 15: Test the Adjustment

Pull the bracelet ends apart.

The sliding knot should move smoothly.

Pull the beads outward to tighten.

Pull the bracelet body outward to loosen.

The bracelet should open and close comfortably.

Finishing Touches ✨

Inspect all hearts and ensure:

- Hearts are aligned
- Connector chains are equal
- Sliding knot moves freely
- Beads are secure
- Ends are woven in neatly

Lightly block the bracelet if needed.

This helps the hearts sit flat and creates a professional finish.

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Final Measurements

Approximate sizes:

- Each heart: 1–1.25 inches (2.5–3 cm)
- Connector chains: 10 chains
- Adjustable cords: 30 chains each

Adjust these measurements as desired for children, teens, or adults.

Quick Pattern Summary

Hearts (Make 5)

- 3 Pink
- 2 Off-White

Heart Construction

- MR
- Round 1: sc, hdc, dc, tr shaping
- Round 2: outline with decorative picots
- Join and fasten off

Assembly

- Connect hearts with ch 10 cords
- Alternate colors
- Create two ch 30 cords

Closure

- Add beads
- Create sliding knot
- Weave in ends
